

TOP DIRT HORSES HEADLINE NOMINATIONS FOR BLOCKBUSTER STEPHEN FOSTER



Sovereignty last Sunday | *Susie Raisher*

Reigning Horse of the Year **Sovereignty** (Into Mischief), G1 Dubai World Cup hero **Magnitude** (**Not This Time**), G1 Pegasus World Cup victor **White Abarrio** (Race Day), and G1 Pennsylvania Stakes winner **Baeza** (**McKinzie**) headline 17 nominations to what is shaping up to be a blockbuster summer event Saturday, June 27 in the G1 Stephen Foster Stakes at Churchill Downs.

One of seven stakes races set for that card, nominations for the 'Win and You're In' contest for the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic also include the likes of **Nysos** (**Nyquist**), last seen putting on a sensational performance in the G1 Met Mile; last year's G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Hit Show** (**Candy Ride** {**Arg**}); and GSW & GISP **Coal Battle** (Coal Front).

SALVATOR MILE BECOMES BATTLE OF 'RISING STARS' LATE, EAST AVENUE NARROWLY BESTS BISHOPS BAY

The 'TDN Rising Stars, presented by Hagyard' were neck-and-neck late, but **East Avenue** (Medaglia d'Oro) had just enough to produce a final jump and narrowly catch ultra-game **Bishops Bay** (Uncle Mo) in the final strides to win the GIII Salvator Mile.

Winless since June 2025 when he took home the GIII Matt Winn Stakes beneath the Twin Spires, the Godolphin homebred went onto the shelf after his fifth-place finish last August in the GIII West Virginia Derby. He returned Mar. 28 at Oaklawn Park in the GIII Oaklawn Mile, and ran second by three-quarters of a length. He was last seen fading to fourth in the GII Alysheba Stakes May 1 at Churchill Downs.

Sent off at 5-2 odds with Bishops Bay crowned the 4-5 favorite, the 2024 GI Breeders' Futurity hero raced along at the back off contested early fractions courtesy of the betting choice as that one pushed the leader through an opening quarter in :23.56. The frontrunner threw in the towel on the turn as Bishops Bay took over, and East Avenue was building up a rally under a full head of steam on the overland path turning for home.

The Big Guns Work Saturday Morning

A pair of top contenders for the Stephen Foster were spotted working Saturday morning at Churchill Downs, namely Magnitude for trainer Steve Asmussen, and Hit Show, for trainer Brad Cox.

The former worked a bullet five furlongs in :59.20 in company with stablemate SW American Promise (**Justify**), who shared the top spot for the fastest move of 50 that morning. Magnitude's sectionals were clocked in :11.80, :23.40, and :35 flat. He galloped out six furlongs in 1:11.60, and seven panels in 1:24.60, according to Churchill clocker John Nichols.

Hit Show breezed four furlongs in :49.20 (103/184), and SW & MGSP **Gould's Gold** (Goldencents), also a nomination to the Foster, posted his own half-mile work in :47.80 (14/184).

Currently based at America's summer playground, Baeza went through his paces at Saratoga for trainer Bill Mott. Breezing on the Oklahoma training track, he covered five furlongs in 1:02.85 (3/5) in company with GIII Ben Ali Stakes winner Stars and Stripes (**Not This Time**).

White Abarrio, who also remains on track for the Foster, was clocked last Thursday putting in his latest prep at Gulfstream for the heralded 'Summer Showdown' at the end of the month. The Saffie Josph Jr.-trained star posted a bullet half-mile work in :46.80.

The pair locked horns in midstretch, and battled to the line in a race that deserved no loser with East Avenue ultimately prevailing in the photo over a valiant Bishops Bay. **Sea Streak** (Sea Wizard) finished third at massive 65-1 odds.

"It appears [East Avenue] might be back by the looks of that race," said trainer Brendan Walsh. "He showed great heart today. He battled hard. He's a very solid horse."

"I think this year he has finally been piecing it all together. I don't think he learned a lot as a young horse because he was so good right away. He's had some issues as well."

"We'll see where we go from here. It was great to see the fight he showed. We'll enjoy this and see where we go next. We'll pick our spots. I think we can achieve something with him this year."

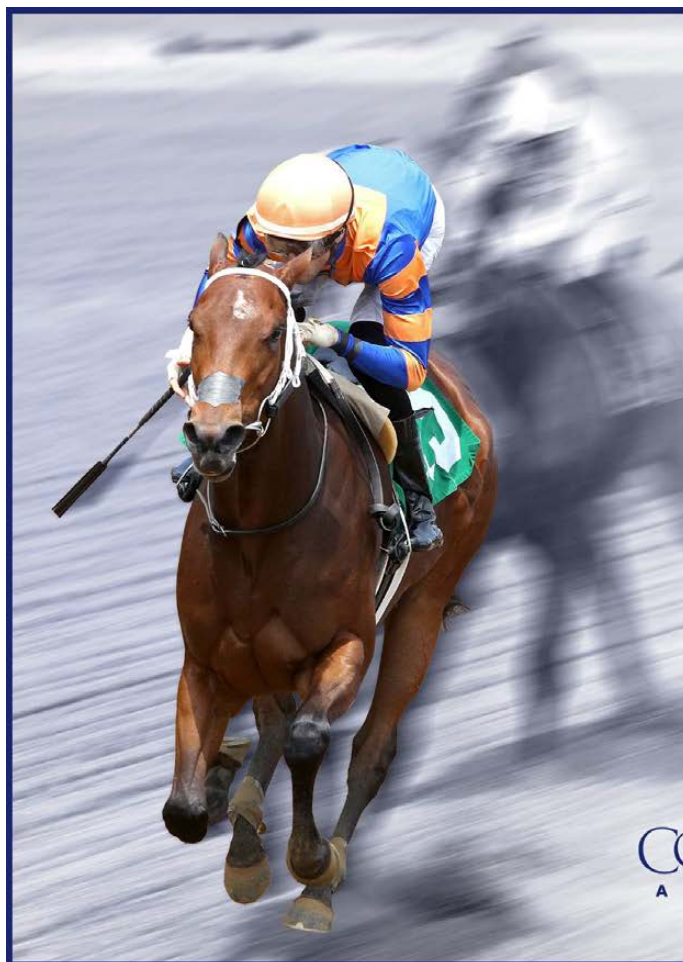
Jockey Tyler Gaffalione was also impressed with East Avenue's effort, saying, "I had to work a little bit harder than I expected to. He was traveling well down the backstretch and when we got to the turn they quickened. It just took a little bit from there for him to get going. He just continued to grind. He showed a lot of heart and would not give in. I'm very proud of him."

