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RECORD-SETTING 2YO SALE SEASON CONCLUDES WITH OBS JUNE

The 2-year-old auction season, which has set records at each of its major stops this spring, reaches its denouement with the three-day Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's June 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale which begins Tuesday morning at 10:30 a.m.

"We hope so," OBS Director of Sales Tod Wojciechowski said when asked if the June sale could continue the company's record-setting streak. "There are a lot of good horses on the grounds. So far, we have seen a lot of activity in the barns. We are always optimistic."

The OBS March sale opened the season with a record-tying seven million-dollar juveniles, as well as its highest-ever gross.

PROPOSED H2-A VISA LEGISLATION CHANGES OPENS DOOR TO BACKSTRETCH WORKERS by Dan Ross

A raft of changes to the H-2A Temporary Agricultural Worker Program woven into the recently introduced **Securing Agriculture's Workforce Act** could open up the visa to the immigrant backstretch workforce.

Designed specifically for agricultural workers, the H-2A program has for a long time effectively excluded equine backstretch workers from participation as it is designed for non-immigrant ag' workers who perform seasonal or temporary jobs.

"For decades, that has been strictly defined in regulations to mean the length of the job contract is limited to 10 months and the underlying job must be BOTH seasonal and temporary," according to a governmental factsheet on the proposed legislation.

The Securing Agriculture's Workforce Act, introduced by House agriculture committee chairman Glenn "GT" Thompson, would change that by stipulating H-2A visas are for agricultural labor or services of a temporary nature only, "removing the requirement that it also be seasonal," the **governmental factsheet** states.

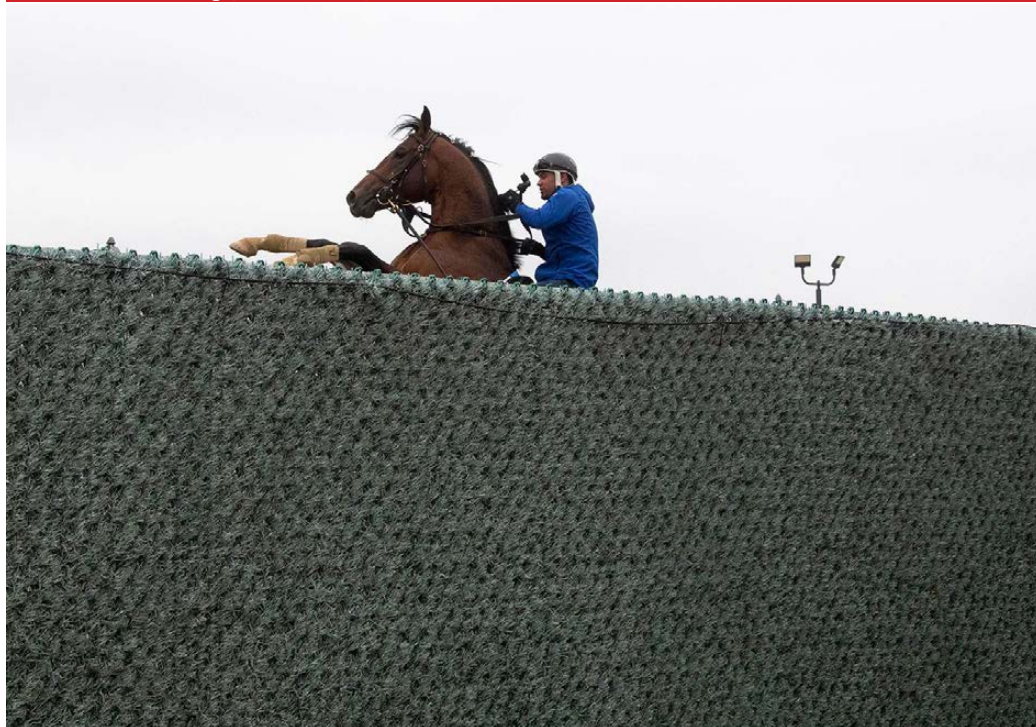

The company's Spring sale in April set highwater marks for gross, average, and median, but those records were largely eclipsed by the auction's \$10.5-million sale-topping son of **Flightline**. And the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic May 2-Year-Olds in Training sale recorded its highest gross, average and median in Maryland last month.

"I think all you have to do is look at the results every day and see the number of 2-year-old sales graduates that are winning races, breaking their maidens, and winning big stakes races," Wojciechowski said of the demand for horses. "So I contribute it mainly to the results that people are seeing with horses that they purchase from the 2-year-old sales."

The OBS June sale set its own records a year ago. A filly by **Curlin** brought the auction's highest-ever price of \$975,000, while the two-day sale had its highest average and median.

"I think I said a year or two ago that this isn't your father's June sale," Wojciechowski said. "It's grown up into its own sale. I think as time has pushed sales calendars later in the year, both yearling and 2-year-old sales, that it makes sense that there is a group of horses that are slated for June."

Consignor Jesse Hoppel, who sold his first million-dollar juvenile at the March sale, said he has horses who fit best in the June sale and have been targeted specifically towards the final major sale of the season.

"I aim horses for this sale every year," Hoppel said after sending out a filly by Vekoma (**hip 876**) to share the quarter-mile bullet time of :20 2/5 during last week's under-tack preview. "Some people come here because it was Plan B. I've got a lot of horses here where it was Plan A all along. The fact that they're standing up doesn't surprise me either. They were meant to come here and do well."

