



TITLE ROLE WINS NAIL-BITING BELMONT DERBY IN BLANKET FINISH

For as clear as the winner of the GI Belmont Oaks was just two races prior, the GI Belmont Derby was a diametrically opposed result. It came down to a desperate photo on the wire that ultimately went to **Title Role (GB)** (Too Darn Hot {GB}) over a fast-closing **West End Kid (Twirling Candy)**.

Title Role spent 2026 accumulating frequent flier miles with trips to Meydan, Newbury, and Cologne in Germany credited to his passport since Jan. 2 when he ran third in the Jumeirah Stakes. He claimed the Jumeirah 2000 Guineas in Meydan Feb. 28 before shipping to England for the G3 Greenham Stakes, where he'd run fifth. Title Role was last seen May 25 when he took down the G2 German 2000 Guineas by 1 1/4 lengths.

SARATOGA NOTEBOOK, PRESENTED BY NYRABETS: ORTIZ SAYS STILL WORK TO BE DONE BEFORE WINNING ECLIPSE by Tim Wilkin

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y. -- Let's just hold off on handing the 2026 Eclipse Award for top jockey to Jose Ortiz.

Says who?

Says Ortiz.

It's true that the 32-year-old Ortiz has had a phenomenal first half of the season with wins in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Belmont Stakes [with Golden Tempo (**Curlin**)] and the GI Dubai World Cup and GI Stephen Foster Stakes [with Magnitude (**Not This Time**)].

He has also ridden the best 3-year-old male sprinter in the land in Englishman (**Maxfield**) and is the regular rider of 4-year-old filly Nitrogen (Medaglia d'Oro), who won the GI Ogden Phipps Stakes by 12 3/4 lengths and is targeting a run vs the boys in the GI Whitney Stakes at Saratoga next month.

And don't forget Lagynos (**Kantharos**), who has won four graded stakes on grass his year already.

All told, according to Equibase, Ortiz has won 19 graded stakes thus far this year, six of them Grade Is.

"Not yet," Ortiz said on the Saratoga backstretch when asked if he had already clinched the Eclipse, which would be his second. "I have had a great first half of the season, but I have to keep it going and put up the same kind of numbers in the second half."

Ortiz will have one big decision to make next month before the horses are loaded into the starting gate for the Whitney.

Belmont Derby, cont. from p1

Carrying 7-1 odds as the domestic audience's betting dollars drifted to the locals and fellow European invader **Pacific Avenue (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}), he broke well and was content to watch from second as 'TDN Rising Star, presented by Hagyard' **Touch of Fire (Constitution)** rolled into the lead heading for the first bend. Title Role was never far from that frontrunner as he posted an opening quarter in :23.65 and a half-mile in :49.20. Still comfortable after six panels in 1:13.15, as the closers were beginning to tighten ranks on the final turn, the British-bred had built up a full head of steam at the head of affairs that vaulted him into the lead.

Working hard, but in command into the final sixteenth, Title Role had an oncoming cavalry charge to fight off late, led by the furious rally of West End Kid and Cherie DeVaux's 3-2 favorite **Remember Mamba** (Kitten's Joy) to his outside. The group hit the wire together, and it was Title Role who got lucky by the slimmest of noses. 'Rising Star' Remember Mamba was a clear third and Touch of Fire held on for fourth in a mad scramble for the minors.

"They were closing him down," said winning co-trainer Ed Crisford. "Johnny [Velazquez] rode a good race. He jumped well and found himself in a good position early, but they were going pretty quick. They slowed it down on the backstretch, but that last furlong he was just treading water a bit, but he did it well."

Crisford added that the plan was to keep Title Role in America, but wasn't sure if a trainer swap to Brendan Walsh would be immediate, saying, "I'll need to speak with the owners whether we keep him for another race or not. Hopefully, we can and then he's going to stay in America. He'll suit America."

"I don't think [going longer in the GI Saratoga Derby at 1 3/16-miles] is too much of an issue for [Title Role]."

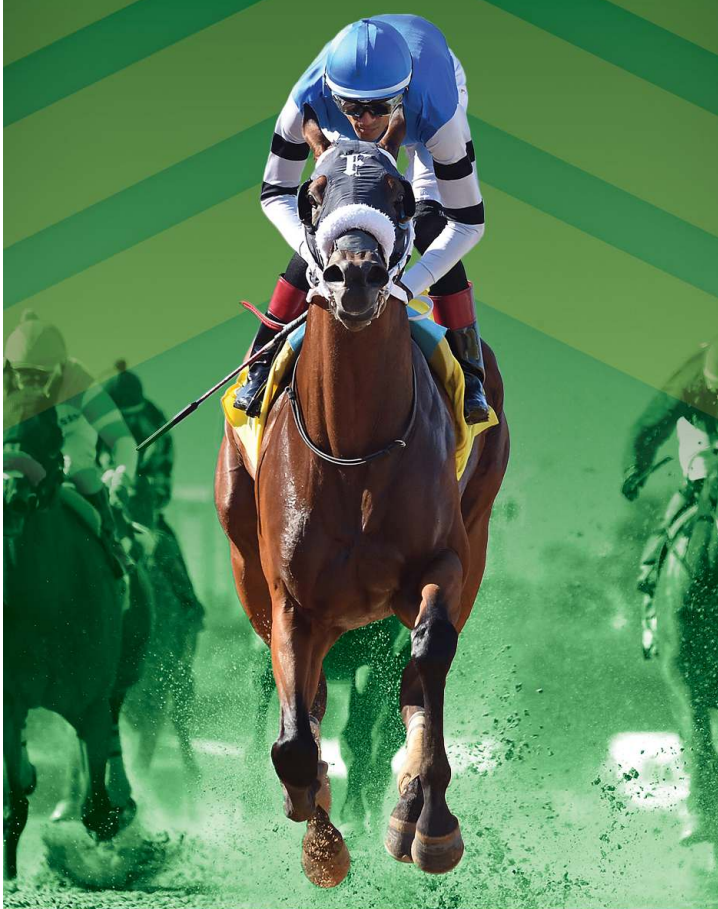

"If he can ride more of a race in terms of not using so much petrol up early, I think he'll get the trip."

"To tell you the truth, I thought I got it, but the jump after the wire, I was like, 'did they [get] me, or was it after the wire?'," said John Velazquez. "But I'll tell you what, I have to give it to him because I asked [Title Role] down the lead, he put the head down, and he was rolling. He was rolling like he just came out running. Even if he got beat, he ran a really good race, but I'm

glad that we got it."