"This is a special horse to me. I've been with [East Avenue] before he ever ran. I was working him then. I spent a lot of time in the mornings with him. It's nice to see him put in an effort like this today."

East Avenue hails from an accomplished Godolphin family, as his dam is a half-sister to Horse of the Year **Cody's Wish** (Curlin) and MGSW Endorsed (Medaglia d'Oro).

WELL-MEANT DEMIAN BECOMES FLIGHTLINE'S FIRST WINNER AT TOKYO

Naohiro Sakakuchi's **Demian (c, 2, Flightline--Mira Alta, by Curlin)** was produced by the visiting Damian Lane with a bit less than a furlong to race and quickened up nicely to become the first winner from the much-anticipated initial crop of his freshman sire (by **Tapit**) in Saturday's sixth race for unraced 2-year-olds going 1400 meters on the turf at Tokyo Racecourse.

Favored at odds-on in ante-post wagering, **the \$1.7-million Keeneland September acquisition** was ultimately away as the 19-10 second pick, but jumped only fairly and raced near the back of a compact group early on before improving into midfield for the run around the turn.

Traveling in hand and with cover turning into the long straight, Demian was asked to take a gap between horses about 300 meters from home, did so professionally and surged past longtime leader **Desert Spirit (Jpn)** (Isla Bonita {Jpn}) inside the final 100 meters, edging away to graduate by 1 1/4 lengths. He covered his final three furlongs in a race-fastest :33.6.

Breeder Rock Ridge Thoroughbreds purchased the colt's dam Mira Alta for \$200,000 in foal to Awesome Again at the 2015 Keeneland November Sale and that produce became Wicked Awesome, a stakes winner and Grade III placed on the Maryland circuit.

The mare's foal of 2018 was the Todd Pletcher-trained Promise Keeper (**Constitution**), who validated 3-2 favoritism in the 2021 GIII Peter Pan Stakes for a partnership including Woodford Thoroughbreds, WinStar Farm and Rock Ridge Racing. Mira Alta is also responsible for GSP War Stopper (Declaration of War) and her youngest produce include a yearling full-sister to Demian and a colt by **Nyquist** foaled this past Mar. 5.

Demian's stakes-winning and Grade III-placed second dam Zenith (Roy) accounted for six winners from nine to race, including Great Hunter (Aptitude), winner of the 2006 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity and third to **Street Sense** in that year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Zenith's unraced daughter Aspen Light (Bernardini) is the dam of MGSW and GI Preakness Stakes third Owendale (Into Mischief) and his 'TDN Rising Star' presented by Hagyard full-sister Shred the Gnarl, recent winner of the GI La Troienne Stakes. **Cont.**

The racetrack exploits of **Flightline** need little recounting. Bred by Jane Lyon's Summer Wind Equine, **Flightline** was a \$1-million purchase as a yearling at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga and won his first three starts by a combined 37 1/2 lengths, including a 11 1/2-length romp in the seven-furlong GI Malibu Stakes.

He returned for an additional trio of starts as a 4-year-old for trainer John Sadler, taking the GI Metropolitan Handicap by a half-dozen lengths, the GI Pacific Classic by an eye-watering 19 1/4-length margin and the GI Breeders' Cup Classic by better than eight lengths en route to Horse of the Year and champion older dirt male honors. Lyon retained a stake in his racing career and was joined in the ownership group by Hronis Racing, Siena Farm, West Point Thoroughbreds and Woodford Racing.

Flightline's first starter, Greenwell, was a promising runner-up in a five-furlong maiden at Churchill Downs on June 12 and he was to have his third runner overall in the form of Flying Dutchmen homebred filly House Boat Party in a five-furlong contest Saturday afternoon.

Flightline is the sire of 124 registered 2-year-olds from his first crop and stood for \$125,000 in his fourth year at stud at Lane's End in 2026.

VEKOMA FILLY FASTEST DURING FINAL DAY OF OBS JUNE BREEZE SHOW *by Stefanie Grimm*

A filly by 2024's champion freshman sire and current leading third crop sire Vekoma (**hip 876**) stole the show Saturday during the final breeze show ahead of next week's Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's June 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale. Consigned by Jesse Hoppel's Hoppel LLC, the New York-bred put up a co-sales best quarter in :20 2/5, one of only two hips to share that bullet across the five days of previews.

"In years past, she might have been the perfect type of horse where she breezed so well on the dirt that I would take her to [the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic May 2-Year-Olds In Training Sale] because she is a New York bred," Hoppel told OBS after the work. "But that filly is so talented, I need them basically to put it on record that she is really fast. And I feel like a sale like this where we're racing the clock, we can really make a horse like her standout more so than we can at a gallop-type sale." **Cont.**

WORLD POOL INSIGHTS

ROYAL ASCOT 2026

The Royal meeting at Ascot in Great Britain will commence on Tuesday, June 16 and finish on Saturday, June 20. Each day has seven races and the amount of horses that will enter the starting gates in five days will be enormous. Eight group one stakes races will be run with each carrying at least \$US 937,000 in purse money. All the sprint races are run down the straight. Some of the one-mile races are run down the straight and some are run on what is called the "round course" which goes around a right-hand turn.

Unlike Epsom last week which saw the G1 Derby run over bottomless ground due to relentless rain, the Royal meet should see much better weather and drying conditions. Like nearly all the top-rated horse races in the world, the entire Royal Ascot meet will be conducted as World Pool races which will see enormous mutuel pools. 27 jurisdictions will commingle their pools into a single World Pool operated by the Hong Kong Jockey Club resulting in enormous liquidity with huge value opportunities for racing fans. Win, Place, Quinella Place, Quinella, Exacta, Trifecta, Double and Pick Three betting should be available but check with your local account wagering company. With the big fields in the handicap races, be aware that Place bets are for the first four finishers if there are 21 or more starters.

There will be an American contingent and four races serve as Breeders' Cup Challenge Series Win and You're In qualifiers for the Breeders' Cup races to be held at Keeneland so you will see many familiar faces. Wesley Ward always sends a strong group and uses his horse's gate speed to best advantage.

The G1 Queen Anne Stakes going a straight mile gets the meet off to an electric start on Tuesday and three of the first four races carded on Tuesday are group one stakes races. Not many meets can start off loud and maintain it for five days. Can you imagine going to the start of a five-day racing festival and Frankel is in the first race? Get used to it since the excitement never waivers. There is obvious quality with each day having at least one group one stakes race but quantity is there also since many of the handicap races that are run have huge fields.

