SARATOGA SPRINGS, N.Y. - At one time this year, Hall of Fame trainer Mark Casse thought **Silent Tactic** (**Tacitus**) was going to be a player in the Triple Crown.

Then came the dreaded foot bruise. The Wednesday before the GI Kentucky Derby, Casse had to scratch Silent Tactic because of the bruise on the left front foot. The next step would be the GI Preakness Stakes, but Casse had to pull the plug on that as well because the foot still just wasn't right.

Fast forward to now and Silent Tactic, owned by John Oxley, may get his chance with the heavyweights of the 3-year-old colt division.

Under exercise rider Edwin Soto, Silent Tactic worked five furlongs on the Saratoga main track in 1:00.65 (6/10) Sunday morning. He worked in company with 3-year-old filly **Measure** (**Essential Quality**), who is getting ready to run in the \$500,000 GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Saratoga on July 25. *Cont. p3*

WILL PRICE BE RIGHT TO SAVE RACING AT HAWTHORNE?

With a bid deadline extended to this Friday, July 10, and a court-approved auction now set for Monday, July 13, the big unknowns in the pending sale of the in-bankruptcy Hawthorne Race Course remain the price and whether the winning bidder wants to continue horse racing and pursue the Chicago-area track's never-realized plans for building a racino.

The federal bankruptcy judge in charge of the case went on the record last week as stating that he would prefer the sale to be a "going concern" transaction that keeps racing alive at the 135-year-old Hawthorne.

But he also said that the \$90-million "stalking horse" bid from a Delaware-incorporated shell company seemed surprisingly low. *Cont. p6*

If all goes according to plan, Silent Tactic will make his first start since Mar. 28 when he was second to **Renegade** (Into Mischief)--beaten by four lengths--in the GI Arkansas Derby.

Silent Tactic had a promising winter at Oaklawn as he was second in the Smarty Jones on Jan. 3, won the GIII Southwest Stakes on Feb. 6, was second in the GII Rebel Stakes on Mar. 1 and then the Arkansas Derby.

Casse spent a frustrating few months dealing with the foot bruise. Now, everything seems to be OK.

"It's good, knock on wood," Casse said outside his barn on the Saratoga backstretch Sunday morning.

As he prepares to send his colt back into the 3-year-old competition, he said he honestly doesn't know what to expect.

"I really don't," he said. "If you look at Renegade, I thought going into the [Kentucky] Derby, that he was the horse to beat. We ran second to win and then he ran well in the Derby, but not so well in the Belmont [Renegade was third]. If you look at [Silent

Tactic's] numbers, he is right there. Anytime you miss the Derby, it is disappointing and the way the race set up, it was even more disappointing because we have a strong closer."

Casse also worked 4-year-old filly **Nitrogen** (Medaglia d'Oro), who is getting ready for the \$1-million GI Whitney Stakes on Aug. 8, and 3-year-old filly **Counting Stars** (**Honor A. P.**), who is being prepared for the Coaching Club American Oaks.

D. J. Stable LLC's Nitrogen, the runaway winner of the GI Ogden Phipps Stakes at Saratoga last month, went four furlongs under Soto in :48.06 (18/141) and West Point Thoroughbreds' Counting Stars, winner of the GI Acorn Stakes in her last start, worked five furlongs in 1:00.50 (5/10) with exercise rider Reynaldo Dumont on board.

"Everyone worked really well," Casse said. "I wanted a little more out of Counting Stars; she would have gone :58 if I asked her to. With Nitrogen, we are a ways away from her next race. I will let her do a little more as we get closer."

Casse had another horse work on Sunday, but it was at his training center in Ocala, Florida. **Sandman** (**Tapit**), who hasn't raced since Feb. 28 and had not had a published work since Jan. 20, went three furlongs in :36.80 (1/1).

Casse said Sandman, winner of last year's Arkansas Derby, has been sidelined with pulled muscles in his rear end.

Casse is just going to wait and see how his 4-year-old progresses.

"I'm not making any promises," he said. "We don't have any race on the horizon. We're just going to take it one day at a time."



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Rodriguez in no Hurry to Make Plans for Phileas Fogg's Next Race

Trainer Gus Rodriguez is sure of one thing: he is never going to have another horse like **Phileas Fogg** (Astern {Aus}). The day after the 6-year-old gelding won the GI Suburban Stakes for the second straight year, Rodriguez, who readily admits he is more of a claiming trainer, stood outside Phileas Fogg's stall.

The horse, wide eyed and bright, looked like he could have run again on Sunday.

Phileas Fogg became the fourth horse in the history of the Suburban--it was first run in 1884--to win the race in back-to-back years. The last horse to do it was Effinex, who did it in 2015-16.