Pedigree Notes:

Title Role is a son of Graded winner Valiant Girl (GB) (Lemon Drop Kid), making him a half-brother to Plucky Lass (Medaglia d'Oro), herself mother of English group winner Calendar Girl (GB) (Advertise {GB}) and MSP-Ire Gutsy Girl (GB) (Blue Point {Ire}). He has six other winning siblings and is the sixth consecutive offspring for the mare to get a picture taken. Valiant Girl's last registered is a juvenile named Lupin's Girl (Ire) (Cracksman {GB}).

Their dam claims a fleet of accomplished siblings, namely multiple Group-winning full-brother Bronze Cannon; English group winner Across the Stars (Ire) ([Sea the Stars {Ire}](#)); and SP-Eng Valiance (Horse Chestnut {SAf}). A full-sister to Valiant Girl named Crimson Ribbon enjoyed a wildly successful broodmare career, producing six black-type horses led by G1 Gold Cup hero Courage Mon Ami (GB) ([Frankel {GB}](#)) and Group winner Danielle (GB) (Cracksman {GB}).

He will have to choose between Magnitude and Nitrogen, who figure to be major players in the Saratoga marquee race for older horses.

When asked about the big decision, he smiled and said it was too early to discuss. But he knows the day is coming when he will have to decide. That question will have to be answered by his agent, Steve Rushing.

"Steve makes the decision," Ortiz said. "I pay him 25 percent. That's his job He doesn't tell me how to ride; I don't tell him how to be an agent."

Hall of Fame trainer Mark Casse knows how difficult it will be for Ortiz, who has ridden Nitrogen in 14 of her 16 career starts.

"It's going to be a tough call for him," Casse said. "He loves Nitrogen, and he loves Magnitude. The good news is that there are a lot of good riders out there."

Beckman Wants to See Ocelli in the Travers, but how does he get There?

The most famous maiden in the land could end up in the \$1.25-million GI Travers Stakes at the end of August. The dilemma facing trainer Whit Beckman is how does he get Ocelli (Connect) to the Midsummer Classic?

Beckman was pondering that Saturday morning in his office at the Oklahoma Training Track. Ocelli, owned by Ashley Durr, Anthony Tate and Front Page Equestrian LLC, has gone to the races nine times in his career.

Nine times he has lost, but he hardly ever disgraces himself

He was third in the GI Kentucky Derby, fourth in the GI Preakness Stakes and, most recently, second in the GIII Ohio Derby. A horse with zero wins has a bankroll of \$829,800.

"I don't know if there is any other horse that can bag over \$800,000 and not break their maiden," Beckman said. "I don't think you can have both of those things in the same sentence in most cases. I feel like he is overdue. We have definitely given him tall tasks at every turn, but he has always shown up and been more than competitive."

Beckman has nominated Ocelli for just about every major race for 3-year-olds before the Travers, and it looks like it will come down to the GI Haskell Stakes at Monmouth on July 18 or one of the two Saratoga stakes, the **Curlin** on July 29 or the GII Jim Dandy on Aug. 1.

"We just have to figure out what we are going to do," Beckman said.

Ocelli had his first work since the June 20 Ohio Derby on Saturday. He went four furlongs in :49.20 (42/94) at Churchill Downs. Beckman said he will bring the colt up to Saratoga and it might be sooner than later. He said the original plan was to have Ocelli work one more time in Kentucky and then ship to the Spa.

"I might want to get him out of there," Beckman said. "It's like 900 degrees there. I will just have to see what the weather is going to be. If it's going to be nasty down there, I might bring him up here next week."

Temperatures in Louisville are supposed to drop from the 90s into the mid to high 80s for much of next week.

Renegade gets Vote of Confidence From Pletcher

There has been some disappointment, absolutely, with the end results of Renegade (Into Mischief), who went into the Triple Crown series with so much anticipation.

It didn't work out. He was a valiant second to Golden Tempo (**Curlin**) in the GI Kentucky Derby after a tough trip and was beat by that foe again in the GI Belmont Stakes last month. He was third that time.

Still, his Hall of Fame trainer Todd Pletcher knows what he has in the colt, who is owned by Robert and Lawana Low and Mike Repole's Repole Stable.

"He is a really good horse," Pletcher said outside his office at the Oklahoma Training Track. "Since the Belmont, he has done very well. If we can have a month leading up to the [GII] Jim Dandy like we have been having so far, he is going to be in a position to make a move forward."

Renegade went off as the 9-5 favorite in the Belmont and finished third, 5 1/4 lengths behind Golden Tempo. In the Kentucky Derby, Golden Tempo beat Renegade by a neck.

In that race, Renegade drew the rail and got bounced around early before jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. got position and made a late run that came up just short.

"We all know he had a difficult trip in the Derby," Pletcher said.

In the Belmont, Pletcher thought his colt could turn the tables on Golden Tempo.

"I will say that I give (Golden Tempo) a lot of credit," Pletcher said. "He showed up in the Belmont and ran a big race. I wasn't positive that he would be able to repeat his Derby effort, but, in fairness to him, he did. I think any of the doubters with how legitimate his Derby was were quieted by his performance in the Belmont."

When asked if he wanted another shot at Golden Tempo in the Travers, Pletcher just smiled.

"We want a shot in the Travers," he said, "whoever is in there."

FROM SANDOWN TO SARATOGA, CLAN O'BRIEN TOPS ANOTHER ELITE RACE AS KENSINGTON LANE WINS BELMONT OAKS

Elite-level turf races have more or less become synonymous with a member of the O'Brien clan and this time it was Donnacha O'Brien's **Kensington Lane (Ire)** (**Starspangledbanner {Aus}**) who took home top prize in the GI Belmont Oaks.

Her conditioner had already enjoyed a big afternoon overseas long before this contest went to post. O'Brien's A Boy Named Susie (Ire) (**Starspangledbanner {Aus}**) ran second in Sandown's marquee G1 Coral-Eclipse Stakes behind father Aidan O'Brien's imperious **Constitution River (Ire)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}). That race was dominated by Aidan and his sons with the trifecta book-ended by the senior O'Brien's runners.

Kensington Lane broke her maiden in her fifth race as a juvenile in Ireland, and didn't produce much against group company in her following two jumps at the Curragh and Leopardstown. She turned her form around May 4 at the former venue with a sharp three-quarter-length victory in the G3 Irish EBF Athasi Stakes. She was fifth last out May 24 in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas after pressing the leaders and fading late, beaten by a classy duo trained by--you guessed it--Aidan O'Brien.