Omar Ramirez is another consignor who had his biggest sale to date this year when he sold a colt by **Speaker's Corner** for \$875,000 at the Spring sale. His 46-head June consignment includes a filly by **Central Banker** (**hip 59**) who shared the preview's furlong bullet time of :9 4/5.

"This is one of my favorite sales where I always try to bring good horses," Ramirez said. "This sale has always been good to me. And this has been a dream year for me. My clients gave me great horses, they trust me and gave me the opportunity."

In all, 500 horses sold through the ring last June for a gross of \$25,553,500. The average was \$51,107 and the median was \$25,000. After its abbreviated two-day renewal in 2025, when 903 horses were catalogued, the June sale returns to its three-day format in 2026, with 1,057 catalogued juveniles.

The June sale continues through Thursday and bidding begins each day at 10:30 a.m.

The proposed legislation, which contains language specifically related to the "management and training of equines," would also clarify that "temporary" is in relation to the "length of the job contract (a maximum of 350 days), rather than the underlying nature of the work being performed," the factsheet adds.

"While this legislation is within the jurisdiction of the Judiciary Committee, through my work traveling the country working on the farm bill, it was clear to me that the agriculture industry is in crisis when it comes to having the labor necessary to maintain a resilient food supply. The existing H-2A program is not sufficient to meet the needs of today, much less the demands of the future," wrote Thompson, in [a letter advocating](#) for the bill.

"When farms and ranches cannot secure the labor they need, the results are felt far beyond rural communities. This ultimately affects healthy food availability, consumer prices, and the economic strength of the broader food supply chain," Thompson added.

"There's broad definition to include equine, so, Thoroughbred and other sectors within our equine community are included," said Oscar Gonzales, vice chair of the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB), a long-time advocate in Washington for immigration reform as it relates to backstretch workers.

Gonzales served as deputy chief of staff to former secretary of agriculture Tom Vilsack.

Among the key provisions of the bill as written, Gonzales identified language allowing for existing

unauthorized workers to gain access to the program, provided they meet certain eligibility requirements (like background checks and an in-person interview).

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"Another part that is critical, the paperwork part of the legislation appears to be much more simplified and streamlined, so that an employer won't have to exhaust their resources to just get through the application process," said Gonzales.

Currently, the backstretch workforce has been largely limited to H-2B visas only.

The H-2B visa program affords non-agriculture seasonal immigrant workers jobs in such industries as hospitality or with animals, but has its limitations. It comes with a restrictive annual quota, and is typically only granted for a year, but it can be extended for up to three years.

According to Gonzales, he and Will Velie, an immigration attorney with close ties to the racing industry, are in the process of establishing their own political action committee, called the Horseman Labor PAC.

The committee, he said, is designed "to advocate politically, to be able to raise funds and support candidates who advocate equine labor issues."

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ASK HISA: DATA USAGE

With a view to pulling the veil back on the whys and wherefores of their operations, a representative of either the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act (HISA) Authority or the Horseracing Integrity and Welfare Unit (HIWU) will every week answer a question of industry importance posed by the TDN.

Q: Recently, there have been several posts online purporting to show *Daily Racing Form* past performances that include records of intra-articular injections. Some of the posts suggest that HISA has been selling the data to outside entities. What does HISA do with the data it collects? And moreover, what information should gamblers have access to, and where can they access this info?

Lisa Lazarus:

HISA would never sell individual horse health information without the consent of the Responsible Persons, and any suggestion otherwise is categorically false.

It is true that HISA is exploring monetizing data in an anonymized fashion to reduce the financial burden of HISA on the industry. However, no such agreement has been launched to date, and HISA will always seek consent from Responsible Persons before sharing any individual horse health information.

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Ask HISA cont.

Most importantly, the screenshots of PPs circulating online could not have come from the HISA Portal because some of the information is different from what is in the HISA Portal. So, while this information did not come from HISA, the importance of the aggregation of treatment records for horses in the HISA Portal cannot be overstated.

With all of the information that HISA is collecting, and through collaboration with technology companies like Palantir, we now have the opportunity to analyze the data to glean learnings that we can then translate into public knowledge. This was not possible prior to HISA's creation of a centralized database. These learnings will help prevent injuries and fatalities, inform best practices, enhance our rules and ultimately move our industry forward.

As it pertains to gamblers, individual horse health data is not

available for public consumption. Whether or not that data would be made available in the future is something that the industry must discuss and consider together. HISA, however, does currently maintain a public **Epistaxis and Unsoundness list** that is available to everyone registered with HISA via the HISA Portal.

Finally, we have shared our review into the potential source of these PP records and our conclusion that they did not

come from the HISA Portal, with other entities that might be the source of that information, and have encouraged them to conduct their own review to ensure the data is not being used for unauthorized purposes.

Note: HISA will be elaborating on what it does with the data in the coming weeks of this series.

Balloteer jumped out to a nice lead and maintained a safe cushion over fellow firster and even-money **Flightline** colt Greenwell. He breezed :10 1/5 and brought \$475,000 at OBS March despite zero stakes winners from 17 runners produced by his first two dams--although his third dam is 1989 sprint champion Safely Kept.