"You never know, but I don't think we are ever going to have another horse like this...ever," an emotional Rodriguez, who has been in the game for over 30 years, said. "We thought he was going to run good because he was training good and coming into the race beautiful. But the way he ran...I was impressed."

Ridden by Kendrick Carmouche, Phileas Fogg went gate-to-wire in the 1 1/4-mile Suburban and won by 10 lengths.

He was dismissed at odds of nearly 9-1.

Phileas Fogg, owned by Steve Shapiro's Jupiter Stable LLC, gave the 55-year-old Rodriguez his second career graded stakes training win after giving him his first last year.

Rodriguez spent 10 years working as an assistant for his brother, Rudy, before going out on his own. Phileas Fogg has given him his two greatest moments as a trainer.

Rodriguez is in no hurry to announce what might be next for his stable star. It will be either the GI Whitney Stakes at Saratoga on Aug. 8 or the \$1-million GI Jockey Club Gold Cup on opening day at the new Belmont Park on Sept. 18.

The Gold Cup is 1 1/4 miles--the distance Phileas Fogg is best at--and the Whitney, which is shaping up as one loaded field, is 1 1/8 miles. But the Whitney is at Saratoga, a place at which Phileas Fogg thrives.

Since coming to Rodriguez--he was claimed for \$62,500 by Shapiro and Rodriguez in 2024--Phileas Fogg has run four times at Saratoga. He has won three.

"I'm not sure yet," Rodriguez said about the next start, "but he loves Saratoga. He loves this race track."

Commandment's Next Stop Will be Jim Dandy

Following a courageous second-place finish in the GI Belmont Stakes at Saratoga last month, trainer Brad Cox has deemed that **Commandment** (Into Mischief) has earned a return trip back to the Spa City.

It's not breaking news, but Cox confirmed that his horse will be back to run in the \$500,000 GI Jim Dandy Stakes on Aug. 1.

"The goal for the summer is the [Aug. 29 GI] Travers," Cox said from his home base at Churchill Downs in Kentucky. "The Jim Dandy is the best prep for that."

Since finishing second behind Golden Tempo (**Curlin**) in the Belmont, Commandment has had two works at Churchill. The latest came on Saturday when he went four furlongs in :47.80 (8/94).



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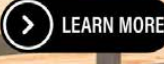
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Commandment came out of the winter as one of the stronger players on the road to the GI Kentucky Derby. He gutted out wins in the GII Fountain of Youth (by a neck over Chief Wallabee (**Constitution**)) and GI Florida Derby (by a nose over The Puma (**Essential Quality**)).

He did not show the same fight and tenacity in the Kentucky Derby, finishing seventh, well behind Golden Tempo.

"Maybe. It's possible," Cox said when asked if the Florida races may have taken some of the starch out of Commandment. "With the Florida Derby leading up to the Kentucky Derby, I thought his works were OK. His works leading up to the Belmont were better."

And his effort in the final leg of the Triple Crown was better. He engaged Golden Tempo down the Saratoga stretch only to see his rival pull ahead and win by 1 1/4 lengths. "I thought he had a shot," Cox said. "For a few seconds, I thought he had a big shot to win it. The other horse just had a little more left."

A low starting price point prior to an auction isn't necessarily a bad thing in a bankruptcy sale. But in Hawthorne's case, it will likely entice bidders who want the real estate for development to compete with entities who see better value in racing and gaming.

Because parcels of 100-plus acres that are zoned for industrial usage in proximity to a major airport are rare finds near any major city these days, the auction should draw plenty of interest.

The stalking horse bidder has already indicated that it doesn't want to be a racino operator.

Stalking horse bids are routine in sales of distressed assets. The term refers to a buyer who agrees to make the first formal, binding offer to purchase. A stalking horse bid must be court-approved in a bankruptcy sale, and it establishes a minimum that other bidders must beat.

If no one offers more, the stalking horse bidder buys the assets.

If the stalking horse bidder gets outbid, their contract contains provisions that allow for payments to cover the due-diligence work they performed and to hedge against the risks they

undertook in establishing that price point.

There has been no shortage of racetracks that have slid off the Thoroughbred grid and been sold over the past decade.

But you can't use those sales prices as apples-to-apples comparisons for what Hawthorne might bring, because values vary tremendously based on geographic location, total acreage, zoning, and projected uses for the land.

Still, it's worth marking the market to see what some of these tracks sold for. Here are a

few publicly reported prices of American racetracks that have changed hands over the past 10 years.

Tattersalls Craven Breeze Up Belmont Derby Winner

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In 2017, Suffolk Downs in Boston was sold for \$155 million to developers. Full-season racing had been phased out there after 2014, but "festival" meets over several weekends each summer were conducted between 2015 and 2019. Seven years later, construction has been repeatedly delayed, with only a small fraction of the full mixed-use master plan (business, housing, retail) currently complete.