Notable Speech won the most recent G1 Breeders' Cup Mile at Del Mar and should be the one to beat in the Queen Anne off a strong win in the G1 Lockinge S. against many of these. The G1 King Charles III Stakes has a field of 27 early entries going

five furlongs down the straight. Overpass is the lukewarm favorite and was only beaten 1 ½ lengths by Ka Ying Rising in last season's G1 Everest. The G1 St. James Palace Stakes is run for 3YO colts going a mile but down the round course. Bow Echo is undefeated in four starts including the G1 English 2000 Guineas. Gstaad won the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf last season at Del Mar but was no match against Bow Echo in his seasonal debut.

Wednesday's racing will be highlighted by the G1 Prince of Wales going 1 ¼ miles. Daryz won the G1 Prix de L'Arc du Triomphe last October over soft ground and two more group one stakes this year. His acceleration is brilliant but waiting for him is Ombudsman, winner of the G1 Dubai Turf in March.

Thursday is G1 Gold Cup Day with the marquee race first run in 1807. Contested at a grueling 2 ½ miles for 4YOs and Up, it is a tactical challenge for the riders to try to save ground while setting a reasonable pace. The finish is an epic test of stamina and courage and it always produces one of the most thrilling scenes of the week. Friday has the G1 Commonwealth Cup for 3YO sprinters and the G1 Coronation Stakes for 3YO fillies going a mile on the round course. Saturday finishes with G1 Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes going six furlongs for older horses where some runners from Tuesday's King Charles III returning here.

Hoppel, who purchased his filly as a Fasig-Tipton October Yearling for \$110,000, will look to continue a strong OBS sales season with the April sale alone rewarding him with a trio of \$775,000+ juveniles including an \$850,000 **Early Voting** filly sold to Three Amigos. That result was in addition to the seven-figure son of **Mo Town** he consigned through the OBS March Sale. Of note, both of Hoppel's toppers worked in :20 2/5.

Just one juvenile claimed the day's fastest furlong with a colt by **Army Mule** (hip 1019) going in :9 4/5 for consignor S G V Thoroughbreds.

Also putting up a noteworthy breeze just a tick off the bullet was the 2-year-old **Highly Motivated** half-sister (hip 925) to GI Woody Stephens runner up Crude Velocity (**Beau Liam**), himself an OBS June grad. She worked a quarter-mile in :20 3/5 for consignor Omar Ramirez.

The OBS June sale will be held next Tuesday through Thursday. Bidding begins each day at 10:30 a.m.

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LUV YOUR NEIGHBOR CLAIMS FIRST BLACK TYPE WIN IN DELAWARE OAKS

Luv Your Neighbor (**Constitution**), who hadn't visited the winner's circle since her debut win last September, marked her return to the winner's circle with stylish victory in Saturday's GIII Delaware Oaks at Delaware Park.

Sent off the 2-1 second choice, Luv Your Neighbor was settled in a two-wide fifth as 8-5 choice **Dazzling Dame** (**Girvin**) shot to the front, leading 5-1 chance **Jumping the Gun** (**Gun Runner**) through an opening quarter mile in :23.76. Narrowing the gap on the front running pair through a :47.82 half, Luv Your Neighbor eagerly confronted the leaders as the trio of fillies rounded the home turn in unison. Drifting a bit wide off the turn, the ultimate winner was moving best of all late, kicking clear to best Jumping the Gun by 1 1/4 lengths. Dazzling Dame held on to be third.

The Ontario-bred filly has been knocking on the door ever since her debut win at Colonial last September, hitting the board in six of seven subsequent starts. In her only forgettable race, she finished a well-beaten seventh over Woodbine's synthetic surface in last fall's Glorious Song Stakes before stringing together four consecutive runner-up finishes, including the Untapable Stakes at Fair Grounds in December.

Launching her sophomore season in a similar vein, she was a neck behind winner Taken by the Wind (Rock Your World) in the Silverbulletday Stakes on Jan. 17 before finishing a half-length behind Bella Ballerina (**Street Sense**) in the GII Rachel Alexandra Stakes on Valentine's Day.

Fading to third--beaten 8 1/2 lengths--in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks on Mar. 21, the Canadian bred found only On Time Girl (**Not This Time**) too good in the seven-furlong GII Eight Belles Stakes on May 1.

"She has run against the very best 3-year-old fillies and it was just a matter of time before she got her day and today was the day," said winning trainer Michael Stidham. "[Jockey Luis] Saez has ridden her multiple times and he has gotten to know her. In a couple of her races, he has kind of used her to be close to the pace. Today, he sat a little bit off of it and he made his move when he needed to do it."

"I have trained a lot of nice fillies over the years and this is one who has a constitution you would not believe. She is in good physical condition after a lot of hard races and shipping."

Pedigree Notes:

With her Delaware Oaks victory, Luv Your Neighbor gives her sire his 41st career graded stakes winner.

Disobedient's first foal is Canadian Classic-placed Faber (Improbable), third in both the Breeders' Stakes and Prince of Wales Stakes. Most recently, she produced a colt by **Nyquist** in 2024 followed by a colt by **Constitution** last season and was bred back to the WinStar stallion. This represents the extended family of Champion grass mare and multiple Grade I/Group 1-winner Tepin (Bernstein).

A two-time Group 1 winner in her home country of Chile, and the 2024 champion 3-year-old filly as well, the mare made only two starts in 2025 after she was brought north, and changed trainers three times from Ignacio Correias after her 10th-place finish in last year's GII Pegasus World Cup Filly and Mare Turf Invitational Stakes to Chad Brown in her lone start at Saratoga.

On the sidelines since that late August jump, and moved to the barn of Saffie Joseph Jr. for her 2026 bow Feb. 28, she finally hit the board when claiming third in the GIII The Very One Stakes at Gulfstream. She was out of the money in the GIII Orchid and GIII Modesty Stakes Mar. 28 and May 1, respectively, before landing in Delaware for her first North American graded win.

Leaving the blocks as the 8-5 favorite, Dona Clota was in no rush from near the rear as **Storm Miami (Ire)** (Blue Point {Ire}) had her mind set on leading the procession and did, posting an opening half-mile in :51.89 and six panels in 1:17.53. Positions largely remained consistent until they hit the final bend and the closers inched closer on the front half of the field, led by Dona Clota from the outside. Kicking into another gear in the lane, she overhauled Storm Miami and **Bellezza (Ire)** (Siyouuni {Fr}) to her inside and held off **Alluring Angel (GB)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) by a neck in a blanket finish. Storm Miami crossed the line in third.