Since officially taking over from his late father 13 months ago, Clement has kept their stable humming with one added twist: his success with first-time starters. He has been winning at an 18% clip overall but at 26% with firsters--and the corresponding 13% flat-bet profit rises to 21% on grass. Big Destroyer is the latest example, rallying from slightly behind the leaders to score smartly in this grass sprint and key a 1-2 Clement finish.

In the early 2000s, the Wilsons experienced Grade I success with Early Pioneer and Designed for Luck, both \$62,500 claims by Cerin. By contrast, Kennyten was a \$140,000 OBS 2-year-old buy three months ago. Cerin quickly saw the colt was fast but wasn't sure he was fit enough yet to handle Zedan-Baffert 1/5 favorite Nayar, an \$850,000 purchase from the same sale. "I was wrong!" Cerin said after 8/1 Kennyten drew off by 7-1/2 lengths in the fastest Beyer by a 2-year-old thus far in 2026. Cerin credited another of the Wilsons' trainers, Michael McCarthy, for recommending the purchase, lavishing praise on McCarthy as a "future Hall of Famer."

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NEPAL UP IS ON HIS WAY HOME**Nepal Up** | Courtesy Robert Harr*by Bill Finley*

All Brad Altschuld wanted for his horse Nepal Up (Will Take Charge) was for him to go somewhere where he could enjoy his retirement, the type of situation where the owner would never have to worry about his horse's future. Nepal Up was about to turn 10 and had been put on the vet's list after a Sept. 1 starter handicap race at Monmouth. So Altschuld found someone who agreed to take the horse, a small-time breeder in Nebraska named Christina Nelson who said she was willing to give Nepal Up a chance as a stallion.

While Altschuld admits he doesn't have anything in writing, he says that Nelson agreed that she would not race the horse again. He also admits that he did not have the horse's foal papers updated to indicate that he was "sold as retired from racing."

Still, Altschuld was in disbelief when he saw that Nepal Up ran in a \$4,000 allowance race on June 7 at Chippewa Downs in Belcourt, North Dakota. He finished third and earned \$480.

"I am very worried about him," he said shortly after the race.

(According to a agreement signed by Altschuld and Nelson, Nepal Up was bred to 10 to 12 mares).

Eight days after the Chippewa Downs race, Altschuld got his wish. After he worked tirelessly to retrieve the horse and come up with a deal with Nelson, **Nepal Up arrived at a farm in Aberdeen, South Dakota early Monday morning**. In about two weeks, he will be shipped to Charter Oak Farm in Hot Springs, Arkansas. The farm is owned by Jill Neece and is where Altschuld has sent other retirees.

"I'll be happier when he's on the farm for good that he's going to stay at, but I'm glad that I did the right thing," he said. "I'm glad that he's going to have the life of retirement that he deserves and the retirement that I had planned for him."

To make his happen, Altschuld agreed to pay Nelson \$10,000 for the same horse he gave to her for free. The money was wired to her last week through her attorney.

"Do I think he got \$10,000 worth of care in the eight months she had him? I find that hard to believe," Altschuld said. "If it had been \$4,000 or \$6,000, I would have been covering the care. But she had me over a barrel. I wanted the horse back. I needed to have the horse out of the situation he was in and I didn't have much choice. I wasn't going to let money stand in the way of the best interests of the horse."

Nepal Up was special to Altschuld. He was the type of old warrior who was easy to fall in love with. He made 47 career starts and earned \$284,110. He won twice as a nine-year-old. Trained by Dan Ward, his biggest win came in the 2025 \$125,000 Trail's End, the mile-and-three-quarter race that is run as the last race on the last day of the Oaklawn meet. It is a race that Altschuld had always wanted to win.

But to Altschuld, every horse is special. That was ingrained him by his mother, Carla, who passed away in 2024 at the age of 77. Before her passing, she was partners with her son in the racing stable they named Brad's Equine Adventure.

"I was the only one in the family who was interested in horse racing, so for my birthday one year she got me a \$5,000 claimer and that's how I got interested in ownership," Altschuld said. "She just fell in love with the animals and their personalities. I know this is hot button topic now, but when they go down the ladder and they can no longer be competitive they're going to end up in situations where they're going to get passed around and you can no longer vouch for their well-being. She just didn't want to see that happen to them. When they were no longer competitive at the tracks we were racing at, which were Monmouth and Oaklawn at the time when she was still alive, that was time for them to be retired. Even though she isn't here to know of this story, I want her to be proud and to know that I have her tenacious spirit to fight for the horse. Both Dan Ward and my mom instilled in me that doing right by the horse is what really matters."