In 2019, Portland Meadows in Oregon got sold for \$48.8 million. The racetrack was quickly demolished and redeveloped into an industrial and warehouse site.

In 2022, Ellis Park got sold to Churchill Downs, Inc. (CDI) for \$79 million, with racing continuing there during the summer on the Kentucky circuit.

In 2023, Arlington International Racecourse sold for \$197 million. The suburban Chicago racetrack has since been razed, but not yet redeveloped. It was bought by the Chicago Bears football team as a prospective site for a new stadium. But to a certain extent, the Bears have largely used ownership of the parcel as a bargaining chip to try and leverage a more lucrative deal for a stadium that the state might fund in a different location.

From a racing perspective, the demise of Arlington--also under the stewardship of CDI--turned out to be the major factor in the erosion of the overall Chicago racing circuit. Hawthorne was never able to bear the burden of being the region's sole Thoroughbred venue after Arlington ran its last race in 2021.

In October 2025, Sunland Park in New Mexico sold for \$301 million. The real estate assets went for \$183.7 million, and \$117.3 million was paid for the racing and gaming privileges, which have continued.

Golden Gate Fields ceased racing in 2024, and the non-profit Trust for Public Land recently secured a \$175-million agreement to acquire the 161-acre site for conversion to a waterfront park. The deal is expected to close in early 2027.



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Just this past week, Maryland's Board of Public Works approved the \$48.5-million purchase of Laurel Park.

Unlike the other sales referenced above, this unique deal calls for an existing racetrack to be converted to a state-owned Thoroughbred training center.

As part of the \$400-million "Pimlico Plus" rebuild of Maryland's racing infrastructure, the state initially purchased Shamrock Farm in Carroll County to serve as an 800-horse training center. When that 328-acre farm was bought for \$5 million in December 2024, state officials envisioned Shamrock would eventually come to fruition as "one of the great equine training centers in the world."

Just over a year later, in January 2026, Maryland abandoned the Shamrock plan, citing higher-than-expected conversion costs for a property that was deemed to be environmentally problematic. Shamrock is now expected to go back on the market this fall.

With Pimlico Race Course now demolished and ambitiously projected to be rebuilt in time for the 2027 GI Preakness Stakes, Laurel will continue to host the bulk of the state's racing (except for Timonium Fair). Once Pimlico opens for 120 days of racing annually, Laurel will transition to training only.

The news site *Maryland Matters* reported July 1 that one member of the Board of Public Works, Dereck Davis—who also happens to be the state treasurer—raised concerns about whether the escalating costs to try and preserve racing in Maryland were worth it.

"We've got to take a hard look at this, and [figure out if Maryland racing can] work on its own, or is this something that we permanently have to prop up?" Davis said.

"I mean, the numbers are just sort of staggering to me, [and] this is not monopoly money. These are real dollars that can help real citizens and do real things for the state of Maryland that will help it move forward, as opposed to trying to keep, you know, a dream, an industry, afloat," Davis said.

This coming week prospective bidders for Hawthorne Race Course will be asking themselves essentially the same question as they try to determine if the price is right to save racing in Chicago.

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Favored Zulu Kingdom came flying late, but pacesetting Mi Bago refused to yield and the two rivals finished in a dead heat for the win in the GIII Kelso Stakes at Saratoga Sunday. Mi Bago zipped out to the early lead and was under a snug hold while clear through a quarter in :24.19 and a half in :48.51, with Zulu Kingdom tucked in along the hedge just in behind him.

Zulu Kingdom was buried in traffic at the top of the lane, but bravely darted to daylight between foes approaching midstretch and the favorite was full of run with the wire looming. Mi Bago looked likely to be swallowed up, but dug in gamely in the final strides to finish on even terms with his more accomplished rival.

"He's an overachiever," winning trainer Mark Casse said of the 9-1 shot Mi Bago. "You wish all horses were as tough as he is."

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Casse continued, “They posted the winner as the ‘one’ [Zulu Kingdom] and then they put up the dead heat. Normally, it’s the thrill of victory to the agony of defeat. I went from the agony of defeat to the thrill of victory. I’m happy. I was saying out there, ‘I’ll take half of it, I’m not greedy.’”

Jose Ortiz, aboard Mi Bago, said, “I thought it was very close honestly. [Zulu Kingdom] put a head in front of me and then I kind of came back. I was a little anxious that it [the photo] took so long. When the numbers started flashing [to show a dead heat], it felt pretty good.”

Of his trip, Ortiz added, “I wasn’t expecting to go that easy [on the lead]. He was traveling very well the first part and when I asked to him go, he exploded. Then the other horse came [running]. They both deserve it.”

Aboard favored Zulu Kingdom, Flavien Prat said, “I thought going into the first turn we were going to be having a decent pace and then they slowed it down. It ended up being a slow pace and both horses sprinted home. I thought his body was in front of Mark’s horse, I just thought it was a bad situation. It sounded like after the wire he got beat, but I thought it was very tight.”

