



## \$3.2-MILLION NYQUIST COLT ON TOP AS FASIG-TIPTON SARATOGA SALE BLAZES OUT OF THE GATE

SARATOGA SPRINGS, NY - The Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale had its first seven-figure result just 19 hips in when Amr Zedan bid \$2 million for a colt by **Curlin**, and it produced the last of the first session's 15 million-dollar yearlings when M.V. Magnier and Peter Brant went to \$1.9 million for a colt by **Gun Runner**, the very last hip through the ring. Somewhere in the middle of the action-packed session, a colt by **Nyquist** claimed the day's top spot when selling for \$3.2 million to Randy and Jenny Boyd's Boyd Racing.

At the close of business Monday night, 79 yearlings had grossed \$54,395,000--more than half of the 2025 auction's total record gross of \$100,845,000. The session average of \$688,544 was well ahead of last year's total sale record figure of \$626,366, as was the session median of \$500,000. The record 2025 cumulative median was \$450,000.

During last year's opening session, 77 yearlings grossed \$39,975,000 for an average of \$519,156 and a median of \$400,000.

## FAIR HILL, HISA LAUNCH INVESTIGATION INTO TRAINING CENTER SHIPPERS *by Bill Finley*

After a group of Fair Hill shippers coming off long layoffs and with some common connections won four races Sunday and, in one instance, produced a suspiciously low daily double payoff, training center General Manager Will Phipps confirmed that the Maryland facility will launch an investigation.

The races in question took place at both Saratoga and Monmouth. The New York Racing Association has also taken steps to answer the many questions the performances raised.

"NYRA has referred the matter to HISA, HIWU, and the TRPB for further investigation," said NYRA Vice President of Communications Patrick McKenna.

Through a spokesperson, HISA issued a statement last Monday afternoon, which reads: "HISA is aware of information circulating on social media and concerns raised directly to HISA personnel regarding events at multiple races on Aug. 9 and is actively investigating those concerns. We take any potential violations of HISA rules extremely seriously. **Cont. p15**

"It was a tremendous start to the 105th Saratoga Yearling Sale tonight," said Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning, Jr. "Literally from beginning to end, from hip number two--since hip one was a scratch--to the last horse in the ring tonight. The energy was palpable. The bidding activity was very, very strong. It was a tremendous session."

Browning said Monday's results confirmed the optimism that had been building around the sale all summer.

"We were optimistic when we put together the Saratoga catalogue," he said. "We were more optimistic when the horses unloaded off the vans and we saw them on the sales grounds. We got even more optimistic as we saw the level of activity on the sales grounds with people looking, got even more optimistic when we saw the vetting, in terms of repository activity. But despite our optimism, it exceeded our expectations."

Browning added the 2026 Saratoga auction still had to come out strong for its second session Tuesday.

"We like where we are at halftime, and we hope to be able to put together another great sale tomorrow night," Browning said. "We have another bunch of really, really good horses to go through the ring tomorrow night. I'll sleep a little better tonight. But we've still got half the work to do."

Tuesday's final session of the Saratoga sale begins at 6:30 p.m.

**Nyquist** Colt Steals the Show at Fasig Opener

Flattered by a trio of yearlings to bring over seven figures on Monday, **Nyquist** was represented by Monday's session-topping yearling, secured for \$3.2 million by Brittany Linton on behalf of Randy and Jenny Boyd's Boyd Racing. Offered as hip 83, the colt was consigned by Gainesway, acting as agent for Stonestreet.

Out of GII Thoroughbred Club of America Stakes winner Slammed (Marking), the Feb. 11 foal is bred on a similar cross to GISWs Nysos and Immersive.

Slammed, with this colt in utero, was purchased by Stonestreet for \$1.1 million at the 2024 Fasig-Tipton November Sale. This is her first foal.

According to Randy Boyd, the operation veered off its original plan heading into Monday's session.