Sent off at 23-1 odds here, Kensington Lane initially took the lead coming out of the gate, but saw familiar face **Abashiri (GB)** (**Frankel (GB)**) try to overtake her with an aggressive move going into the first bend. Stepping on the gas to regain her lead through an opening quarter in :23.47 and a half-mile in :48.82, Kensington Lane had that early challenger just off her flank after six panels in 1:13.17, but the 6-5 favorite was soon backpedaling heading into the final bend.

Ears pricked coming off the turn, the chestnut had built up a clear advantage heading for home and was extending that lead under little urging by midstretch. Never really asked for more, Kensington Lane handily defeated **Faithful Departed** (Yoshida {Jpn}) by open lengths. **Fitz Right (Charlatan)** was turned away late and had to settle for third.

"Given the way she's broken out of the gate in Europe, we thought she could be forward," said Phillip Shelton, racing manager for co-owner Medallion Racing. "I told [Joel Rosario], 'we want her to be within a couple lengths of the lead, if she ends up on the lead because nobody goes, that's fine.' He opened up by three [lengths] and I was hoping he didn't go too early, but it never felt like he had to get into her too hard. She appreciated the circumstances of the race."

When the inevitable question surfaced about what Kensington Lane's next plans would be--returning to Europe or remaining in the States--Shelton said, "I'll have to talk to the partners and see what we want to do. In Europe, there are no more restricted 3-year-old only Grade Is, [and] in America, there are three more. Given her propensity for firm ground, she still may go to California [for the GI Del mar Oaks Aug. 22], but she could go back to Europe. We'll have to talk amongst ourselves and figure out what we want to do."

"Everything went as planned," said Kieran Murphy, traveling assistant to O'Brien. "We shipped in Monday morning and [Kensington Lane] was very relaxed, did a couple of bits of work on Thursday, Friday--not much--just ticking over and here we are."

Of the beaten favorite, jockey William Buick said, "[Abashiri] jumped a bit slow, so I went around them and put her in a good position. We went to the front; there was no pace on. At the half-mile, she was struggling. She's probably not used to the sharp oval tracks, lacked that experience." **Cont.**

Pedigree Notes:

This victress is out of a half-sister to Group 1-placed Flying Cross (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Kensington Lane is the mare's first black-type runner from five to race, and is one of four winners. Dam Almost Always (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) has a juvenile filly by the late Wootton Bassett (GB) in the wings as well as a yearling colt by **No Nay Never**.

Second dam Ramruma (Diesis {GB}) was a multiple Group 1 winner who was also crowned as Europe's champion 3-year-old filly during her time on the track. She was one of 10 winners for third dam Princess of Man (Ire) (Green God {Ire}), making her a full-sibling to multiple group-placed Ausherra. That sister went on in her broodmare career to produce MGSW & G1SP-Eng Strategic Prince (GB) (Dansili {GB}) as well as a branch of the family that later yielded Australian multiple Group 1 winner Montefilia (Aus).

This is also the female family of another Australian Group 1 winner in All the Good (Ire) (Diesis {GB}).

I LOVE GIRAFFES FRACTURED HIP IN FRIDAY'S SPILL AT SARATOGA

SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y. - It wasn't a total happy ending after Friday's frightening spill on opening day of the 46-day Saratoga meet.

I Love Giraffes (**Charlatan**) came out of the incident with a fractured hip and will be sidelined for at least four months, trainer Chad Summers said Saturday morning. And Hall of Fame jockey Javier Castellano, who was also involved in the spill, will miss the rest of the week and probably all of next week.

"I don't know if she will ever run again," Summers said of his 3-year-old filly outside his barn on the Saratoga backstretch. "It's just disappointing. We love that filly, we love all our horses. That is the first horse in my whole career that I have had go down and it's not a good feeling. It makes you not wanting to come here in the mornings." **Cont.**

I Love Giraffes, owned by Al Gold's Gold Square, was ridden by Paco Lopez in Friday's Wild Applause, a one-mile race on the inner turf. At the top of the stretch, I Love Giraffes clipped heels with Pillar of Beauty (Caracaro) and fell. That started the messy spill and Lovely Grey (Vekoma) and jockey Dylan Davis fell over I Love Giraffes. Smexy (Ire) (Mehmas {Ire}) and jockey Tyler Gafflione and Paris Carver (Bolt d'Oro) and Hall of Fame rider Javier Castellano were next and tumbled to the turf.

All four horses that went down immediately got up and it was originally thought that all were ok. Summers said his filly was stepped on twice, resulting in the fractured hip.

"It is just unfortunate," Summers said. "It looked like she was going to be a winner. It's a shame that opening day had to be marred by an incident. Thankfully, nobody died."

Summers said that I Love Giraffes will not need surgery, and her recovery will be four to five months of stall rest.

"It's a tough industry," he said. "There are so many highs and so many lows. We have been blessed this year to have the highs and cursed this year to have the lows."

Earlier this year, Summers won his first Classic when Napoleon Solo (**Liam's Map**) was victorious in the GI Preakness Stakes. Connections of the other three horses involved in the spill said their horses came out of it in good order. Trainer Kelsey Danner stood outside her office at the Oklahoma Training Track Saturday morning and watched Lovely Grey amble about and munching on grass.

Owned by Go Go Greys Stable, Lovely Grey got a ride back to the barn via equine ambulance after the incident because she was bleeding after receiving a few lacerations.

"It was very scary," Danner said. "She was making a good move and of course I was worried about her. I got to the turf course quickly and they were all bearing weight."

Trainer Brendan Walsh said that Smexy, owned by Mark Dobbin, may have gotten the least brunt of the spill. She was standing tall in her stall at Walsh's barn at the Oklahoma Saturday morning, seemingly not the worse for wear.

"I thought she was going to be able to go wide of them and the next thing I know they are going to straight over," Walsh said. "At least it was on the peak of the turn, and they were not in full acceleration. She is fine."

Trainer Jorge Delgado said on X that Paris Carver, owned by Amo Racing USA LLC, was also doing well following the incident.

Castellano, who was taken off the course via ambulance, was released from Saratoga Hospital Friday night after x-rays taken on his back and neck were negative. Basically, he has a case of general soreness. Kevin Meyocks, Castellano's agent, said Castellano won't ride Sunday and all of next week.