After the race, there was an immediate Stewards' inquiry into the traffic problems on the rail and they concluded that Storm Miami caused enough interference against Bellezza to warrant a disqualification. The latter was elevated to third and the former was moved back to fourth. The new order of finish was Dona Clota, Alluring Angel, and Bellezza.

"The trip was beautiful," said winning jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. "The main thing was trying to get her to relax. She had been keen the last couple of times. Today she was relaxed every step of the way. I just bided my time, found a hole at the quarter pole and she got it done."

Pedigree Notes:

Dona Clota is the most accomplished offspring for her winning dam, but is not the only group runner--her half-brother El Mero Mero (Chi) (Stay Thirsty) and full-brother Buenos Tiempos (Chi) have both hit the board in group races in Chile. Her winning half-sister is also a group producer as the mother of Group-placed De Esmeralda (Chi) Mendelssohn). **Cont.**

First dam Delfa (Chi) (Total Impact {Chi}) is herself a half-sibling to the mother of Chilean champion 2-year-old colt Demuestrame (Chi) (Stuka). That mare is also the granddam of Listed-placed Super Smash (Chi) (Ya Primo {Chi}). This is the extended female family of champion Dominguerio (Chi) and two-time Chilean Horse of the Year Wolf (Chi)--who also took home three other individual honors as champion and was a multiple Group 1 winner.

CLASSY GIMME A NOTHER COLLECTS EATONTOWN ON SEASONAL BOW

It may've been her 2026 debut after over nine months off, but the classy **Gimme a Nother (Saf)** (Gimmethelight {Aus}) had plenty left in the tank late to dominate the GIII Eatontown Stakes at Monmouth Park and kick off the Saturday graded action in a big way.

Untouchable in her native South Africa during her 2023 and 2024 seasons, her seven consecutive victories included three Graded wins and two Grade 1 wins, all at Turffontein, for trainer Michael de Kock. Purchased by North American connections and imported to the States last year, her 2025 campaign in the

Northern Hemisphere saw Gimme a Nother run second three times against Graded company and she entered the winner's enclosure last out Sept. 6 at Del Mar in the GII John C. Mabee Stakes. She defeated salty customers in that aforementioned race, including names like GSW & MGISP Medoro (Honor Code) and MGSW & MGISP Mission of Joy (Kitten's Joy).

Sent off here carrying 6-5 odds with **Whiskey Decision** (Into Mischief) crowned as the even-money favorite, Gimme a Nother broke well and initially looked like she might set the tempo, but was outkicked early for that spot by 99-1 **Creative Stuff** (Creative Cause) through an opening quarter in a casual :25.24 and a half-mile in :50.42 with no real rush to push the issue. The field closed ranks on the bend as the leader began fading and Gimme a Nother assumed command at the head of affairs with a building advantage in her corner. Responding well as Whiskey Decision tried and failed to reel her back in, the victress strode home to score by 3 1/2 lengths. The betting choice held second as **Grayosh** (Yoshida {Jpn}) ran on for third.

"We thought she might end up on the lead the way she has been running her last couple of starts, but it was fine that he let that [\$113.90 longshot Creative Stuff] set the pace with her right behind in slow fractions," said Ian Wilson, assistant to trainer Graham Motion. "There wasn't a ton of speed in the race so [jockey] Jorge [Ruiz] did exactly what we wanted him to do."

"She does know how to win, that's for sure. She was undefeated in South Africa before she came here. She had a bit of a slow start to her career in the United States but lately she has not done anything wrong. Even in her defeats she was very good."

Wilson continued, "With the Southern Hemisphere horses, it is quite a transition bringing them to the United States. We've done it in the past with South American horses, not so much horses like this from South Africa. It does take them a little time to get accustomed. It's not an easy thing."

Pedigree Notes:

Gimme a Nother hails from a female line of South African champion racemares and is one herself as the 2024 champion 3-year-old filly. Her dam, Nother Russia (SAf) (Tiger Ridge) was a two-time Grade 1 victress as well as being twice elite-placed with her later campaign being enough to be awarded the title of 2018 champion older mare. The second dam, Mother Russia (SAf) (Windrush), was also a multiple Grade 1 winner and was too crowned champion older mare in her time.

Beneath the fourth dam is yet another champion producing mare as Mother Russia's half-sister French Muse (SAf) (Melun) would lay claim to her own fame as the mother of South African Horse of the Year and champion older horse Winter Solstice (SAf) (Western Winter).

Gimme a Nother has three winning half-siblings, the youngest being 4-year-old Special Star (SAf) (Danon Platina {Jpn}).

JUSTIFY'S MIZUMI REMAINS PERFECT, STROLLS TO CONVINCING SUMMERTIME OAKS VICTORY by Patrycja Szpyra

As caller Frank Mirahmadi noted: she broke her maiden in May and is a Graded winner in June. Baoma Corp's **Mizumi** (Justify) ran to her looks, and strolled home to a convincing GIII Summertime Oaks victory in just her second career start.

Unveiled in the aforementioned May 2 maiden at this venue, she sailed through the 6 1/2-panel main track dash to earn an 85 Beyer, and stretched out to 1 1/16-miles for the first time here. The betting public was wholly unbothered by her being the least experienced in the field, and sent her off as the 3-5 favorite when the gate's opened.

Tracking from the rail as **Wolf Hill** (Upstart) kept **Daring Pursuit** (Not This Time) honest up front, Mizumi enjoyed a ground-saving trip behind opening fractions of :23.31 and a half-mile in:46.74 with the top two never far out of reach. In striking range entering the far bend after six panels in 1:10.67, the daughter of Justify was taken to the outside for racing room and had uncorked her rally as they were swinging for home.

Making up the distance to Wolf Hill with every stride, she quickly took command in the lane and sailed home to a dominating victory in her stakes debut. **Bank Shot** (Game Winner) looked to run a big race, but could not close the gap in the stretch and had to settle for third. **Cont.**

"That was really impressive for a second time out," said trainer Bob Baffert. "Ricky Gonzalez rode her the first time, filling in for Juan [Hernandez], but he rode her great that day. Today, second out to be stuck behind horses, Juan rode her with a lot of confidence. You could tell that she was just kicking on."

"We were just happy to get her to the races...It is nice to have a good 3-year-old filly like that. Now she is a stakes winner. I was really impressed with her myself."

"She was traveling beautifully when I was covered up," said Hernandez. "Around the turn when I swung out and started to make my run, she got lost a little bit, she was looking around. So I shook my hands and put her in the bridle and she took off and started running again. She won easy."