"We came here with a strategy of buying two fillies, but we just fell in love with this colt," he admitted. "And like we say, we have a strategy, we stick to it, but every month we change the strategy. [Monday], we changed the strategy, but it was just a colt that we couldn't pass up."

During Monday's session, a quartet of **Nyquist** yearlings sold--from five through the ring--for a gross of \$5,975,000 for an average of \$1,493,750.

"The sire, **Nyquist**, of course," said Boyd when asked what attracted his team to the colt. "I just think it's just going to be an amazing colt. We think it has a possibility to be a Kentucky Derby horse one day."

What's next for the colt?

"Well, I can say that you'll initially go to Paul Sharp and that's where he'll do his initial training," Boyd confirmed. "But we haven't got the race trainer yet."

Returning to the prime directive later in the sale, the Boyd's also secured hip 104, a filly by **Quality Road**, for \$1.5 million. A daughter of GIII Indiana Oaks winner and GI Acorn Stakes runner-up Talk Veuve to Me (**Violence**), the Mar. 20 foal was also bred-sold by Stonestreet. Denali Stud acted as agent. Talk Veuve to Me is a half-sister to the stakes-placed Tiffany Case (Uncle Mo), the dam of champion Nitrogen (Medaglia d'Oro).

"We're buying fillies for the long term," Boyd added. "We want to buy fillies that have great potential to be a broodmare, and hopefully, they'll have a good career while they're racing. But the most important thing is to buy quality broodmares."--CBoss

### Ward All Shook Up Over \$2.3-Million **Gun Runner** Colt

Trainer Wesley Ward went to \$2.3 million to acquire a colt by **Gun Runner** (hip 78) from the Taylor Made Sale Agency consignment Monday at Saratoga and shortly after signing the ticket on the yearling, the client gained a partner in the colt's breeder, Three Chimneys Farm.

"Everything," Ward said when asked what he liked about the yearling. "I trained for Goncalo Torrealba and Three Chimneys. And Doug Cauthen and his team bring me out every year to see the horses in the sale. This was my favorite for the year so far. He's just a beautiful colt. I was very excited for him to come here. And sometimes they get here and they can go one way or the other and this horse just kept going the way that we wanted. Everything I want in a race horse. It looks like he's going to be, not just a really good horse, but also it looks like he could be a really nice 2-year-old for next year. So we're really excited."

The colt is out of 2015 GI Kentucky Oaks runner-up Shook Up (**Tapit**), who is also the dam of the stakes-winning and multiple graded-placed King Ottoman (**Curlin**).

"Goncalo jumped in and Three Chimneys is going to take half the horse," Ward said. "We're going to put our partnership together for the other half."

Of the colt's final price tag, Ward added, "I thought he was a \$2-million horse and we had to go a couple more to get him, but we were excited."

Three Chimneys purchased Shook Up for \$1.65 million at the 2015 Keeneland November sale.

"That colt has been a star from day one and a farm favorite, all the grooms, managers, everybody liked the horse," Doug Cauthen said. "And he came up here and really showed himself very well. The sales company, the consignors all did a great job and we expected him to bring in that realm."

Of the decision to stay in on the colt, Cauthen said, "We asked him after the fact and he kindly said we could stay in. So that's great because we do like the horse a lot."

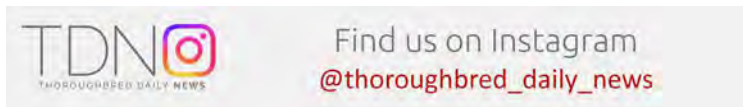
Cauthen added, "Almost all the [Three Chimneys] horses go to auction and Goncalo loves partnering with people. So if people come up, he likes to stand behind his product and we'll stay in with them. ## Into Mischief Colt Tops Flying Dutchman's Saratoga Shopping List

Hunter Rankin said he was finding plenty of competition while bidding on behalf of Flying Dutchmen during Monday's first session of the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale, but even so the Boersma family's racing operation came away with five new yearlings for a total of \$5,225,000. **Cont. p7**