Zulu Kingdom set the pace before settling for third as the favorite in the June 7 GIII Poker Stakes over this course and trip last time out. The bay, now a winner of eight of 11 lifetime starts, won the 2024 GIII With Anticipation over the Saratoga lawn, as well as that year’s GII Pilgrim Stakes. He won the GI American Turf Stakes last May and was back at Saratoga to win the GIII Manila Stakes in July. Zulu Kingdom finished first, but was disqualified to fourth while ending his 2025 campaign in the GII National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame Stakes. He opened 2026 with a win in the Apr. 10 GI Maker’s Mark Mile Stakes before his third-place effort in the Poker.

Mi Bago was a three-time stakes winner over the Gulfstream lawn, but had failed to hit the board in six previous tries in graded company. The bay gelding was coming off a romping front-running victory versus fellow New York-breds in the June 3 Kingston Stakes last time out.

Pedigree Notes:

Mi Bago is the 12th graded stakes winner for his sire, Vekoma, and he joins **Jonathan’s Way** as one of two for the stallion out of an Indian Charlie mare.

Mi Bago’s unraced dam, Wabanaki, has a yearling colt by **Highly Motivated** and she produced a full-sister to the Kelso winner this year. The mare sold to bloodstock agent Sean Perl for \$45,000 at the 2024 Fasig-Tipton Digital sale.

His third dam, Battle Creek Girl, produced Canadian champion Wavering Girl.

FLIGHTLINE’S SHONAN GALLEON SETS CLASS RECORD ON HAKODATE DEBUT *by Alan Carasso*

Tetsuhide Kunimoto’s **Shonan Galleon (Jpn)** (**Flightline**) was all the rage as the 3-10 chalk facing four other rivals while making his career debut in an 1800-meter newcomers’ contest on the turf Sunday at Hakodate. He lived right up to his advance billing, taking command at will before edging effortlessly away while stopping the timer in 1:47.6 over a track rated good-to-firm and establishing a new 2-year-old course record in the process.

A ¥210 million (*about \$1,305,652*) purchase as a foal at the 2024 Japan Racing Horse Association (JRHA) Select Sale on the island of Hokkaido, Shonan Galleon was the subject of a good deal of attention in the lead-up to this first appearance and was bet as if he couldn’t lose. The money and hype proved to be warranted.

Drawn gate one, Shonan Galleon was just beaten for speed and was settled in mid-field by jockey Katsuma Sameshima as the filly **Danon Cube (Jpn)** (Kitasan Black {Jpn})--purchased as a yearling for nearly \$860,000 at last year's Select Sale--showed the way through the opening 800 meters in a reasonable :48.1.

Danon Cube, the chief pari-mutuel protagonist at 5-1, opened up a sizable advantage in the hands of the legendary Yutaka Take down the backstraight, but Shonan Galleon was slipped a bit of rein and was poised to strike as the stretch loomed. Given a squeeze by Sameshima with about 200 meters to travel, Shonan Galleon easily gathered up the front-runner and raced clear under hands-and-heels encouragement ([video](#)). The winning margin was 2 1/2 lengths and the final time shaved 0.5 seconds off the previous 2-year-old record established last July.

"He has the makings of a star. I want to take good care of him," said Sameshima, as quoted by Netkeiba on X.

Next up for the winner could be the G3 Sapporo Nisai Stakes (1800m) on Sept. 5, per NetKeiba.

Shonan Galleon is the third overall winner for his freshman sire (by **Tapit**) and his second from two starters in Japan, joining the impressive debut winner Demian, himself a \$1.7-million Keeneland September yearling. The Feb. 13 foal is the first produce for his dam, Argentina's champion 2-year-old filly of 2022, with Group 1 successes on both dirt and turf.

The bay shares interesting pedigree symmetry with **Flightline's** 'TDN Rising Star' presented by Hagyard Flight Command, as his dam sire Full Mast is a son of Mizzen Mast, whose exceptional daughter Stonetastic is also by the latter stallion and is the granddam of Flight Command.

Tan Gritona's youngest produce are a yearling filly by leading sire Kizuna (Jpn) and a colt by Epiphaneia (Jpn) foaled Apr. 20 of this year. Neither is entered for this year's Select Sale, which is scheduled for July 13 and 14.