Pedigree Notes:

Mizumi is the first black-type horse for her dam, multiple Listed-placed Sweet Opportunity (Distorted Humor), who hails from the immediate female family of GSW Strike Power (Speightstown). She is the fourth offspring to get her picture taken from as many to the races and the third to become a multiple winner. Her youngest half-siblings are a yearling filly by Medaglia d'Oro and a 2026 Authentic filly.

In addition to Strike Power, this is also the extended family of GSW Five G (Vekoma) and GSP Early On (**Union Rags**). The pedigree is also active in Japan with stakes-place millionaire Hyuma (Any Given Saturday) to its credit. The fourth dam is GI Santa Anita Oaks heroine Golden Treat (Theatrical {Ire}), whose various branches of the family produced GSW Ice Cream Silence (**Street Sense**) in addition to eventually yielding Mizumi.

Freedom's Not Free, who waited for the last possible moment to make his presence felt in his seasonal debut, was up just in time to nail Sumter on the line to win Saturday's GIII Daytona Stakes at Santa Anita.

Sent off at 5-1 in his first start since a second-place finish in last August's GII Del Mar Derby, Freedom's Not Free settled in midpack just behind favored Sumter as longshot Modus Bestia

(**Maclean's Music**) led the field through a sharp opening quarter in :21.84. Turning for home, Irish Royalty (Grazen) gained control as Sumter narrowed the gap on the front runners while Freedom's Not Free seemed to lag a hair as his main rival scooted away from him. Down the stretch, Sumter took over a furlong from home and appeared to be home free, however, Freedom's Not Free switched to another gear and caught the frontrunner in the final step, getting his head down on the wire. First Peace was up to grab third.

Freedom's Not Free needed three tries to graduate, but finally got the job done when debuting on the grass in a six-furlong test at Santa Anita in January of his sophomore season. Subsequently third in the 6 1/2-panel Baffle Stakes at that venue, the dark bay won his next two starts--the Pasadena Stakes and Cinema Stakes--both going a mile at Santa Anita.

Third in last summer's American Derby at Churchill Downs, he was only a 1/2-length back in second behind The Padre (Ire) (Ghaiyyath {Ire}) in Del Mar's La Jolla Handicap before setting the pace and getting caught late by that rival in the Del Mar Derby.

"[Trainer Mark Glatt's] been talking highly, for months now really," said Scott Sherwood of co-owner Blinkers On Racing. "He was 3-year-old when he left and he is a bigger, stronger 4-year-old now. You can see it. He is a good-looking animal and Mark had him ready."

"I thought he was too far back, if you know any of his races, he has always sat just off the pace. But that going a mile or a mile and an eighth. I thought, 'oh, geez, he's too far back.' But he had clear sailing and he showed a turn of foot he has never shown."

The son of The Big Beast began his 2026 with an electric victory in the G2 1351 Turf Sprint at King Abdulaziz Racecourse in mid-February, and checked in fourth a month later at Meydan in the G1 Al Quoz Turf Sprint. Sent home after those jumps, he denied defending champion Ag Bullet (**Twirling Candy**) in his first start back in North America last weekend during the Belmont Stakes Racing Festival.

"I think [Reef Runner's next race] will be the Troy, which is two months from now," trainer David Fawkes said. "I'll be honest with you, between running in Saudi Arabia and running in Dubai and then coming back home to run so big in New York, I'm not in a big rush to run him back in 10 days, if you know what I mean. I'm going to give him a little extra time."

Reef Runner earned an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint this October at Keeneland with his win in the Jaipur.

Previously a major player on Triple Crown trail last year, Burnham Square has reinvented himself this spring as a turf marathon specialist. Last year's GI Blue Grass Stakes winner has won his last two starts, both graded stakes at 1 1/2 miles, by a combined 14 1/2 lengths for trainer Ian Wilkes.

Dropped out of graded company for the first time this season, the 1-9 favorite had to work for it Saturday in the Chorleywood Stakes. Drawn inside in this three-turn affair, Burnham Square was forwardly placed, racing alongside Chapman's Peak early. Able to scoot clear of that rival with a lap to run, the favorite began opening up a gap down the backstretch through the mile in 1:39.74. But Chapman's Peak wasn't finished and re-issued his challenge as the sprint for home began. The pair bobbed heads to the line with Burnham Square prevailing by a neck to keep his win streak intact.

"They made him run today," winning rider Brian Hernandez Jr. said. "It was a different strategy than normal. He got a little aggressive going into the turn but he traveled nicely once we got on the lead. He really had to sprint home to put (Chapman's Peak) away. Once he saw that horse, he really took off again. His class really showed today."

Out of a dual-surface mare who sold for \$55,000 at the 2024 Keeneland January Sale, Burnham Square has a 2-year-old **Oscar Performance** half-brother purchased for \$400,000 by Greenwell Thoroughbreds as a yearling at Keeneland last year. His dam has since produced a yearling **Life Is Good** filly and a filly by **Gun Runner** this spring.

Second dam Rising Tornado is also responsible for champion older mare Close Hatches (First Defence), who in turn produced GII Wood Memorial winner and MGISP **Tacitus** (**Tapit**); GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Scylla (**Tapit**) and Grade III winner Batten Down (**Tapit**).

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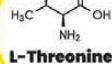

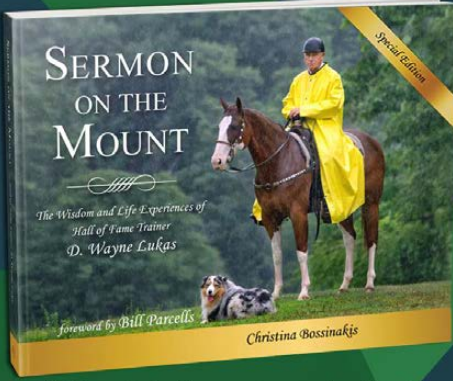

Already one of the six herself, having conquered the Poule d'Essai des Poulisches with the minimum of fuss four weeks ago, Ballydoyle's unbeaten starlet bids to join an elite band by adding this prestige affair to Longchamp's Classic and Prix Marcel Boussac. Remarkably, just a quartet have achieved that feat in history and two of those were Allez France and Zarkava, who continue to be discussed with suitable reverence. The other pair Divine Proportions and Blue Rose Cen were hardly shrinking violets too and it seems highly likely that we will see Chicquita's half-sister avenge her defeat at the hands of Treve in the 2013 renewal.