The group was led by a colt by Into Mischief (**hip 91**) purchased for \$2.3 million from Hill 'n' Dale at Xalapa, which was consigning the colt on behalf of his breeder, Don Alberto Corporation. The yearling is out of multiple graded-placed Stellar Sound (**Tapit**), a half-sister to Grade I-placed 'TDN Rising Star' presented by Hagyard Luminance (Tale of the Cat), whose dam Silent Serenade (Unbridled's Song) was purchased by Don Alberto for \$1.025 million at the 2017 Keeneland January Sale carrying the filly that would become Stellar Sound. A full-brother to hip 91 topped last year's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale when selling for \$4.1 million to Coolmore and White Birch Farm.

"He's out of a great mare," Rankin said of the yearling. "They breed great horses over there and it's fun to buy horses off them. He was a really nice horse. We are just really excited to get him."

Flying Dutchman also purchased a colt by **Cody's Wish** (**hip 50**) for \$950,000 and a colt by **Curlin** (**hip 51**) for \$800,000--both from Lane's End--a colt by **Life is Good** (**hip 30**) for \$675,000 from Taylor Made Sales Agency, and a full-brother to GI Preakness Stakes winner National Treasure (**Quality Road**) (**hip 102**) for \$500,000 from Bridie Harrison, agent for Peter E. Blum Thoroughbreds.

"There is a lot of a negative stuff people say about the business, but there are a lot of people excited about it," Rankin said. "Our group is excited and I know a lot of new groups who are excited, too. We've been outbid a bunch tonight. That's a really good thing for the business. We have tried really, really hard. It's a good sign for this market." [@JessMartiniTDN](#)

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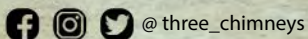