"They have already entered for (next) Thursday, and I am not going to have him on any horses for Friday, Saturday or Sunday," Meyocks said Saturday. "He hit pretty hard." Meyocks said Castellano is scheduled to see a doctor in Albany on Monday.

"We want to double check everything," he said. "Cross all the T's and dot all the I's and make sure everything is ok. I have spoken to him (Saturday) and he sounds great. He is still sore, so we are going to give him a week or two off."

Gaffalione, Lopez and Davis all walked off the course under their own power after the spill; Lopez won the Schuylerville Stakes in the next race on Friday with Harper's Corner (**Speaker's Corner**).

Gaffalione and Davis rode at Saratoga on Saturday and Lopez was scheduled to ride at Colonial, but that card was cancelled because of weather.

PHILEAS FOGG ROMPS IN REPEAT SUBURBAN WIN *by Stefanie Grimm*

One year ago, **Phileas Fogg** (Astern {Aus}) went to the lead and gutted it out late to take the GI Suburban Stakes in a photo finish.

This year, he left no doubt.

Once again on the front from the opening strides, the 8-1 shot kept his face clean and absolutely rolled home in a one-horse parade to defend his title in the Suburban this time by double-digit lengths.

Entered off a strong allowance win at Aqueduct May 1, regular pilot Kendrick Carmouche let his mount do what he does best and sent him up to handle the pace making through fractions of 23.93 and :48.59. Never really pressured up the backstretch with only 41-1 longshot **Yo Daddy** (Yoshida {Jpn}) closest to him, Phileas Fogg got away around the far turn and continued to open up, leaving this field far in his wake.

Ten lengths back, G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Hit Show** (Candy Ride {Arg}) got up for second ahead of **Tiztastic** (Tiz the Law).

"The horse was training so good coming into this race," said winning trainer Gustavo Rodriguez. "I told my owner that he was doing better than last year. He won, but I didn't expect him to win the way he did. The way he ran today, I thought he was going to run good, but to win the race and the way he did it, I didn't expect that. That was the plan: grab the lead and take it from there. And Kendrick [Carmouche] is beautiful on the lead."

Carmouche added: "He ran real good last year. This year, after the winter, he wasn't doing as good. We gave him a little time; I started working this horse again. This horse started eating, color started coming back. He was just a different horse."

"I know last time when I worked him, I let him go nice and easy. Oh, my gosh, he wanted to pull me out of the saddle the rest of the workout. Gustavo brought this horse in good condition. I'm just glad I was the pilot again to get another Suburban."

"By the time I turned on the backside, I knew the race was won. My horse was taking me. At no part during the race he was straining. I just had to wait to pull the trigger. I didn't even do that. I just let him go a little."

Rodriguez also added that the connections would take a "wait and see" approach on his runner's next start ahead of the GI Whitney Stakes Aug. 8.

Pedigree Note:

Phileas Fogg is one of eight graded stakes winners for Astern who previously stood in both North America and in Australia for Darley before being sold to Turkey ahead of the 2025 breeding season. First dam Merino, by top-class broodmare sire More Than Ready, has a pair of winners from as many to race with her other being the 4-year-old Bernardini filly Wild 'n' Woolly. Merino herself is a half-sister to G1SW Capezzano (Berardnini) and from the family of both Eclipse-winning sprinter and successful late sire Speightstown (Gone West) and GISW and first-year sire **Early Voting** (Gun Runner).

Merino, who was sent to Saudi Arabia in 2022 and returned to the United States in 2025, last reported a foal in 2023.

SWEET AZTECA BECOMES FIRST THREE-TIME WINNER OF GREAT LADY M

Lightly raced, but classy as they come, **Sweet Azteca** (Sharp Azteca) collected her eighth lifetime win on her seasonal bow in the GII Great Lady M Stakes at Los Alamitos.

Running largely on appointment only since her 2024 campaign, which saw her win the GI Beholder Mile at Santa Anita over MGISW Adare Manor (Uncle Mo), she changed barns from Michael McCarthy to Richard Baltas ahead of her shortened, but fruitful, 2025 season. In just two starts, she collected her second victory in this race and went on to Del Mar last August to claim the GIII Rancho Bernardo Handicap for the second year in a row. Gone since then, the betting public wasn't worried in the least about the long break, and the grey was sent off as the 3-5 favorite in her bid to become the first horse in the race's history to win it three consecutive years.

Out right to the front with **A. Z. Wildcat** (**Munnings**) in close pursuit, Sweet Azteca was kept honest up the backstretch through an opening quarter in :21.84 and swung into the bend after four panels in :43.81 as that early challenger lost ground.

Drifting out as she turned for home, the wagering choice comfortably kept **Magnificat** (Omaha Beach) at bay by 1 1/4 lengths. 'TDN Rising Star, presented by Hagyard' **Nooni** (Win Win), gone since 2024 after fading to fifth in that year's GII Starlet Stakes, ran on well to claim third.

"We got it done. It's great to have a mare like this," said trainer Richard Baltas. "Hopefully, we can regroup and get her ready for the Breeders' Cup [\$1-million Filly & Mare Sprint Oct. 31 at Keeneland]. We'll try to map it right to get her there. It's a big relief and we're very happy and excited. She got a little tired at the end, but it didn't matter. I think she was about 90% today."

"You don't want to be on the inside, but she breaks so well all the time and she has so much natural speed. She was good and quiet in the gate today. It's a real special day."

Pedigree Notes:

Sweet Azteca is out of SW So Sweetitiz (Grand Slam), a granddaughter of Tizsweet (Cee's Tizzy). This victress is her dam's first to the races and first winner while her younger half-sister Sweet Gal of Mine (**Dialed In**) was the next in line to get her picture taken. Their mare's most recent of racing age is a juvenile full-sister to this victress and the youngest of the group is a 2026 filly by **Epicenter**.

The aforementioned third dam has her own claim to fame as the full-sister to the sensational Horse of the Year Tiznow. From his fleet of full-siblings, their dam also produced MGSW Budroyale; SW & GSP Tizbud; GSW Tizdubai; and unraced/unplaced sisters Tizamazing and Tizso. The former is best known as the mother of GI Preakness Stakes hero Oxbow (Awesome Again) and his full-brother SW & GSP Awesome Patriot. Tizso created a branch of the family that yielded the late GISW Paynter (Awesome Again); GSW Tiz West (Gone West); and SW Tizakitty (Distinctive Cat).