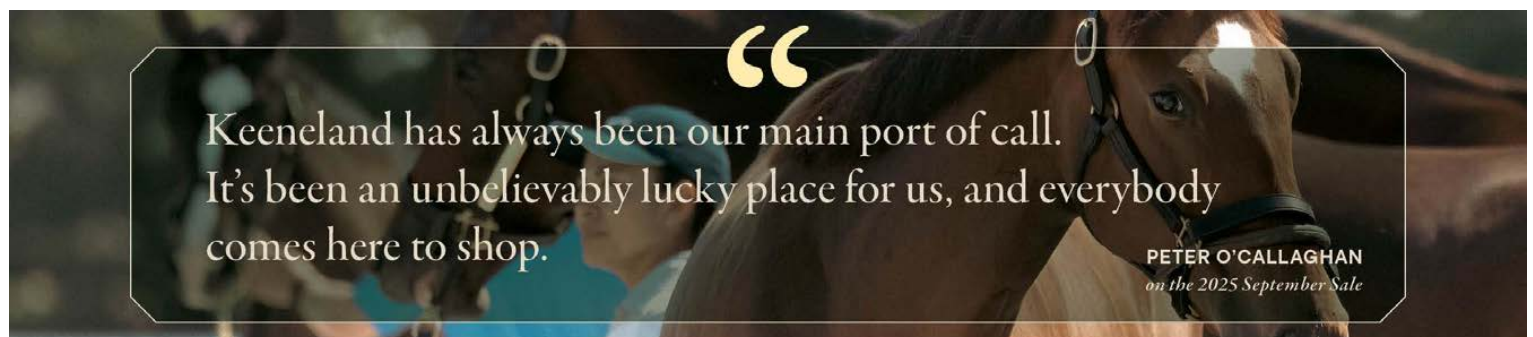

Steadying off heels early, Twenty Six Black settled into a spot in the clear and third from last through the blazing :20.90 first quarter set by Bring Theband Home (Into Mischief). As they rounded the turn, Twenty Six Black advanced between horses before angling out at the top of the lane, unfurling his rally as Bring Theband Homeheld still held up front for a :43.54 half before he tired. A Roger Cimborra, Jr. homebred, Twenty Six Black kicked clear of the field, opening up by daylight to leave no doubt as Possiblemente and Coppola chased him home.

"I love him. He's such a consistent horse," said winning trainer Horacio De Paz. "I saw him check a little bit and I was concerned about that a little bit, but it was probably the best thing that could happen because the pace was pretty fast. And then he comes with that run, it was good."

Prior to the Jaipur, Twenty Six Black placed with a neck second in the Elusive Quality Stakes at Belmont's Aqueduct meet May 2 in his only other start this year after closing out 2025 with a win in the New York Turf Sprint Championship Stakes. He's been exclusively racing in black-type events dating back to the fall of 2024, with an additional win in the Disco Partner Stakes and a number of placings, including in the GII Troy Stakes and GIII Belmont Turf Sprint Stakes. De Paz indicated another shot at the Troy, to be held at Saratoga Aug. 9, will likely be next on his agenda.

In the five path and in striking contention as they swung for home, the eventual winner had a fight on her hands, but battle she did down to the wire as Just a Minute arrived late to make things interesting. The trio hit the line together, and were a head away from one another for the top spots as Triskelion topped the group followed by Beach Heist and Just a Minute to round out the trifecta.

The victress is the first to the races for her dam, and the only registered foal of racing age. The mare's 2025 Arabian Lion was stillborn and her youngest is a 2026 colt by **Highly Motivated**. Victorian Gold is out of a daughter of Irish Group-placed Petite Princess (Dayjur), making the second dam a half-sister to MGSW Raylene (Tabasco Cat) and MSW Princess Janie (Elusive Quality). Gerrards Cross must like Monmouth Park very much, indeed.

The chestnut filly won the Colleen Stakes at the seashore oval last summer for her second victory in two lifetime starts, but hadn't found the winner's circle in three starts since while navigating two multi-month layoffs. Last seen finishing second in the Stormy Blues Stakes at Laurel June 14, Gerrards Cross returned to Monmouth and the winner's circle for Sunday's Monmouth County Stakes.

"It was an awesome performance by her," said winning trainer Kathleen O'Connell. "It was truly what I expected. She's been training like a monster."

Sprinting straight to the front, Gerrards Cross took command right away, opened up by two lengths in the lane, and couldn't be caught, asserting herself to a 2 1/4-length win as Spinelli chased her gate to wire. Tap Into Grace closed from the rear of the field to claim third by a neck.

"She's a fast filly and she loves the turf at Monmouth," said rider Cipriano Gil. "The plan was to go to the front. It's easy there with not having to constantly push. She does it naturally. She was relaxed the whole way."

Dam Spanish Concert has also produced five-time stakes-placed Dream Concert (Jess's Dream) and 2-year-old filly Roccarosso Rocket (Khozan), who was unplaced in her first career start May 29 at Gulfstream and, like Gerrards Cross, is racing as a James Chicklo homebred. Watson, disqualified from first going five furlongs at Gulfstream in his only previous start June 13 after drifting out and impeding a rival, technically entered the Proud Man Stakes a maiden. The Arindel homebred exited a determined winner of his first black-type event.