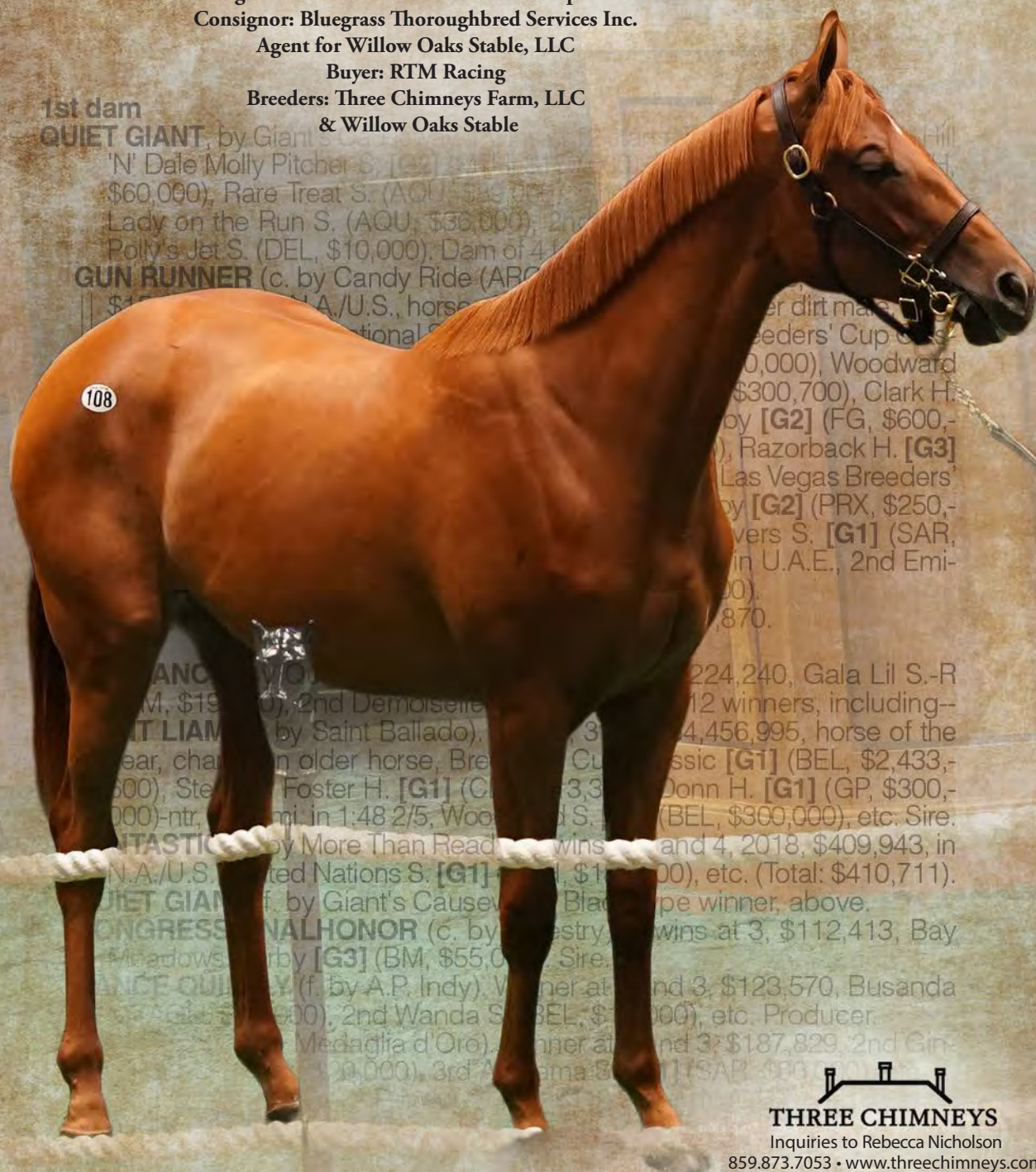

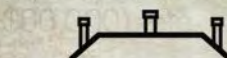

**Curlin Colt Wows Early at Fasig-Tipton Saratoga**

With only a handful of yearlings having passed through the ring at Monday's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga opener, a colt by supersire **Curlin** drew a cool \$2 million from Donato Lanni bidding on behalf of Amr Zedan. Plying his trade from the balcony above the main sales ring, Lanni was accompanied by Zedan in addition to Hall of Famer Bob Baffert.

"He's a horse that the whole team liked. Bob loved the horse," said Lanni. "He was a horse that impressed us from the very beginning. At Saratoga, you have so much time to look at these horses, if you ever have a reason to get off a horse. We just stayed on the horse."

"There's not going to be too many of those Curlins left," added Lanni. "Unfortunately, he's getting a little older. He had the [Kentucky] Derby winner [Golden Tempo] this year and he's been such a great sire."

Out of Merlazza (Medaglia d'Oro), hip 19 was consigned by Hill 'n' Dale at Xalapa.

"Pedigree looks like he'll stretch out," added Lanni. "He's a very mature colt, very athletic colt. Just a really, really cool colt."

Merlazza is a full-sister to the dual Grade III-placed Gold Standard and a half to Mapit (**Tapit**), responsible for GSW and GISP Where's My Ring (**Twirling Candy**). This is the extended family of MGISW Dream Supreme.

"You never know what they're going to bring, but the good ones always seem to cost a lot. I know there was a lot of competition for the horse. I'm a very happy guy."

**Curlin**, who stands at Hill 'n' Dale, **was withdrawn from breeding service earlier this season.**

"Curlin has been everything to Hill 'n' Dale," said Hill 'n' Dale's Jes Sikura. "He's been the flag bearer at Hill 'n' Dale for the last decade. He's been our Classic sire, America's Classic sire. He got his Kentucky Derby winner. He's had a son win every leg of the Triple Crown, Breeders' Cup Classic, everything. And now that there's obviously a little bit more of a limited number of horses, they're in high demand."

In regard to Monday's fourth top-priced yearling of the session, Sikura explained, "To be up here in Saratoga, it's such a great sale to look the way he did, move the way he did, and show the way he did all week."