YAUPON'S BOOKED TOO MUCH FOR SANFORD RIVALS, SARATOGA SPECIAL NEXT ON SCHEDULE *by Patrycja Szpyra*

The 6-5 favorite in this scratched-down field, **Booked** (Yaupon) was untouchable late to claim his first black-type victory in the GIII Sanford Stakes at Saratoga.

Booked debuted Apr. 28 beneath the Twin Spires, and gave himself a lot to do after breaking leftward at the jump. Racing in last early, he made up ground during the running to claim second behind long-gone winner Fanshell Beach (**Corniche**). He was last seen breaking his maiden at this venue June 7 by 1 3/4 lengths over **Jack's Golden Goal** (Omaha Beach), who was scratched out of this contest.

Popping out of the gate well this time and cruising up to lead **Pocket Listing** (Listing) through an opening quarter in :21.96, Booked never turned a hair from the early pressure as that pair was comfortably ahead of **Goodbye to Romance** (**Complexity**) in third after four furlongs in :45.64. Turning away any challenge from his long-time shadow, Booked arrived at the head of affairs well in control as Pocket Listing began to fade.

For a moment, it looked like **Vissino** (Preservationist) would be the danger late, but Booked found another gear in midstretch and left the field in his wake with air to spare. Vissino claimed second while Goodbye to Romance held on to third.

The final time was 1:11.24.

"He was much the best today," said jockey Ricardo Santana Jr. "The only thing we worried about was the break from [post No. 1]. He's a big colt. Today he broke [well] and he was much the best."

"He's a 2-year-old, third time out. You can tell [Booked] was looking at the crowd, the TVs. I did not want to be too rough with him."

"Horse has got nice talent," said Steve Asmussen after the race. "Ricardo did a great job with him away from there, from the inside. His first jump isn't great, but it looked like he was traveling very easily in the middle. I think a big colt with a lot of size, that he'll start finishing his races off a little better. He has a lot of talent."

Asmussen added that Booked's demeanor reminded the conditioner a lot of his sire, Yaupon, who he'd trained for the duration of that one's career as well. "Yaupon was an extremely fast horse that was unbelievably lazy, which was kind of an odd combination. You just always worried about how quiet he was all the time. But [Yaupon] was extremely talented, and they have a very similar personality, and they both have a lot of speed."

As to a next target, Asmussen has the GII Saratoga Special Stakes Aug. 1 penciled in for Booked. "As I mentioned, he's got a very quiet demeanor, he doesn't do much in the morning, and I think he'll need races."

Pedigree Notes:

Booked is the second stakes runner for his dam behind MSP Zadorsky (Tapiture), who was last seen in April taking on allowance company at Keeneland. Another of his half-siblings Tre Italiani (Flatter) missed defeating a first-level allowance group at Churchill June 3 by a head and his 3-year-old brother Johnny Ringo (Silver State) made his turf debut at Horseshoe Indianapolis June 9. The quartet has a yearling half-sister by Two Phil's in the wings.

Dam Fingerprint (Competitive Edge) is herself a daughter of SP Miss Super Quick (Rock hard Ten), a half-sister to GISW Callback (Street Sense) and SW Defy Gravity (Bandini).

Summer in Saratoga is a great occasion to love that particular course, and **Zulu Kingdom (Ire)** (Ten Sovereigns {Ire}) will look to avenge his third-place finish in last month's GIII Poker Stakes even as the two horses who beat him also return in the GIII Kelso Stakes.

A multiple Grade I winner in his career, the Chad Brown-trained Zulu Kingdom has crossed the wire first every time he's been at Saratoga—he was disqualified from his GII Hall of Fame win last year and placed fourth—and the Poker was only the second time in his career that horses physically finished ahead of him. Zulu Kingdom is clearly a fan of this course.

That being said, there is *a lot* of speed signed on here, and he's shown a preference for the running style of late. There is prior form from his juvenile year that suggests he could sit well off whatever this pace becomes, and get a first-jump on the closers, but he won't be the only one eyeballing those tactics. Jockey Flavien Prat will have to win the jockey's race here just as much as his mount will need to be best on the day to take home the hardware.

Looking to once again play spoiler is **Pass the Hat** (Collected), the ever-improving chestnut from the Bill Mott barn who posted a career-best Beyer figure of 95 to defeat Zulu Kingdom and stablemate **Capitol Hill** (Into Mischief) the last time the trio met in the aforementioned Poker at this venue. If all the speed in this contest steps forward, the ball will be very much in his court to run them all down. Closing from well out of it has been Pass the Hat's forte his entire career, and he's on a two-race winstreak of late.

Capitol Hill shares that running style, and with only a nose separating these two on the line last out, he's been knocking on the door for the last four times he's faced stakes company in New York but has been unable to get the job done. The question here is one of class--runners to his inside have faced serious competition, and he'll have an extra six bodies to contend with from the five-horse field in the Poker. Traffic problems could be a real concern.

Speaking of classy new shooters, Juddmonte's **Cosmic Year (GB) (Kingman {GB})** is one such example as his 3-year-old season in Europe saw him locking horns with some tough company, and running well for trainer Harry Charlton. He missed winning the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas to fellow Juddmonte-owned Field of Gold (Ire) (**Kingman {GB}**), who returned the following month at Royal Ascot to win the G1 St James's Palace Stakes by 3 1/2 lengths over the classy G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf winner **Henri Matisse (Ire)** (Wootton Bassett {GB}).

Despite tailing off toward the end of his sophomore season, Cosmic Year clearly took to a change of environment as he was imported to the States to the barn of Chad Brown, and kicked off his 2026 U.S. campaign with a runner-up effort to **Neat (Constitution)** in the May 30 Cliffhanger Stakes at Monmouth. Manny Franco is in the irons for this second jump, and the pace is ripe to take advantage of...the question will be if he can run down the ones who got first jump on him, ala Zulu Kingdom.