O'Brien, whose clutch on the season's three-year-old monuments is bordering on a monopoly at present, could offer no negatives this week. "She's good, very straightforward. She's well-balanced and very like her sire," he said of the blueblood, who bids to complete Ryan Moore's set off English, Irish and French Classics. **Cont. p3**

AIDAN O'BRIEN DUO CLASH IN CORONATION

A total of 10 fillies, including Aidan O'Brien's English and Irish Guineas winners **True Love** (No Nay Never) and **Precise** (Starspangledbanner), have been entered in the G1 Coronation Stakes on Friday, June 19.

The duo face G3 Fred Darling Stakes second **Touleen** (Lope De Vega) from the Owen Burrows yard. The filly finished sixth behind True Love in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket.

"She's well and seems good and it's all systems go for the Coronation," said Burrows. "We thought she had a good draw in the Guineas but it didn't end up being that way as Karl Burke's filly [Venetian Sun] didn't stay and Precise didn't run her race. We just got a bit stuck out there and Saffie [Osborne] had to move about and everything was happening away from her."

He added, "When he went up to a mile and a quarter, he improved again and everything she does is very like him really. Obviously, the Diane is a very prestigious race, very important for a filly and a tough race to win. I think she's even better on better ground and we're going to learn more on Sunday."

With 20 wins this century, the Diane has always been one of those Classics in which the French trainers have held their own but the stranglehold is slipping in the modern era despite the last three renewals staying at home. Four of the last eight have gone to England and Ireland and it is disconcerting that Sunday's edition sees just four fillies from domestic stables.

One of those is the Pouliches third **Green Spirit** (Kingman), but the length gap that separated her and Ballydoyle's luminary in the Marcel Boussac had grown to 4 1/2 last time and she has it to do over a trip that may not improve her. England's hopes are far stronger, with Ace Stud's 1,000 Guineas runner-up **Evolutionist** (Night Of Thunder) joined by James Wigan's Michael Seely Memorial winner **Lilt** (Lope De Vega) and TBT Racing's Musidora runner-up **Felicitas** (Teofilo).

It is the daughter of the Wigan's high-flyer Dank who excites the most, drawing William Haggas into a notably bold commitment with a filly having only her third start. The wide draw in 10 could have been much kinder, but Lilt could be one of those rarities capable of overcoming the odds.

"She's going up in distance, which hopefully will suit her and that's what should bring about some improvement," Haggas said on Thursday's *Nick Luck Daily Podcast*.

Haggas added, “She’s a big filly and she’s from a family that do better as they get older. We thought the mile looked the bare minimum for her at York, but she was still classy enough to win. She hit a bit of a flat spot, which I suspect she might do again on Sunday, but she should come home well hopefully. Whether it’s well enough, we’ll see.”

Also on Sunday’s card is the G3 Prix Bertrand du Breuil Longines, where last year’s Prix du Moulin hero **Sahlan** (Wootton Bassett) bids to get back on track after a tame eighth in the Lockinge, and the G3 Prix du Lys Longines for the Grand Prix de Paris prospects. Andre Fabre holds the record with 15 wins, but none since Flintshire in 2013 so he’ll be looking to either the Wertheimers’ Prix de l’Avre scorer **Rumoriste** (Frankel) or the Niarchos Family’s Prix Noailles runner-up **Space Waltz** (American Pharoah) to end the drought.

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LUCKY VEGA FILLY PREVAILS IN ARCADIA

In this series, the TDN takes a look at notable successes of European-based sires in North America. This week’s column is highlighted by the victory of Cortina d’Amprezzo at Santa Anita.

Nothing But Luck

Cortina d’Amprezzo (Lucky Vega) got the job done for trainer Phil D’Amato at Santa Anita on June 11 ([video](#)). The three-year-old filly races for Hopeless Stables, Little Red Feather Racing, Medallion Racing, McNulty Thoroughbreds, Veranda Stables, and Omar Aldabbagh.

Bred by Mountarmstrong Stud, she changed hands for €26,000 as a Goffs Autumn yearling when picked up by Sean Grassick Bloodstock. Trained initially by Kevin Thomas Coleman for Tim and Jack Halley, the filly placed in both of her Irish starts last May and June, before transferring to these connections. Out of the juvenile winner Reflect Alexander (Kodiac), herself a relation to G1 Prix du Jockey Club winner-turned-sire Old Vic, Cortina d’Amprezzo is the last known foal, and fourth winner from four to race for her dam.

The Irish National Stud’s Lucky Vega, priced at €12,500 this season, has two winners from two runners in the U.S. Worldwide, the son of Lope De Vega is credited with five stakes winners ranging from New Zealand, Australia, the U.K. and Germany. [Cont. p5](#)

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Dubawi Filly Gets In On The Action In Canada

D.J. Stable's **Majaz** (Dubawi), second five times in seven U.K. starts, graduated at Woodbine on June 13 ([video](#)). Trained by U.S./Canadian Hall of Famer Mark Casse, the four-year-old filly was bred by Floors Stud and Coolmore Stud.

An 450,000gns Tattersalls October Book 1 graduate, Majaz raced in the colours of Shadwell Estate Company for trainer Roger Varian. Sold for 45,000gns at the 2025 Tattersalls December Mares Sale, Majaz debuted for her new connections on Saturday.

A granddaughter of the five-time Group 1 winner and dual Guineas heroine Attraction (Efisio) through her multiple graded stakes-placed dam Cushion (Galileo), Majaz is a full-sibling to the gelding Hafit, who was third in the G2 Queens Vase and G3 Zetland Stakes.

Darley's former champion sire Dubawi now has 50 winners from 95 runners in North America. Twenty-six of those are stakes winners with 11 Grade I winners topped by In Italian, a four-time victress of the highest tier.

He added, "I would like to think Ascot would suit her a lot better track-wise. The twice she has run at Newmarket she hasn't handled the undulations the best so we're hoping Ascot will prove better for her.

"She's got four or five lengths to make up and I'm not saying she is going to win it, but I would be disappointed if she's not making up a few lengths on them."

Fourth in the Guineas was Ed Walker's G2 Rockfel Stakes runner-up **The Prettiest Star** (Starman), who is also entered, although that filly is also possible for next Saturday's G3 Jersey Stakes. Sir Mark Prescott's multiple group-placed **Moon Target** (Cracksman), yet to debut this year, is another Coronation hopeful.

Donnacha O'Brien sends GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf scorer **Balantina** (Ten Sovereigns), while Paddy Twomey's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas fourth **Black Caviar Gold** (Havana Grey) is also signed on.

Bond Thoroughbreds' Charlie Bond said of Black Caviar Gold, "Black Caviar Gold is in great form and we're looking forward to next Friday.