He added, "I think the way he moved, he was a beautiful mover with a huge overstep. He was also strong, sleek, light on his feet. So I think as a whole, he stood out and he looked like he has a lot of room to develop to be a strong, robust, athletic curling colt. So there were a lot of things about him physically that stood out and made him a star and achieved the result he just did."

Asked about the price, he said, "Probably past the expectations. I thought he was going to sell really well. I didn't really have a number in mind, nor do I think anybody did, but I think that was definitely a little past the range we were expecting." --CBoss

## Gunning to the Very End

Some might have been worried that their yearling would be strolling through the sales ring as the very last offering of an evening session, however, agents Hanzly Albina and Ron Blake were not among them. When their striking **Gun Runner** colt strode into the sales ring at the end of the night, several key players were still sitting in the pavilion. Among them, the Coolmore team in tandem with White Birch Farm's Peter Brant, who changed things up by sitting on the upper level to do their bidding. When all was said and done, the partners landed Hip 113 for \$1.9 million, ending the evening as the fifth highest-priced colt of the session.

Armed with only a pair of yearlings on Day 1, Blake-Albina sold both of them, including a **Gunite** colt (hip 39) that sold earlier in the session for \$310,000.

Were they concerned about the late post?

"No," affirmed Albina. "We thought we were going to close it out pretty strongly and they would wait around for us. So I wouldn't say we were worried. If we'd been the last horse tomorrow, we may have been worried. But today we're okay with it. It's a **Gun Runner**, so that's going to keep them in the seats."

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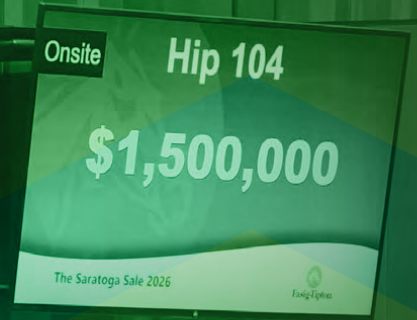

Out of SW Toni Tools (Roaring Fever), the colt is a half-brother to GI Darley Alcibiades Stakes winner and millionaire Candied (Candy Ride {Arg}).

Asked what made the chestnut so special, Albina responded, "He obviously has an extremely good pedigree. He's a 3/4-brother to a Grade I-winning filly and he is by the best dirt sire in the world. And he's a specimen that, in the best sale of the finest horses in the year, stood out. And the buyers know what they want. They want the best stuff. They want the best times, the best mares, and the best physicals. And he embodied all three of those things."

He added, "We were flattered by all the people who looked at the horse and gave us praise. It just reaffirms what you're doing and that you're trying to do it the right way."--CBoss

## Owens Strikes for Uncle Mo Colt

"He's going to be a Derby winner," Lori Owens said after purchasing a colt by Uncle Mo (hip 54) for \$1.5 million in the name of her B-4 Farms Monday in Saratoga. The colt was consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency on behalf of his breeder, Barbara Banke's Stonestreet. The yearling is out of Grade I winner and former 'TDN Rising Star' presented by Hagyard Rachel's Valentina (Bernardini), a daughter of champion Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro).

Owens said the colt would likely be trained by Steve Asmussen.

From Abilene, Texas, Owens has been in racing for the better part of a decade now and has campaigned Canoodling (Pioneerof the Nile), winner of the 2022 GIII Wilshire Stakes and GIII Megahertz Stakes, and multiple stakes winner and multiple graded-placed Bye Bye Bobby (Quality Road) with trainer Todd Fincher. @JessMartiniTDN

## 'The One We Came For': Holliday Nabs Nyquist Filly for \$1.375 Million

Marc Holliday, CEO of SL Green and chairman of the New York Racing Association Board of Directors, had one horse on his wish list when he came to the Saratoga sale Monday and it was mission accomplished when he went to \$1.375 million to acquire the filly by Nyquist (hip 49) from the Paramount Sales consignment.

The yearling is out of Pray for Leslie (Bernardini) and is a half-sister to multiple graded winner Praying (Vekoma).