"[There's] just a lot of emotion," said winning trainer Nick Tomlinson, a former assistant to Mark Casse who went out on his own last fall. The Proud Man Stakes was his first stakes winner.

"When it's your own name on the paper, it's different. I'm very grateful. It's not easy to sweat those kinds of races out, but I'm glad he got the job done."

Pressuring leader Candy Cole (**Twirling Candy**) from second on the outside through a :23.08 first quarter, Watson headed the frontrunner leaving the turn, putting that one away with authority only to be accosted by Gaelic Legacy. The two battled down the lane, with Gaelic Legacy appearing to get Watson's measure and putting his head in front, only for Watson to fight back and refuse to lose, finishing a neck to the good on the line.

Breaking a step slow and brushing with her inner rival, Embrace Time raced from the rear of the field for most of the trip and had a wall of horses to run down turning for home.

Swinging eight wide but rally steadily despite an awkward move inside the final furlong, she had the top pair in her sights as the gap between them closed at the sixteenth pole. Bumped during the duel, Embrace Time got her head down in the nick of time to win the photo over Call the Bullpen (**Cairo Prince**), who held on to the runner-up spot by a nose. The victress is the most recent to the races for her dam, who does have a juvenile in the wings named Negan's Savior (**Quality Road**).

Edging up despite Florent Geroux sitting chilly until the top of the stretch, French Blue took command and kicked clear in the lane while chased home by Overcome Adversity (**Maclean's Music**), who finished 1 1/2 lengths back in second.

The bay winner, a Three Chimneys homebred, broke her maiden on debut over the same distance at Santa Anita in January, followed by a third in the GIII Santa Ysabel Stakes in March. After setting the pace before succumbing in the GII Santa Anita Oaks in April, she failed to make much of an impact in a trio of non-stakes starts at Churchill Downs before finding the winner's circle again Sunday.

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CALANDAGAN SWOOPS FOR GRAND PRIX DE SAINT-CLOUD REPEAT



Calandagan | Scoop Dyga

Calandagan (**Gleneagles**) entered Sunday's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud with a question to answer and did so in his customary style to register back-to-back successes in the 12-furlong feature.

Bogged down in the Coronation Cup last month, the flagship performer of the Aga Khan Studs had his favoured lively conditions here and was dropped out as usual by Mickael Barzalona with every rival ahead. Last at the 500-metre marker and in front at the furlong pole, the 30-100 favourite closed out with his trademark dazzling sectionals, hitting 10.94, 10.55 and 11.18 for the last three furlongs.

At the line, the homebred had a neck to spare over Godolphin's **Cualificar** (Lope De Vega), with 3/4-of-a-length back to the winner's stablemate **Sunly** (Night Of Thunder) in third and another four to last year's runner-up **Aventure** (**Sea The Stars**), running a time of 2:27.27 which is a second faster than he managed in 2025.

"I was upset with myself at Epsom and he was on edge and sweating more than usual today, so I was worried," Francis Graffard said of the winner, who was registering his sixth victory at this level. "In the end, I said to Mickael to just ride him to suit and trust in him. He's such a good horse." **Cont. p3**

DARDANOS SPRINGS 84-1 DEUTSCHES DERBY SHOCK, SIXTH WINNER FOR ANDREAS WOHLER

Stall Bergholz's one-from-five Listed Dortmund Derby Trial runner-up **Dardanos** (Soldier Hollow) was an unconsidered 84-1 chance for Sunday's G1 Idee 157th Deutsches Derby at Hamburg and belied his monster odds to provide trainer Andreas Wohler with a sixth renewal of Germany's Blue Riband.

Wohler's first success came via Pik Konig (Königsstuhl) in 1992 and his latest winners include Isfahan (Lord Of England) in 2016 and 2019 hero Laccario (Scalo).

"He is such an easy horse to ride, so I was happy to be booked and really looked forward to the race," said jockey Wladimir Panov after registering his first win in the contest. "He is so relaxed, he does everything you want and I had an excellent trip. It is an emotional moment and I am overjoyed." **Cont. p4**

"He's like a greyhound--if you put a rabbit in front of him, he tries to catch it," Graffard added. "These Group 1s are hard races and I like them to enjoy them--I think it was really good for him and I think he'll be very pleased with himself. The plan is to go back to the King George and Ascot is a good place for him, but it is closer to this race this year, so we'll see how he comes out of this--it's very hot today."

Graffard was also impressed by the effort of Sunly, who was coming of age with conditions to suit.

"In the paddock beforehand she was magnificent," he said of the Juddmonte homebred. "She looked fantastic and she's a strong filly. She had a good draw, a perfect trip behind the leaders, and she quickened nicely. I nearly thought she was going to win at one stage--I was focusing more on her than Calandagan, who I thought was too far back.