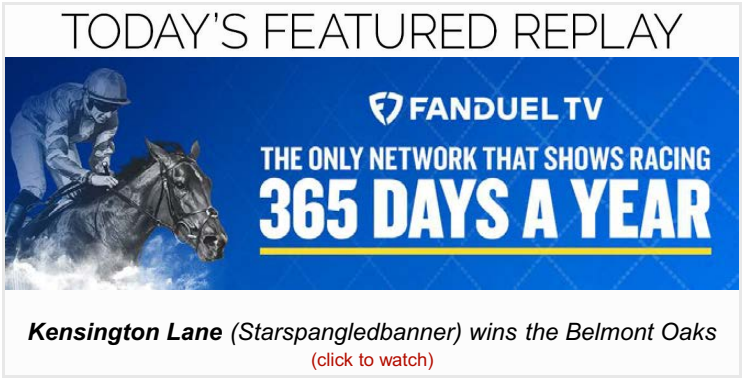

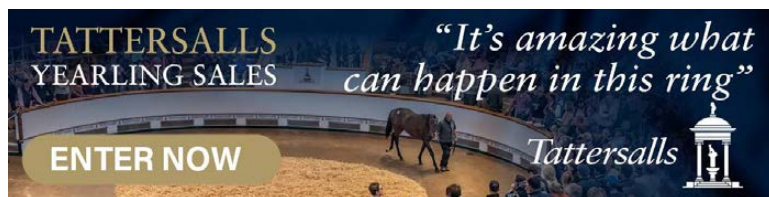

CONSTITUTION RIVER GIVES O'BRIEN HISTORIC FOURTH CONSECUTIVE ECLIPSE

No trainer had won Sandown's G1 Coral-Eclipse four years in a row before Saturday, but Aidan O'Brien's Team Ballydoyle did what they do and put another statistic to bed with their exciting talent **Constitution River** (Wootton Bassett).

In a finish which almost mimicked that of the Prix du Jockey Club, the 8-11 favourite was in command by three lengths from **A Boy Named Susie** (Starspangledbanner), with Donnacha's colt reversing the Chantilly Classic form with **Hawk Mountain** (Wootton Bassett) by a neck as the three-year-olds and the O'Briens dominated.

"We've always thought the world of him—he's a special horse," O'Brien said after greeting his 10th Eclipse winner, with five coming in the last six years. "Ryan's just said that he was coasting through the last furlong and he's not sure he's ever ridden a better horse, so that's big praise from him. He said we could put him anywhere we want."

If **Constitution River** didn't feature prominently in musings over the operation's Classic hopes during the winter, it was only because his juvenile campaign had been halted after a smooth win in the Curragh's Futurity. [Cont. p3](#)

TATTYCORAM TAKES THE LANCASHIRE OAKS, YORKSHIRE OAKS NEXT

One of the potential improvers in Saturday's G2 Lancashire Oaks, Chasemore Farm's **Tattycoram** (Camelot) made her biggest leap yet to storm to an impressive success.

Relishing the steep rise to the line on Newmarket's July Course, the Ralph Beckett-trained homebred, who had won Goodwood's Daisy Warwick Stakes on her four-year-old bow, left behind the Group 1 mare **Tiffany** (Farhh) to score by 4 1/2 lengths. The three-year-old **Caught U Sleeping** (Cotai Glory) was another 1 1/4 lengths behind the 5-4 favourite in third.

"We were going an even gallop and she's won with a bit of authority," jockey Ed Greatrex said of the 11-2 shot. "It takes her a few strides to get into top gear, especially on this ground. Camelots get better with age and she's hugely exciting for everyone. She's put her hand up to run in a Group 1, but I'll leave that to Ralph and the team." [Cont. p5](#)

While the focus was on the yard's Group 1 protagonists Pierre Bonnard, Benvenuto Cellini, Hawk Mountain, Gstaad and Puerto Rico, those closest to the imposing colt who lurked in the shadows were slowly coming to another conclusion.

Finally readied for his delayed fourth start at Chester, he had Benvenuto Cellini's Vase *tour de force* to follow but within 24 hours had dramatically changed the conversation. Pouring it on in the Dee Stakes, he became virtually everybody's idea of the Derby winner--including Ryan Moore--until the "lads" opted for Chantilly and what John Gosden recently referred to as the real stallion-making Derby.

Given his wide-margin romp on the Roodee, the visual thinkers weren't entirely enamoured with a more scrambling display as he landed his Classic, but all the data and logic pointed to a rare achievement. Far from guaranteed to turn up for this, given how

hard he had grafted from the compromising draw in the heat at Chantilly, he had convinced the team to give the green light and was surprisingly large odds for a renewal lacking star quality among the older horses and comprising two members of his generation he had already subdued.

With **Gethin** (Ghaiyyath) wrecking his prospects by pulling too hard throughout the early stages and Hawk Mountain also running too free tracking the pacemaker **Flushing Meadows** (Wootton Bassett), this was always going to go to the closers and predictably **Constitution** River was the sharpest and the fastest of them. **Saddadd** (Pinatubo) tried but was only able to tread water and, as the

older-horse challenge died, A Boy Named Susie emerged to keep the winner honest to the line.

This was plain sailing for Moore, who looked to be only cajoling the winner from the two pole to maintain focus. **Cont. p4**

It was a sixth renewal for the rider, who is just one short of the legendary Lester Piggott's record. "We went hard early and it was always the plan to get him into his rhythm, but the horses in front came back to him quickly and he got there too early," the rider said. "You can't be waiting up the hill here and he was a bit idle but always in command."

"It's hard to know where he'll end up, but he's got an awful lot of ability, is a beautiful-looking horse who stood out here and has a deep pedigree--he's done nothing wrong in his whole career. We're learning all the time and, given how the race panned out, he could be even better than this. I know how good Hawk Mountain is and the Eclipse is never easy--you are meeting that rising ground at Sandown and it's hard to be wildly impressive here."

What is so tantalising about Constitution River is that he is still a work in progress with everything in place to further enhance his status. O'Brien is looking forward to what lies ahead.

"He's maturing, he's a big, scopey proper physical and we felt we hadn't seen the bottom of him," the trainer said. "He's

classy, pacey and is heavier today than he was the last day which is always a good sign. He has that sharpness of mind, he's not a slob and in no way backward-thinking--when you put him into gear, he's ready to rock."

O'Brien added, "He has all the options--the Juddmonte, the Irish Champion and the Champion--and I'm not sure what the lads are thinking, but he will have an easy time now. This is such a prestigious race, and a difficult race to win, and you need a good horse to win it. I'm grateful the lads let us run both him and Hawk Mountain. He also ran a stormer. He did a good bit of the donkey work, but still came there and the French form really stood up--Donnacha's colt is obviously very good as well."

Donnacha O'Brien had suggested that Ana O'Brien's A Boy Named Susie was the best he had trained earlier this term and the runner-up was backing up that statement here. "We're very happy with that, it was a huge run," O'Brien Jr said. "That was a career-best and everything went to plan with no excuses. We'll see how he is, but maybe he needs to run in a Group race for a bit of confidence. Whatever he does this year, he's going to be better next year and he is a Group 1 horse. He's not the finished article and I think there's improvement in him as he strengthens."