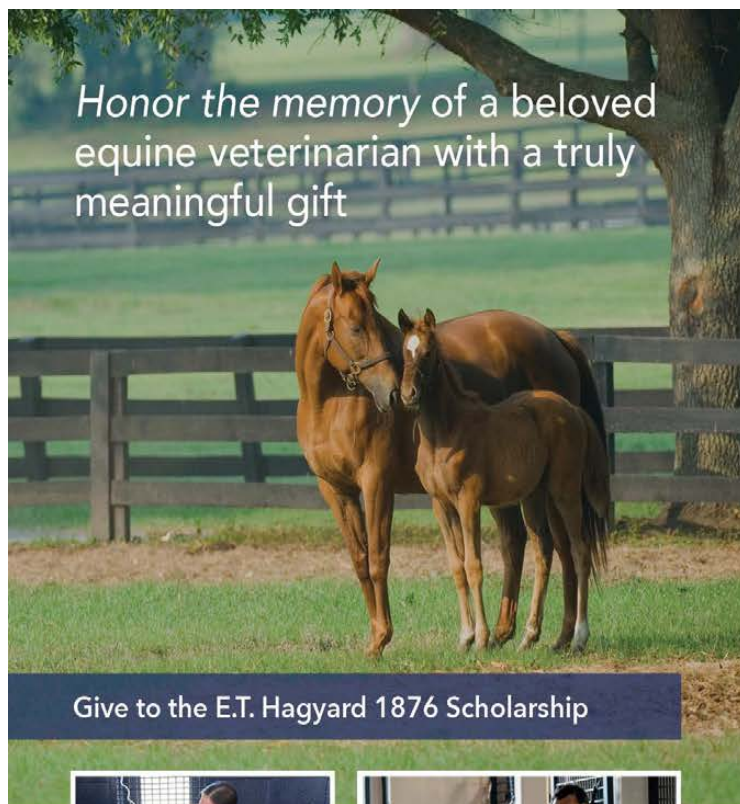
Altschuld says he has retired between 20 and 25 horses, some of whom have gone on to second careers and some that are pasture pets. Altschuld said he has yet to decide future plans for Nepal Up. But he knows that the horse in good hands and will live out his life safely and comfortably, the way Altschuld had always intended that he would.

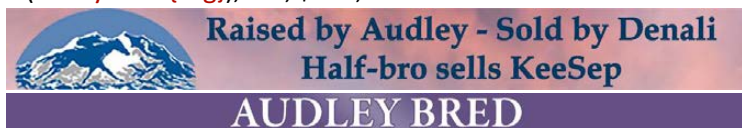

his time from midfield and improved past a rival to be fourth approaching the second bend behind a quick opening half-mile in :45.52.

Ridden along by Joel Rosario, the Virginia-bred Secured Freedom began to zero in on the gasping pacesetters and rolled up to poke his head in front four or five deep at the quarter pole. The bay colt, getting the blinkers off from Tim Yakteen, appeared to idle some, allowing One More Freud to loom a threat inside the final furlong, but Secured Freedom got his mind back on business in the final 40 yards and held sway to the line to score at the 13-10 chalk.

Secured Freedom was exiting a fourth to 'TDN Rising Stars' Crude Velocity (**Beau Liam**) and Englishman (**Maxfield**) in the GII Pat Day Mile at Churchill Downs on May 2, having finished fourth in the GII San Felipe Stakes and third in the GII Robert B. Lewis Stakes prior to that.

"He's a big horse and he's just late developing mentally," said Yakteen. "I think today was a big step forward. We took the blinkers off of him, he had a strong pace to run at, and Joel ended up taking advantage of all of that. We will regroup after this and figure it out. There are plenty of spots out there for 3-year-olds, we will just go from there."

The winner's dam, Securely, produced a colt by Maximus Mischief in 2025 and was bred back to **Prince of Monaco**.

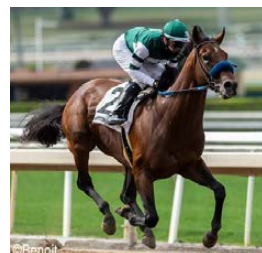

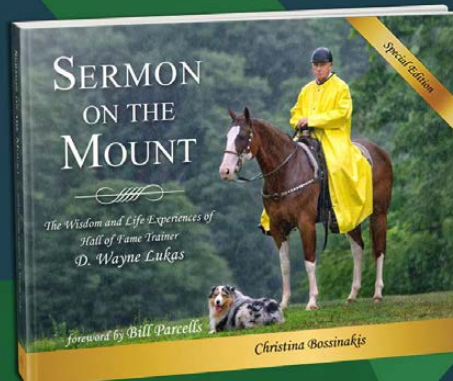

Kieren Fallon understands what it feels like to ride the wave for a period and he said, "He'll reach 100 and it won't make a blind bit of difference to Aidan. He will just roll on, keep doing the same thing and be back again with probably a better team next year. He's a genius of a trainer."

For everyone else, there is always the possibility of a temporary disturbance and occasional lightning strike. This year, the shift in the atmosphere comes via **Bow Echo**, the son of Night Of Thunder who bids to rain chaos on the status quo as he did under Billy Loughnane at Newmarket last month. The culmination of a lifetime's work by his late breeder Sheikh Mohammed Obaid occupies the eye of a stunning St James's Palace Stakes and is getting some notable press.

For most of us, comparison with that great disruptor **Frankel** is tantamount to heresy, but where this colt is concerned it is partly allowable, at least for now. He has to go and suppress Ballydoyle's formidable **Gstaad** (**Starspangledbanner**) again as he did in the Guineas, plus the not-inconsequential duo **Puerto Rico** (Wootton Bassett) and **Talk Of New York** (Wootton Bassett), and then we can discuss the matter further.

George Boughey is speaking the right kind of language ahead of such a defining moment. "When he was sent to me, Sheikh Mohammed Obaid said he was the horse that was going to change my career," he said. "He's got quite a few of the attributes you need for the track—he's got all the attributes to do anything really."