"She's a good filly who has the option of the Prix Vermeille, but she deserves to take her chance in the Yorkshire Oaks. She's a very late-maturing filly and a filly I've always held in very high regard. Today, with good ground and 2,400 metres, she fully confirmed her ability."

Louise Benard, Godolphin's representative in France, said of last year's Prix du Jockey Club runner-up and Prix Niel winner

Cualificar, "We were hoping to see the same Cualificar we saw in last year's Prix du Jockey Club--his first two runs of the season had been perfectly respectable and we hoped he would improve for those races. That's exactly what we saw today. He travelled well throughout and enjoyed a good trip.

"There was plenty of pace, which suits him. We came here hoping to win, but we're all delighted to finish second behind Calandagan and so close to him. For us, this was simply confirmation of what we had expected and Monsieur [Andre] Fabre will decide what's next. He's a horse who performs well over this distance and isn't particularly dependent on the ground."

Pedigree Notes

Calandagan is the second foal out of Prix Minerve runner-up Calayana (Sinndar), whose two other black-type performers are the Prix de Thiberville winner Calasita (**Zarak**) and the Prix Belle de Nuit third Calamandra (News Bay).

From the family of Danehill's Poule d'Essai des Poulains-winning sire Clodovil and the Group 3 winner and Arlington Million third Colombian (Azamour), Calayana's two-year-old filly is by Palace Pier, while she also has a colt foal by **Siyouni**.

Stall Bergholz's Friedrich von Lenthe added, "I can't yet believe what has happened. We were hoping to maybe get placed, or perhaps finish in the first five or six home, but to win is awesome."

Wohler continued, "One of Dardanos's owners is a Hamburg native and that is something very special. Dardanos definitely needed his latest outing and he improved for that, but we did not really know just how much. Winning the Derby always is and always will be so very special."

Dardanos, one of three contenders representing Wohler, was the last to load and first into stride and accepted a tow in second before slipping to fourth once past halfway.

Repeating this week's popular tactic of heading wide with the field off the home turn, he gained an edge passing the quarter-mile and stayed on relentlessly under continued rousting in the closing stages to prevail by a length and the same from the Liberty Racing duo **Chiefland** (Study Of Man) and **Salitos** (In Swoop). **Kairos (Zarak)**, another Liberty Racing nominee, finished two lengths back in fourth.

SIYOUNI'S SOREANGA REGAINS WINNING HABIT AT HAMBURG

Last season's Listed Junioren-Preis victrix **Soreanga (Siyouni)** failed to fire in Hoppegarten's G3 Diana-Trial on seasonal return in May, but bounced back in determined fashion to secure a narrow verdict in Sunday's G3 Hugo Pfohe Horsepower Trophy - Hamburger Stutenpreis at Hamburg.

The 5-1 third choice bounded forward for control after being the slowest of seven into stride and remained on the front end thereafter.

Sent wide to the stands' side rail off the home turn, she was tackled by old foe **Believe In Me (Intello)** approaching the final furlong and stayed on resolutely under a late drive to prevail by a short-head in a pulsating duel. Three-race maiden **Noble Lips (Gleneagles)** fared best of the remainder and finished 3 1/4 lengths back in third.

"She is a fantastic filly. She fought brilliantly and proved that she belongs in this class," winning jockey Eduardo Pedroza told *GaloppOnline*.

Owner Andreas Jacobs added, "The way she fought in the last 300 metres was impressive and the goal is the [G1 Preis der] Diana [German Oaks at Dusseldorf] in four weeks."

Soreanga is the fifth of six foals and one of three black-type performers out of an unraced sibling of G3 Bavarian Classic victor **Saphir (Black Sam Bellamy)**, multiple stakes-winning G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) second **Sarandia (Dansili)**, stakes-winning G3 Prix des Chenes second **Saint Pellerin (Konigstiger)** and the dual stakes-placed **Salontanzerin (Black Sam Bellamy)**.

CHAMPION MILER FIELD OF GOLD RETIRED FROM RACING, JOINS JUDDMONTE ROSTER FOR 2027

Field Of Gold (**Kingman**), who proved himself Europe's leading three-year-miler of 2025 with consecutive Group 1 wins in the Irish 2,000 Guineas and St James's Palace Stakes, has been retired from racing and will stand at Juddmonte's Banstead Manor Stud in 2027.

Trained by John and Thady Gosden, Field Of Gold was a dual winner as a two-year-old, notably when emulating his sire, **Kingman**, with victory in the G3 Solario Stakes at Sandown, before he returned the following year with a three-and-a-half-length success in the G3 Craven Stakes at Newmarket. A near miss in the 2,000 Guineas was then followed by the two standout performances of his career at the Curragh and Royal Ascot, with his victory in the St James's Palace, by three and a half lengths from **Henri Matisse**, confirming his standing as the leading miler of his generation.