Pedigree Notes

Constitution River, who became the third Prix du Jockey Club winner for his much-missed sire, was bred by Gerard Laboureaux of LG Bloodstock at Pierre Talvard's Haras du Cadran in the Orne department of Normandy. He is the first foal out of Chuppy (Le Havre), a full-sister to the high-class British Champions Fillies & Mares Stakes, Prix de Royallieu and Hardwicke heroine Wonderful Tonight.

The second dam, Salvation (Montjeu), is a daughter of the Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial winner Birdie (Alhaarth), whose three stakes performers are headed by the GIII Providencia Stakes winner Hostess by Wootton Bassett's sire Iffraaj. **Cont. p5**

Tattycoram did win a notable Sandown novice last April, but any Oaks dreams died when she was a well-beaten fourth in the Musidora. Although she showed some improvement in three subsequent starts, she had gone off the radar by the time she reappeared in Sussex. Two starts in to her 2026 campaign, it is clear we are dealing with a different proposition and Beckett is understandably thinking big from here.

"She's in the Arc, but she'll go to the Yorkshire Oaks next and I fancy her chances there," said Beckett. "She was a filly we finished early last year, hoping she would develop from three to four, and it looks like that is the case. She went into a little dip after winning the Daisy Warwick, hence the two-month break, but I was easy about that and this was always a race that would set up well for her. She's a good filly."

Sir Mark Prescott said of Tiffany, "The available form is that she has run to form. I suppose when you are six, you are not coming forward anymore. She is still very good, but just not quite good enough. I think she would be better with a tiny bit of ease in the ground, but I don't put that as an excuse."

He added, "We will have to be very broad brush and not afraid to get beaten if it gives us a better chance of winning. We have got to try a few different things."

"We tried in front today, which we hadn't done before, but when they have got five seconds to their name they tend to get six. She has done lots of winning though and has been fantastic to the owners."

Tattycoram is currently the last known foal out of the dual Listed-placed dam Illaunmore (Shamardal), who is responsible for the Gimcrack and Windsor Castle runner-up **Johannes Brahms (Siyouni)**.

The second dam is the Albany Stakes-placed Illaunglass (Red Clubs), while the family includes the Lowther winner Celandine (**Kingman**) and her Listed-winning full-brother Division, who has been placed in this year's Commonwealth Cup and Sandy Lane. ZELZAL'S MISE EN BOITE MAKES BREAKTHROUGH IN DEAUVILLE FEATURE



Mise En Boite | Scoop Dyga

Mise En Boite's best return in four prior black-type outings was a third-place finish in Chantilly's Listed Prix Servanne two months ago and he made the leap forward to secure a first stakes win of any kind in Saturday's G3 Prix de Ris Orangis at Deauville.

Reined back to find a modicum of cover behind the leaders in fifth after a swift exit, the 39-5 chance made continued forward

progress from halfway to tackle **Charibelle** (Kodiac) entering the final furlong and was ridden out to deny that rival by a length, with **Zodiac** (Kodiac) a neck further adrift in third.

"He has come into his own from three to four and finished a close third behind [subsequent G1 Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes fourth] Stolen Kiss and Sajir in the Prix Servanne, so we knew his form was excellent," said trainer Xavier Blanchet after collecting a first pattern-race rosette of his own.

"Racing over a straight course really shows him at his best and he just keeps getting better and better. We will now take a look at the [August 9, G1] Prix Maurice de Gheest [back at this venue]."

Pedigree Notes

Mise En Boite, who becomes the fifth Group winner and 16th stakes winner for his sire, is the sixth of seven foals and one of five scorers from as many runners produced by a multiple-winning granddaughter of three-time Listed winner Biblique (Saint Cyrien).

Biblique is the dam of the multiple Listed-winning G3 Prix de Flore and GIII Locust Grove Handicap third Histoire Sainte (Kendor), herself the dam of GIII Knickerbocker Stakes victor Violon Sacre (Stravinsky).

SIOUX NATION'S CONCORDE LANDED A NEW TDN RISING STAR *By Tom Frary*

The vibes surrounding **Concorde Landed** (**Sioux Nation**) ahead of Naas's five-furlong Saturday opener were particularly strong and Bond Thoroughbred's newcomer showed why with a five-length success to become a **TDN Rising Star, Presented by Hagyard**.

Able to move from rear to the stands' rail with the minimum of effort, the Paddy Twomey-trained 13-8 favourite was in front passing two out and kept piling it on to dismiss Ballydoyle's **Snowing** (**No Nay Never**), a half-sister to the high-class Maljoom (Caravaggio) who had the benefit of experience. There was another 1 1/2 lengths back to the Robson De Aguiar-trained debutante **Fly Smartly** (Mehmas) in third.

"She came from the breeze-ups, so she knew a bit more than ours normally do first-time-out," jockey Billy Lee said of the €200,000 Tattersalls Ireland Breeze-Up purchase. "She was having a look in front and was quite raw, so it was a good

performance. She has plenty of natural speed but is fairly relaxed and should get six. She's going to York for either the Roses or the Lowther and is a very exciting filly."

Twomey added of the relative of a host of smart Cheveley Park runners, "It's rare you see Paddy Twomey training a five-length winner first-time out! A first-time out winner, full stop. She is a nice filly, but I didn't do a lot with her since the sale. She's come in, she's cantered, she's breezed a few times. She's not been anywhere.

"Billy just said that maybe she has a bit too much speed for the Lowther, but I think she'll be okay. It would be the perfect race for her. I don't really train first-time-out two-year-old winners that much, so it's very possible that I get them beaten, but I think she's nice. We have 50 two-year-olds--we actually have a very good bunch of two-year-olds, but she's nice." **Cont. p8**

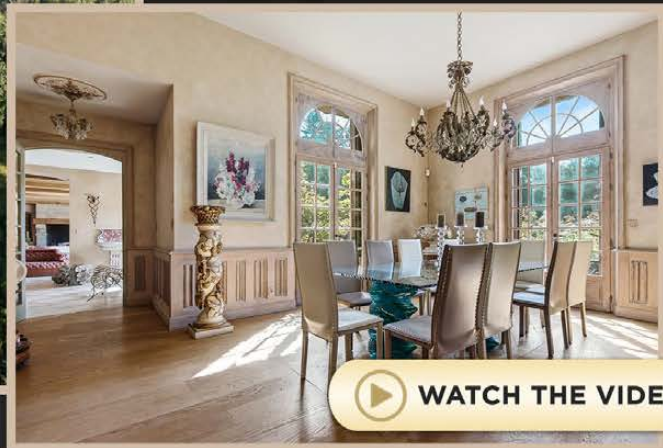

"EXCEPTIONAL" DERBY WINNER MOTIVATOR DIES AT 24

Michael Bell hailed **Motivator** as an "exceptional racehorse" following the death of the Derby winner at the age of 24.