Talk Of New York, who is perhaps the feature race's most intriguing member due to his lack of exposure to this kind of competitive environment, is one of a trio charged with thrusting Charlie Appleby's Moulton Paddocks back to where it needs to be. While the yard's current campaign has been mostly a bit *meh*, he has provided a shot in the arm, along with **Notable Speech** (Dubawi) and **Opera Ballo** (Ghaiyyath), and it feels significant that they are all assembled on Tuesday.

It is fair to say that Notable Speech owes Godolphin very little but, after two flops at this meeting, a third-time lucky scenario would be most welcome. If it doesn't come in the opening Queen Anne, the Boys In Blue will be praying that Loughnane's white cap is in front at the line *a la* Cape Cross.

"This has the makings of a great race with the two Guineas winners, while we go in with untapped potential at this level," Appleby said of the St James's Palace. "We will see if Talk Of New York can rise to the occasion, but we have a lot of confidence in the horse and are looking forward to it."

He added, "People have a question mark against Notable Speech at Ascot, but I think on both occasions we did not have the rub of the green you need at this level. If he can put the Ascot hoodoo behind him, he should take all the beating.

Billy The Kid is starting out on his own odyssey, one that could span multiple Royal Ascots, Frankie-style, and he was typically ebullient at Windsor on Monday evening.

"One more sleep to go," he said. "Bow Echo is a dream to ride and a Group 1 at Royal Ascot would be huge. I've got a serious book of rides and Opera Ballo is one of them tomorrow. I'm hoping he can get the week off to a great start. It's a pinch-yourself moment to have these rides on the opening day at 20 years old."

Coolmore and Godolphin's fortunes are only two of the key elements at play this week. How last year's leading owners Wathnan fare is another. Their breeze-up splurges will have to pay some sort of dividend in the meeting's two-year-old tests, so it's a case of over to you **Royal Heritage** (Blue Point) and **Ruler's Pride** (Mehmas) in Tuesday's Coventry and **Alta Regina** (**Sioux Nation**) and **Wild Blossom** (Mehmas) in the following afternoon's Queen Mary. There's also **Light Of Dawn** (Showcasing) in the Albany on Friday and **Flight Signal** (Mehmas) in Saturday's Norfolk. All winners, all ready-made Ascot prospects about to prove the various investments either on the money or wide of the mark.

As if Wathnan didn't have an array of class horses to go to war with this week, they also have at their disposal the luminary James McDonald, whose five Royal winners include a treble in 2022. He is one of the more high-profile of the international cast heading to Berkshire this week, alongside the likes of US legend Johnny V whose first ride comes from leftfield in Tuesday's 14-furlong Copper Horse Handicap.

It is the sprints that are again home from home for the Australians, with **Overpass** (Vancouver) and **Asfoora** (Flying Artie) in the opening day's King Charles III and **Joliestar** (Zoustar) in Saturday's Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes.

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The Japanese contingent **Satono Reve** (Lord Kanaloa) and **Lugal** (Duramente) lie in wait in the latter contest, while Wesley Ward makes his return with four currently in the Norfolk. They include the impressive Woodbine winner **Ez Tina** who, if successful, will be avenging the defeat of her first-crop sire **Golden Pal** here in 2020.

As ever, France will be well-represented all week, but there will be extra gravitas in 2026 due to the current wave created in partnership by the Aga Khan Studs and Francis Graffard. They largely hold the key to the country's fortunes, with **Daryz** (**Sea The Stars**) looming large in the Wednesday feature Prince of Wales's. There really isn't much more that can be added to the existing reel of compliments sent his way, while the stable's Blue Point-sired sprinters **Rayevka** and **Samangan** have real chances in Tuesday's King Charles III and Friday's Commonwealth Cup, respectively. Interestingly, French sprint form held up particularly well here 12 months ago and the Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee sees another leading gallic dragster in **Sajir** (Make Believe) ply his trade.

Other talking points include the new Windsor Castle Stakes, reshaped to more accommodate the prospective milers than the fast and precocious and headed by Ballydoyle's **Sergei Diaghilev** (Wootton Bassett). That forces more of the sprint-breds into the Norfolk, one of a quartet of Breeders' Cup Challenge Series races shifted to Saturday for simulcasting on NBC. **Cont. p6**

SIX OF THE BEST

What a year 2026 is turning out to be for Darley's supersire and his stallion sons...



Brilliant 2,000 Guineas winner Bow Echo, fellow **future Darley stallion** Ombudsman, Portfolio Duration at Saratoga: three G1 winners so far this year for Champion sire **NIGHT OF THUNDER**, more than any other stallion in Europe.

Dubawi's lookalike stallion son, and his fastest – the G1 Platinum Jubilee winner **NAVAL CROWN** – is off to a flying start with his first crop of two-year-olds, with winners at Newmarket and Doncaster and runners at Royal Ascot.



Native Approach brings up a 13th G1 win for **TOO DARN HOT**, who sizzles (again!) at Inglis Easter and is sire of the winners of more juvenile Group races since 2023 than any other active worldwide stallion.



Remarkably, five of the nine runners in today's Queen Anne Stakes are by the breed-shaping **DUBAWI** or his sons – including his five-time G1 winner and **future Darley stallion** Notable Speech, already winner of the G1 Lockinge this year.