Though below his best in two subsequent starts in 2025, hopes had been high that Field Of Gold might be able to rediscover his best form after he kicked off his four-year-old campaign with a runner-up finish in the G2 bet365 Mile at Sandown. However, it has now been confirmed that he will not be ready to return to top-level racing in 2026, having suffered from a bacterial lung infection which forced him to miss the G1 Lockinge Stakes and G1 Queen Anne Stakes. He retires as the winner of five of his 11 starts and just shy of £1 million in career earnings.

John Gosden said, "Field Of Gold combined speed, looks and class in bountiful measure. He possessed incredible acceleration and a superb action which he demonstrated in the St James's Palace Stakes. A very powerful and well-balanced colt with a great temperament."

Bred by Bobby and Honora Donworth of Roundhill Stud, Field Of Gold entered the Juddmonte fold after being purchased for €530,000 at the Goffs November Foal Sale. He is one of three winners from as many runners out of the winning Shamardal mare Princess de Lune, with the others including the Listed Rosemary Stakes heroine Zanbaq (Oasis Dream).

Princess de Lune, in turn, is a full-sister to the dual Group 2 winner and multiple Group 1-placed sire Puissance De Lune, as well as the G2 Middleton Stakes scorer Queen Power. She is also a half-sister to the G1 Prix d'Isphahan hero Zabeel Prince, by Shamardal's son, Lope De Vega, and to Serena's Storm (Statue Of Liberty), the dam of the top-class fillies Rizeena (Iffraaj) and Summer Romance (**Kingman**). The third dam, Serena's Sister, is a full-sister to Rahy's multiple Grade I-winning matriarch and champion Serena's Song.

A stud fee for Field Of Gold will be announced at a later date.

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JERRY CHAU AND LUKE FERRARIS JOIN VINCENT HO IN TEAM HONG KONG AT SHERGAR CUP

Emerging stars Jerry Chau and Luke Ferraris have been selected alongside Vincent Ho to represent Team Hong Kong at the 25th Shergar Cup, which takes place at Ascot on Saturday, August 8 and will be run under the World Pool banner for the first time. **Cont. p9**

The six-race card will join the global commingling pool's fixture list, which is powered by over 20 international wagering partners.

Ho, Chau and Ferraris will vie against a host of champion jockeys representing Great Britain and Ireland, Europe and the Rest of the World in the annual team competition.

Riders will carry their team's silks in races, with points awarded to the first five horses past the winning post: 15 for first, 10 for second, seven for third, five for fourth and three for fifth. The team with the most points at the end of the competition wins, while the Silver Saddle--secured by the Hong Kong-based Hugh Bowman in 2025--goes to the jockey who accumulates the most points.

Andrew Harding, Executive Director, Racing, The Hong Kong Jockey Club, said, "The Hong Kong Jockey Club is thrilled to be represented with Team Hong Kong at the 25th running of the Shergar Cup. Joining captain Vincent Ho is the talented duo of Jerry Chau, who graduated from our own Apprentice Jockeys' School, and Luke Ferraris, a global rising star who has had a long association with Hong Kong racing.

"The introduction of Team Hong Kong reflects Hong Kong's world-class racing, with the jockeys' roster in Hong Kong representing the most competitive anywhere on the planet. It is also incredibly exciting to see this year's Shergar Cup run as part of the World Pool, which is a natural development of our commitment to the continued globalisation of horse racing and the development of premier racing events around the world."

Nick Smith, Director of Racing and Public Affairs, Ascot Racecourse, added, "Today's announcement marks probably the most important milestone in the 25-year history of the Dubai Duty Free Shergar Cup.

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ÎLE SAINT-LOUIS – A PRIVATE MANSION APARTMENT OF RARE DISTINCTION

Paris 4th · 175 m² · Seine View · €6,450,000

Few addresses in Paris carry the weight of this one. On the Île Saint-Louis stands a private mansion conceived in the 17th century by the architect to Louis XIV. Available for the first time in years, this 175 m² second-floor apartment is an act of inheritance.

Three façade wings trace the curve of the Seine, and the rooms unfold in enfilade, each turning toward the water and light — no buildings opposite, only the river and Paris as it has always been.

The bones are magnificent: Versailles parquet, French casement shutters, carved stone. Master artisans have brought a total, extraordinary renovation to these volumes. Two reception rooms face one another — one anchored by a grand mirror-chandelier, the other rising into a sweeping vertical composition. Frescoes, painted panels, and doors inspired by Dante's Divine Comedy converse with exposed stone rooted in four centuries of history.

A spiraling carved-stone stair ascends to three independent suites, one a duplex, each offering genuine autonomy. A raised alcove, drawn from Versailles, crowns the uppermost volume.