It is 21 years since the son of Montjeu's **career-defining victory at Epsom**, with the manner of his five-length defeat of Walk In The Park, with super-sire Dubawi back in third, living long in the memory.

Motivator headed to post at Epsom unbeaten in three starts, with his other wins including the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster as a juvenile, before he warmed up for the Derby with an impressive success in the G2 Dante Stakes at York.

Bell told the Press Association, "I was very lucky to have him as part of my life and he obviously gave us many special days, but one in particular.

"He was a very, very high-class horse and I think on Derby day he would have won a lot of Derbys. He was absolutely on his game that day and was very impressive—it would have taken a good Derby winner to beat him, I think."

Motivator failed to add to his tally in three subsequent starts as a three-year-old. Having filled the runner-up spot behind Oratorio in both the G1 Coral-Eclipse and G1 Irish Champion Stakes, he then signed off with a fifth-place finish in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

"He never had the rub of the green after that [the Derby]," Bell added. "On Eclipse day, it rained everywhere bar Sandown and then we played away in the Irish Champion Stakes and were beaten by Oratorio again.

"Although he started favourite for the Arc, I think he'd slightly gone by then, but he was an exceptional racehorse and I was very privileged to have him."

Motivator's Derby triumph also saw him become the first ever syndicate-owned winner of that Classic for the 230 members of the Royal Ascot Racing Club, which is managed by Harry Herbert.

"Michael Bell trained him supremely well and everyone involved with the horse will be saddened by his passing, but he leaves a wonderful memory," said Herbert.

"The life-size bronze of him by the pre-parade ring at Ascot is something very special. I certainly know that, every time I pass it, I smile."

He added, "He was one of the most impressive Derby winners any of us have seen, really—he won by five lengths eased down. It was wonderful that he was owned by Ascot, running in the name of the Royal Ascot Racing Club, and he gave over 200 members the day of their lives.

"He went on to be a successful stallion, being the sire of Treve, and he had a very high black-type strike-rate with his runners in France, in particular."

Motivator was retired at the end of his three-year-old season to stand at the Queen's Royal Studs at Sandringham. However, having been introduced at a fee of £20,000, he was denied the opportunity to cover a full book of mares after injuring himself in a paddock accident.

In 2010, Motivator's stud career met with another setback when a tendon injury forced him to miss the breeding season in its entirety. He stood for £8,000 when he returned in 2011 and then just £5,000 in 2012.

Only 33 foals came from that final crop bred at the Royal Studs, with Motivator soon being sent on his way to Haras du Quesnay in France for 2013, having sired 10 individual stakes winners up until the end of 2012. The bright spark was Ridasiyna, his first Group 1 winner when landing that year's Prix de l'Opera.

Then along came the aforementioned Treve, the dual Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe whose exploits as a three-year-old in 2013 saw Motivator sustain the strong support he'd received in his first season at Haras du Quesnay. Introduced at €7,000, he produced 99 foals from that first crop conceived in France and another 92 the following year, at the increased fee of €15,000, after Treve had rattled off a Group 1 hat-trick.

But whilst seven stakes winners emerged from those two crops, Motivator was unable to really kick on with his Flat runners in the way that might have been hoped.

Instead, the most accomplished performers conceived in Motivator's later years at Haras du Quesnay were in the National Hunt sphere, headed by the Grade 1-winning hurdlers For Fun, Jigme, Pentland Hills and Stormy Ireland. **Cont. p10**

More recently, Motivator proved a popular visitor attraction at Haras du Hoguenet following his move there in 2023. He covered 80 mares as recently as 2024 and is survived at the Normandy farm by his aforementioned son, Jigme.

Entering this competitive test with a perfect record, the clear-cut Haydock novice winner Secret Of Life had something to prove but the punters didn't believe that and heavy support saw her upstage her peers in the market before doing so in the running. Allowed to dictate under Rossa Ryan, the homebred was too strong at every stage up the home straight to enhance her burgeoning reputation.

"She's a lovely filly and fair play to the Deer family for letting Ralph take his time with her," the rider said. "We were a bit concerned about the ground, because she seems to like a bit of juice as she's so big, but she got away with it today, her class prevailed. I don't know if she'd get away with it again, so I'd say they will campaign her for the autumn and the more time she gets, the better she'll become."

He added, "She's a filly that looks like she's going to be a four-year-old but has winning black type now, so you can't ask for a lot more. It seems like there are gears there that she doesn't know how to use yet--mentally it hasn't come yet and she'll come forward again for sure."

The winner is the first stakes performer for the talented dam, who was successful in the Prix de Psyche at Group 3 level. From the family of the Middle Park and Prix Morny-winning champion sire Dutch Art, her two-year-old filly Haldon Pier is by Palace Pier.

Made to work for it by Brazilian Diva, the winner is set for another step back up in trip and class.

"For some reason, he just never fired in Ascot and nothing came to light after," Ballydoyle representative Chris Armstrong said. "He was in good form since, so Aidan said we'd bring him here and see. We knew coming here it'd be a touch short for him, but it was worth a go."

Armstrong added, "He'll appreciate going the six now. He'll probably go for maybe the Railway Stakes or over to the race in Goodwood [the Richmond]. He's a horse that keeps a little bit for himself and is still learning on the job. He's a work in progress, but he's a nice one."

The dam, who was second in the Dragon Stakes at two, has also produced the Marygate Stakes winner Secret Hideaway (**Starspangledbanner**). Out of the Sweet Solera winner and Fillies' Mile third English Ballet (Daneshill Dancer), she is connected to the Prix de Diane heroine Star Of Seville (Duke Of Marmalade) and St James's Palace Stakes runner-up King Of Comedy (**Kingman**).

Gostam's trainer Andreas Wohler also saddles **Westminster Rocket**, but there is no obvious reason for that colt to reverse the form of Cologne's Union-Rennen in which he was put in his place by the unbeaten **Englishman**.