Last year, multiple G1 winner **SPACE BLUES** made the fastest G1-winning start at stud of any stallion by Dubawi – and now no sire standing in Ireland at under €40,000 has more Stakes-performing three-year-olds.

Those returning to defend their Group 1 crowns a year on are **Docklands** (Massaat), **American Affair** (Washington DC), **Trawlerman** (Golden Horn), **Time For Sandals** (Sands Of Mali) and **Ombudsman** (Night Of Thunder), with the latter making the Prince of Wales's a special renewal. In taking on an Arc hero in Daryz, who is coming in off scintillating efforts in France, as well as Sheikh Ahmed Al Maktoum's now fully-matured Tattersalls Gold Cup hero **Almaqam** (Lope De Vega), he has put a fire under what in some ways is the meeting's biggest prize.

The Gosdens, who remain powerhouse material at Royal Ascot, have managed to coax Trawlerman back into the frame for Thursday's Gold Cup, ski goggles and all. He faces **Scandinavia** (Justify) in another huge clash and, if he manages to ward off Ballydoyle's staying new boy, he will become the fifth horse this century to win more than one renewal of the meeting's beloved cornerstone.

Those looking for a "banker" for the week will mostly land on Friday's Coronation Stakes favourite **Precise** (Starspangledbanner) now that she has again shown why Aidan O'Brien has her on a pedestal.

On the same day, last year's Albany winner **Venetian Sun** (Starman) will start at short odds in the Commonwealth Cup representing a trainer in Karl Burke who, in statistical terms, is one of the "Mr Royal Ascots". Another is Harry Eustace, who is a remarkable four-from-12 here over the last five years, while Willie Mullins, Ed Walker and Saeed bin Suroor are others who strike gold with relative regularity.

After O'Brien has reached his own milestone, Ryan Moore is sure to be a lot closer to his own century. On 92 at present, it is not inconceivable that he could make it this week having ridden a remarkable nine winners in 2015 and seven in both 2022 and 2025. Atop all the thrilling action set to unfold, embrace the sight of two of the sport's greats combining to bend history to their will.

One of the highest-rated runners by Starman, Green Sense made a blistering debut at the Curragh last year, before securing that Group 2 triumph in the Prix Robert Papin at Chantilly. Other notable performances include a third-placed effort behind Power Blue in the G1 Phoenix Stakes at the Curragh.

Boyd added, "Boyd Racing's strategy is to buy fillies who will go on to have great, successful careers and then be broodmares. Right now we have eight fillies and two colts. Most of them are up in Saratoga, and we have two older mares with Bob Baffert, Seismic Beauty and Splendora, who won the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint last year. We also bought Vahva at Keeneland in November and she was just bred to **Not This Time**.

It was a good day at the office for Green Sense's former owners, Simon Munir and Isaac Souede, as they also sold recent six-length Pontefract maiden winner **Green Sovereign** (Lot 2), who runs in the Windsor Castle Stakes at Royal Ascot on Wednesday, to Richard Ryan and Teme Valley Racing for £200,000.

The two horses were originally sourced by Anthony Bromley on behalf of Munir and Souede at Goffs yearling sales on either side of the Irish Sea, for €90,000 and £40,000. [Cont. p7](#)

"We're thrilled with the sale," said Bromley. "They're both scopey horses and we felt there was still plenty of racing ahead of them. They had to make their money and they have done. I'm thrilled with the results. I think they're both going to run this week."

While Green Sense managed to find a buyer, fellow Jersey Stakes entrant **Alparslan** (Dandy Man) was unsold at £1 million. Britannia Stakes entry **Bobby McGee** (Mayson) was unsold at £575,000, while **Immortal Guard** (Persian King), **Bamako Beach** (Sands Of Mali) and **Sky Watch** (Starman) were other high-profile lots who failed to hit the mark at £495,000, £330,000 and £300,000, respectively.

All told, just 11 of the 19 horses offered on Monday were sold with turnover reaching £2,970,000. For context, the turnover 12 months ago was £8,070,000 for 20 lots sold, while in 2024 the sale generated £8,395,000 in turnover for 15 lots sold. The average was £270,000, compared to £403,500 last year and £559,667 in 2024.

Commenting on Monday's edition of the sale, Goffs chief Henry Beeby said, "The 2026 London Sale was another enormous success in so many ways. Whilst the statistics are well behind last year, we don't measure this sale in the same way. Normally, we obsess over percentage rises or falls but with the London Sale it is an entirely different approach. Success at the London Sale is judged by the reaction of both vendors and purchasers and, by that measurement, we've had a very positive evening." [Cont. p8](#)

From Royal runners, to formidable teams and top-notch stallions bidding to break their Royal Ascot hoodoo, here are five things to watch out for on the opening day of the eagerly-anticipated meeting. It promises to be a week to savour.

Things Are Looking Rosy For Shapoor Mistry

Bidding to continue a glorious summer for Oaks-winning owner-breeder Shapoor Mistry is Rosy Affair (Havana Grey), who lines up for the G1 King Charles III Stakes. The five-year-old mare, who won the Listed Cecil Frail Stakes over six furlongs at Haydock on her last start, has been exciting her trainer George Boughey, who said last week, "She drops back to five, and I've been wanting to do that for a while. She's shown loads of pace at home. The quickest we've ever had a horse go over five furlongs was her [last Tuesday], so it gives me confidence to run five furlongs with her."