"It was a big run in the Irish Guineas on ground conditions she wouldn't really like and if there is a bit of rain around next week at Ascot it would be a boost."

Charlie Johnston's German 1000 Guineas heroine **Timeforshowcasing** (Showcasing) is part of the field, as is Richard Hughes's **Rose Ghaaiyyath** (Ghaiyyath). The duo are owned by Jaber Abdullah. Rounding out the field is G3 Fred Darling Stakes victress **Sukanya** (Havana Grey) from the yard of Jack Channon.

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VENETIAN SUN "IN GREAT FORM" AS COMMONWEALTH CUP ENTRIES OUT

G1 Prix Morny heroine **Venetian Sun** (Starman) is one of 25 horses remaining in the G1 Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot on Friday, June 19. She was a G3 Albany Stakes winner at two at Ascot.

The Karl Burke trainee failed to stay in the G1 1000 Guineas, but made up for that effort with an impressive win in the G2 Sandy Lane Stakes over **Division** (**Kingman**) later in May.

Sean Graham, racing manager to part-owner Tony Bloom, said of the filly, "Venetian Sun is in great form and came out of the race at Haydock in great shape, with Karl very happy with her.

"We would love to see her run well at Ascot and then it could open so many possibilities for her sprinting. It's nice to go there with such a high-class filly and the one thing about it is, it was a team decision to go for the Guineas and it is something we had to do.

"Her run in the Moyglare [Stud Stakes, at the Curragh last September] didn't really tell us much and we were always hopeful that she might get the mile because she is so relaxed in her races. But the Guineas showed she didn't and Clifford [Lee, jockey] immediately said she's just a fast filly who didn't stay.

"It made the decision to go back sprinting easy. If she had finished fifth or sixth you might have been tempted to go again in the Irish 1,000 Guineas and then you don't really know where you are.

"We learned nice and early where we are and it made that decision to go back to six furlongs so much easier."

Aidan O'Brien has a three-horse presence in the Commonwealth Cup. G3 Marble Hill Stakes hero **Albert Einstein** (Wootton Bassett) was one of the talking horses over the winter, but after only placing in the G3 Greenham Stakes and Listed Carnarvon Stakes, the latter to **Song Of The Clyde** (Sergei Prokofiev), he comes to Ascot with something to prove. Fourth to Venetian Sun in the Sandy Lane was multiple Group 1/-placed **Brussels** (Wootton Bassett), and G2 Norfolk Stakes victor **Charles Darwin** (**No Nay Never**) will also line up.

Besides Song Of The Clyde, Clive Cox will also run **Coppull** (**Bated Breath**), successful in the G3 Commonwealth Cup Trial Day Stakes.

Carnarvon Stakes third **Havana Hurricane** (Havana Gold) will represent Eve Johnson Houghton, and fourth that day was Charlie Appleby's **Wise Approach** (Mehmas). Jim Boyle's G1 2000 Guineas fourth **Into The Sky** (Starman) is another given the option of dropping back in distance, likewise Robson De Aguiar's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas fourth **Power Blue** (Space Blues) and Simon and Ed Crisford's Rockfel Stakes scorer **Zanthos** (**Sioux Nation**) after her run in the G1 French 1000 Guineas.

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NEW INFORMATION ON SHERGAR'S DEATH REVEALED BY PRINCESS ZAHRA

New information regarding the death of kidnapped stallion **Shergar**, has been revealed by Princess Zahra Aga Khan, the daughter of the colt's late co-owner, Aga Khan IV.

A winner of the 1981 G1 Derby by a record 10 lengths and a brilliant racehorse, the son of Great Nephew is best known for his kidnapping from the Aga Khan's Ballymany Stud in Ireland on February 8, 1983.

At the time, the IRA were the main suspects behind the kidnapping, which involved six armed men. The prevailing thought is that his abductors were ill-equipped to control a thoroughbred stallion, and that he was killed shortly afterwards. His remains have never been found.

Princess Zahra Aga Khan has now described how a ransom of £2 million that was demanded for Shergar's safe return was not paid out of fear the money would be "used against human beings" and revealed the horse had not been insured against kidnap.

She told *Telegraph Sport*, "We now know the horse was killed within two days [of being taken]. They did so in an awful way."

Another complication for the Aga Khan IV for paying the

ransom was that Shergar was owned by a syndicate and they all needed to agree.

Princess Zahra, who was 12 at the time, said, "Dad was so upset, there was great disbelief. People didn't understand the horse was syndicated and the ransom demand was only for 10% of his stud value.

"I remember Dad saying over and over, not only was the horse not insured against kidnapping--because who the hell was going to think of kidnapping a horse--but because the horse was syndicated he couldn't get everyone to agree on what to do.

"He also argued that even if he could pay the ransom, he couldn't do so if [the money] was going to be used against human beings."

Princess Zahra said, "It was very unprofessionally done, and when they finally killed him they did so in an awful way.

"The horse didn't deserve that. Even as a stallion he was the kindest horse in the world, he was so unfairly treated.

"And why? He was a national symbol of Irish breeding and racing. It's a long time ago, it was a very different world and people had different motivations back then."

Shergar did leave a crop of 36 foals that arrived the year of his death. Five of them would go on to win stakes races, with G1 Irish St Leger winner Authaal a three-time Group 1 winner.

Words Of Truth went postward with a five-pound penalty for annexing last term's G2 Mill Reef Stakes and dominated the closing stages of this second black-type start to notch a fourth career success.

"The ground is probably a bit on the dead side, which from his form last year was always going to suit him," explained Alex Merriam. "He needed to run and he probably wasn't going to be

quite good enough for [Royal] Ascot, so this was a suitable race. It's a stiff five furlongs here, he could probably go six and we're happy. There are no major plans, but we'll look at races over six and go from there." Oisin Murphy added, "He's a beautiful horse with lots of quality. He has to come along a fair bit, but the [G1 British Champions] Sprint on Champions Day on soft ground at the backend of his three-year-old career could suit."

Positioned in a handy third after an alert break, the 15-8 pick loomed large travelling well soon after passing halfway and was ridden out once quickening to the fore with 150 yards remaining to easily assert superiority.

Words Of Truth is the third foal and scorer produced by G2 Prix du Calvados and G3 Prix Six Perfections winner Beyond Reason (Australia), herself a daughter of GIII Gallorette Handicap victrix No Explaining (Azamour).

The Godolphin homebred, one of his sire's 164 stakes winners, is a half-brother to G2 Superlative Stakes victor and G1 Dewhurst Stakes third Ancient Truth (Dubawi) and a yearling filly by Space Blues.