If successful, Rosy Affair would become the second Group 1 winner for her sire Havana Grey after Vandeeek, whose half-brother Gstaad ([Starspangledbanner](#)) returns to Royal Ascot for a rematch with Boughey's Bow Echo (Night Of Thunder) in the hotly anticipated G1 St James's Palace Stakes. Gstaad won the G2 Coventry Stakes on this day last year and could become the first Coventry winner since [Dawn Approach](#) (2012) to return to win the St James's Palace. [Emma Berry]

Can Mehmas And Sioux Nation Break An Important Duck?

Given the popularity of Mehmas and [Sioux Nation](#) at the breeze-up sales in particular, it might surprise that neither stallion has managed to sire a Royal Ascot winner to date. Mehmas is 0-78 heading into the royal meeting, but that does

not tell the whole story given that Persian Force was a narrow second in the 2022 Coventry Stakes and Lusail only went down by a head in the St James's Palace Stakes that same year. The Tally-Ho Stud resident is well-stacked for the week with Goffs Breeze-Up Sale-topping Mrair heading a five-strong challenge for the stallion in the Coventry Stakes, while Craven Breeze-Up graduate Wild Blossom has strong claims in the Queen Mary. As for [Sioux Nation](#), a Royal Ascot-winning two-year-old himself, he has had almost 20 runners at the royal meeting without a winner. Similar to Mehmas, he has a number of strong fancies bidding to break that unwanted duck this week, most notably Queen Mary fancy Alta Regina. [Brian Sheerin]

Expect Another Big Week For Night Of Thunder

Night Of Thunder's rise through the stallion ranks continues at frightening pace and Tuesday's card sees Kildangan Stud's kingpin enjoy serious prominence. In the Queen Anne, More Thunder looks primed for a big effort with a profile that more than hints at a Group 1 win, while the smart Ten Bob Tony and Zeus Olympios are proper understudies. The supplemented three-year-old Behike adds spice to the King Charles III, while in the St James's Palace he is represented by the big horse of the day and possibly the entire meeting. Bow Echo is one of the very finest 2,000 Guineas winners for many a year and is perhaps the

greatest testament so far to his sire's versatility as well as class. Then there is Ombudsman to look forward to on Wednesday... [Tom Frary]

More Wathnan Racing Domination?

Wathnan Racing's representation at Royal Ascot grows by the year and Tuesday begins with a bang for the operation. Why their Queen Anne runner Damysus ([Frankel](#)) is such a big price given that he flirted with favouritism for the Lockinge is a mystery and he'll love this track, while the breeze-up sensations Royal Heritage (Blue Point) and Ruler's Pride (Mehmas) head to the Coventry with big upside. Throw in the in-form Night Raider (Dark Angel) in the King Charles III, the classy Haatem (Phoenix Of Spain) and Map Of Stars ([Sea The Stars](#)) in the Wolferton and hot favourite Valiancy (Cracksman) in the closing Copper Horse and you have a formidable team. It'll be extremely difficult to

follow last year's exploits of ending the meeting as the leading owners, but they are well stacked to give it a good shot. [Tom Frary]

Racing was abuzz about the prospects of Willie Mullins training his first winner for the King and Queen when Reaching High ([Sea The Stars](#)) lined up for the Ascot Stakes at this meeting 12 months ago. Well, things couldn't have gone any worse

for the stayer when he endured a nightmare passage to finish a luckless ninth, beaten a little under four lengths under Ryan Moore. Reaching High will bid to gain compensation in the same race on Tuesday and there doubtless will be lots of punters more than happy to strap themselves in for the ride as he is likely to go off a pretty short favourite once again. Easing forward once into the straight, the 8-13 favourite came under a drive to launch her bid approaching the furlong pole and was ridden clear inside the final 150 yards to defeat Wise And Wonderful (Oasis Dream) by 3 1/4 lengths.

Starlight Mirage is the fourth foal and scorer produced by an unraced half-sister to the dam of Listed Premio Repubblica Marinare victrix Sa Filonzana (El Kabeir).

REDLINE (GB) (f, 2, Bayside Boy {Ire}--Elas Ruby {GB} {SW-Eng & GSP-Fr}, by Raven's Pass) broke smartly from an outer stall and raced in a handy fourth from the outset of this unveiling. Inching into third passing halfway, the 10-3 second favourite came under pressure with a quarter-mile remaining and kept on well in the closing stages to prevail by a half-length from Eleven Eighty Two (Ardad), becoming the eighth winner for her freshman sire (by New Bay).

Redline is the fourth of five foals and third scorer produced by stakes-winning G2 Prix de Malleret third Elas Ruby (Raven's Pass), herself a daughter of Listed Montrose Fillies' Stakes runner-up Elas Diamond (Danehill Dancer).

Quickening to challenge passing the two pole, the 6-1 chance seized control with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and stretched clear in the latter stages to easily account for Absolute Diamond (Kodiac) by seven lengths.

Miss Kodi, full to a yearling filly, is the first of two foals out of an unraced half-sister to G1 Prix Morny-winning sire Arcano (Oasis Dream).

Descendants of her second dam Tariysha (Daylami), herself a daughter of the dual Group 1-placed G3 Weld Park Stakes victrix Tarwiya (Dominion), also include the stakes-winning G2 July Stakes runner-up Platinum Star (Lope De Vega), Listed Prix La Camargo winner Tifosa (Kodiac) and Listed Naas Oaks Trial second Jaliyah (Mehmas). The outcome of this will depend on the pace that Billy Loughnane goes on **Opera Ballo**, who showed how much he appreciates being allowed to bowl along in front in the Sandown Mile. While the beauty of that willingness to dictate means that he is in here with his own agenda, it is impossible to escape the fact that a strong tempo is exactly what his illustrious stablemate **Notable Speech** needs and exactly what he didn't get when fourth in this 12 months ago. Also undone by slack early fractions in the 2024 St James's Palace, the often-brilliant Notable Speech comes into this contest which has seen winners return at 33-1, 14-1, 33-1 and 14-1 in recent years as a short-priced favourite who regardless of excuses is zero from two visits here. While Opera Ballo, who will sport the Godolphin blue with the white cap so often successful in this in the past, is no pacemaker he should also set things up perfectly for **More Thunder**. Campaigned initially over 10 furlongs by Sir Michael Stoute before being transformed into a six-furlong sprinter by William Haggas, he has gradually moved back up in trip with menace and his first start over this trip last time in the Lockinge saw him finish faster than the winner Notable Speech. This could be a renewal for the big favourites, with last year's surprise package **Docklands** unlikely to enjoy the same pace scenario and fast ground counting against the QEII shocker **Cicero's Gift**, but if there is one to cause a minor upset it could be **Damysus** who will be much more at home at Ascot than he was at Newbury on his first try at the trip. Bar the absent Rayif, this epic renewal of one of the week's best races sees all the main actors at the trip converging with **Bow Echo** very much the leading man on his impressive 2,000 Guineas success. One of the finest to grace that Classic, *full stop*, he faces a different test here over this stiff mile where it could be that he is put into the red for the first time by **Puerto Rico** and **Gstaad**. He's so good it's hard to find any weak spot, but from stable reports it could be that he is getting faster all the time and he might be more vulnerable here than elsewhere due to the track's demanding nature. Gstaad is one of Ballydoyle's best milers of recent times and it is worth noting that he recorded a time nearly a second faster than Field Of Gold's in the Irish 2,000 Guineas last year and we all know what that Juddmonte celebrity went on to do here. Reported to have come forward from both runs this year and having enjoyed the perfect preparation, Gstaad has to do it here if he is ever going to put one over his Newmarket conqueror. So impressive from late summer onwards in 2025, Puerto Rico can be expected to step up from his comeback in the Poule d'Essai des Poulains and loves being allowed to dominate in front, while the impressive Heron Stakes winner **Talk Of New York** is a strong stayer at the trip who will greatly benefit if the pace is overdone. Draw may be a big factor in this renewal, with the Australians **Overpass** and **Asfoora**, last year's winner **American Affair** and Ballydoyle's **Mission Central** all racing towards the stand's rail which can be heavily favoured on the straight track. Seven of the last nine winners came from double-figure stalls, with only the top-class Blue Point and Bradsell overcoming being drawn in the low numbers so the recent revelation **Night Raider** could be up against it from stall six. As usual in the world's best sprints, Ka Ying Rising dominates the conversation and the fact that Overpass could get within two lengths of him in the Everest probably stands him in good stead here. Time and again, the Australian sprinters have been able to overwhelm their Northern Hemisphere counterparts and it will be no surprise if this becomes the latest chapter in the ongoing saga. Drawn favourably in 15, **Rayevka** is of interest having run only twice over this trip including when winning the Prix de Saint-Georges last time. She showed when third to **Time For Sandals** in last year's Commonwealth Cup that she appreciates this track, as did Mission Central when taking the inaugural British Champions Day Two-Year-Old Conditions Stakes over six furlongs in October. If there is one at a huge price who could make an impact it is **Aspect Island**, third in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint and still unexposed over this trip. [Tom Frary].

Again the draw could be a factor here, with Ballydoyle’s first-string **Confucius** towards the stands’ rail in 20 and stablemate **Great Barrier Reef** in three. The fact that Aidan O’Brien holds the record with 11 renewals is no coincidence, with his juveniles conditioned to run hard and take the pain even at this fledgling stage of their careers. Both this year’s contenders have exhibited that “hardiness” he often talks about already, with Confucius super-strong on Naas’s established Royal Ascot Trials Day and Great Barrier Reef taking the Marble Hill and while the betting suggests the former is well ahead it is impossible to be certain. Eve Johnson Houghton has done well at this meeting in recent times and her adoration of the unbeaten **Night In Vegas** is notable, while Richard Hannon is following on from his father in targeting this with one of his cracks. **Cut A Dash** is another of those exciting **Starspangledbanner** progeny that seem to be popping up everywhere at present and the way he went over York’s flat five suggested this will suit him ideally. Any analysis of a two-year-old race at Royal Ascot wouldn’t be complete without including a Karl Burke runner and Wathnan’s impressive Ayr winner **Ruler’s Pride** looks to be made of the right stuff. He’s a Mehmas too, so a win for him would carry extra import as he would remarkably be the sire’s first at the Royal meeting. [Tom Frary].