Gregory had endured an unsuccessful streak of eight--which included a third in 2024's G1 Goodwood Cup--after going three-for-three in Royal Ascot's 2023 G2 Queen's Vase and came back off a 476-day break and a wind operation last year to embellish his black-type tally in gutsy fashion.

"He had a hell of a long time off and everyone's played a part in this [comeback]," said James Doyle. "Holly Campbell, who looks after a lot of our recuperating horses, has taken her time and done a marvellous job. I always felt there was another big day in this horse and I think there's better things to come from him. Usually, he's off the bridle like four or five furlongs out and makes you work hard, but he travelled really good today."

He added, "I was down inside the three-furlong marker on the bridle and I knew he would hit the line hard. I think the staying division is pretty decent and he does need to improve a bit more now."

Wathnan's six-year-old headed postward as a 13-2 chance and stalked Al Qareem (Awtaad) in second for most of this marathon. Bounding to the front racing along the far-side rail approaching the quarter-mile marker, he came under stern urging thereafter and was driven out to subdue Tabletalk and Mount Athos by a neck and the same.

Gregory, one of his sire's 20 black-type winners, is the third of six foals and leading performer thrown by G2 Park Hill victrix Gretchen (Galileo).

"I had a near miss here yesterday so it was good to finish in front," commented Australian rider Zac Lloyd after continuing his preparation for a first appearance at Royal Ascot. "I didn't want to be boxed in and make him dash up the last furlong-and-a-half, but a gap appeared in front of me and I had to ask him to go in there sooner than what we would have liked. He was a sitting duck two furlongs out and, full credit to him, I thought he was gone at the 100-metre mark, but he surged again. Luckily, my horse was game and I won comfortably at the line, but he done most of the work."

Thunder Call is the seventh of eight foals and one of six scorers for his dam Diala (Iffraaj), who is out of a winning half-sister to G3 Schwarzgold-Rennen runner-up Lukrecia (Exceed And Excel).

He is a half-brother to G3 Craven Stakes winner and G1 2000 Guineas third Skardu (Shamardal) and a two-year-old colt by Zoustar, while his fourth dam is the multiple Group 1-placed G2

Last to come off the bridle in the straight, the 2-1 favourite weaved a passage into the clear approaching the final furlong and kept on powerfully to prevail by two lengths from Andesite (Pinatubo).

"He's nice and he's definitely Group-race material, but whether he's top-class we'll have to wait and see," Sheikh Juma Dalmook Al Maktoum's racing manager Philip Robinson said. "He had a tendency in his early days to jump on the right rein and hang left and it's very pleasing now to see that he's running straight as a die and going forward. That's a great thing in itself. We'll take it one step at a time and, hopefully, this is a stepping-stone to a Group race. I know the owner is very keen to go on for Group races as soon as possible."

Extremely Zain is the ninth of 10 foals and fifth scorer thrown by an unraced full-sister to three-time Group 1-winning distaffer Lush Lashes (Galileo) and the stakes-placed Claudio Monteverdi (Galileo).

The winner, who hails from the family of G1 Deutsches Derby-winning sire Buzzword (Pivotal), is a half-brother to the stakes placed Urban Dancing (Distorted Humor) and the unraced two-year-old colt Ground Control (Space Blues). CLASS PREVAILS FOR TRON BOLT IN WET JJ

James McDonald was vindicated for his decision to not jump off of exciting Toronado colt **Tron Bolt** for the G1 JJ Atkins Plate when the colt defied a sucking Heavy 9 track at Eagle Farm on Saturday to clinch the 2026 edition of the race.

Despite a less than perfect exit from the barriers that saw the colt in the latter half of the field as the 1600-metre feature got underway, McDonald guided the colt forward to catch up to **Cormier** (Maurice). The latter dug deep to stay ahead, but Tron Bolt dug deeper still, grinding his opposition down to win by a shade under a length, with stablemate **Stormy Marc** (Wootton Bassett) storming home for third for the same connections.

Trainer Chris Waller last won the race for the same connections, Hermitage Thoroughbreds, when training The Autumn Sun to win the race in 2018. The victory was a landmark win on several levels for McDonald, taking his record to 141, but also extending his tally for the season to a new high water mark of 17.

"I feel very humbled and privileged to be in this position," McDonald said. "To ride horses like that who give me great rides, I thought he was exceptional today. It is nice to stand alone."

"It's the race that we pick out from a long way out," said Waller. "It's an integral part of the Queensland Winter Carnival, it's been a massive stepping stone for a lot of our great horses, this race in particular. Even without winning it, Brazen Beau ran second, Zoustar ran second, they've come out to be multiple

Group 1 winners and champion sires. It really is a neat race.

"He's a real cool dude. Nothing worries him. He really is a special horse for that reason and obviously he can run fast as well. But that attitude, that'll take him a long way. It is all class, and it shows he's not under pressure. He's having a pretty good day out."

Waller has already pencilled in a few targets for the colt's spring, headlined by the G1 Caulfield Guineas - a race also won by The Autumn Sun, who scored four Group 1 wins in his 3-year-old season.

"With [stud] values, you always try and win something shorter, like a Golden Rose at our home track," Waller said. "We try to use the Golden Rose as a stepping stone to either a Coolmore up the [Flemington] straight, but for this horse's example it would be more a Caulfield Guineas."

Tron Bolt was originally purchased by Hunter Lodge and Liam Ruddy for A\$250,000 from the Gilgai Farm draft at the 2025 Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale. He was then re-offered by Hunter's Lodge at the 2025 Inglis Ready2Race Sale, where Hermitage Thoroughbreds paid A\$900,000 for the son of Toronado.

Pedigree Notes

Tron Bolt is the first foal out of Baccarat Baby (Casino Prince), whose eight victories include the G3 Sunshine Coast Guineas and the Listed Princess Stakes. She was purchased by Dermot Farrington on behalf of Gilgai at the 2022 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Broodmare Sale Spendthrift Dispersal for A\$900,000.

Baccarat Baby is a three-quarter-sister to the Group 2 and Listed winner Philia (All Too Hard), who sold at this year's Inglis Chairman's Sale to Katsumi Yoshida for A\$1.4 million, and a half-sister to the triple Group 1 winner Duais (Shamus Award). This is also the extended family of the very successful stallions Flying Spur and Encosta De Lago.

Baccarat Baby has most recently left a Toronado yearling colt, who was a A\$110,000 Magic Millions Gold Coast National Weanling Sale purchase last year for Headline Thoroughbreds. She has yet to produce another live foal.