"She was the one we came here for," Holliday, who did his bidding alongside bloodstock agent Dan Hayden and trainer Carlos Martin, said. "She's that cross of Nyquist with Bernardini mares I think is going to be something that we're going to have a lot of fun with on the racetrack and for many years in the breeding shed. So I'm very, very happy with how it turned out."

The filly was bred by Jeff Kerber and Jeff Prunzik.

Holliday concluded, "She's an extremely well-balanced filly and she vetted Triple A-plus. For me, that's what I look for for this kind of purchase. We're going to send her down to Ocala and see how she develops." @JessMartiniTDN

### \$1.15-Million **Gun Runner** Filly a Career High for Veteran Breeder Stautberg

Caroline Stautberg has been selling yearlings in Saratoga for three decades and the Monkton, Maryland, breeder had her biggest sale to date Monday in Saratoga when her **Gun Runner** filly (**hip 108**) sold for \$1.15 million to RTM Racing. Consigned by Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services, the chestnut, bred on a foal share with Three Chimneys Farm, is out of graded-placed **Tapit's World** (**Tapit**) and is a full-sister to multiple graded stakes winner and Grade I-placed **Il Miracolo**.

"This is the highest," Stautberg, with a big smile, confirmed of the sale.

Stautberg admitted she had expected the filly could become her highest seller before she went through the ring Monday.

"But, I was thinking in the neighborhood of \$700,000 or maybe \$800,000 if everything went great. So I was delighted. And very surprised."

**Tapit's World's** 2-year-old daughter **Worldly Charm** (**Vekoma**), who sold for \$150,000 at Saratoga last August, recently made her racetrack debut, finishing third in the My Dear Stakes at Woodbine.

"I still have the mare," Stautberg said of **Tapit's World**, who she purchased for \$175,000 at the 2015 Fasig-Tipton November sale. "She is carrying a **Gun Runner**, but she also has a **Gun Runner** weanling that [farm manager] Darin [Martin] says looks just like this one, if not better."

Asked what it was like watching her first million-dollar sale, the 85-year-old Stautberg, who has just six broodmares, said, "I don't know. It was just unreal. It was beyond belief."

### Nakauchida Lands Two Seven-Figure Yearlings on Day 1

One of only two buyers to secure a pair of seven-figure yearlings during Fasig-Tipton's initial session, Japanese trainer Mitsumasa Nakauchida extended to \$1.9 million for hip 100, a filly by **Not This Time**, and hip 70, a colt by **Life Is Good** that brought \$1 million. Both yearlings were consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency as agent.

"It was a little bit more than what I expected, but the market is strong and Saratoga is such a good sale," said Nakauchida of his biggest expenditure of the evening. "Everyone's here, so you got to push very hard to secure a very good yearling."

Out of Grade III winner and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies third **Girl Daddy** (**Uncle Mo**), the bay filly is a full-sister to **On Time Girl**, winner of the GII Eight Belles Stakes and GIII Forward Gal Stakes.

Hip 70 is the second foal out of **Seabrook** (**Speightstown**), a daughter of SW and GSP **Regia Marina** (**Medaglia d'Oro**). This is the family of GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner and champion **Midshipman** and the late MGISW sire **Frosted**. **Cont. p13**



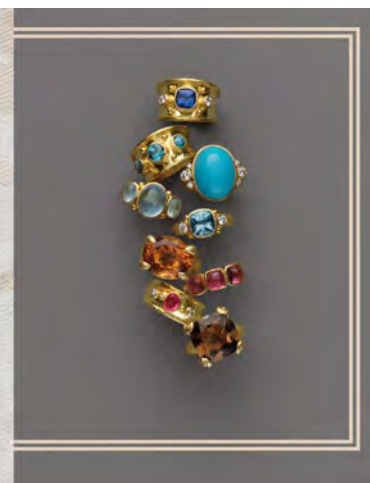

The conditioner explained he was also drawn to the colt's athleticism.

"He's by good stallion," he said. "He's not as proven yet, but I like **Life Is Good**. And I saw a few of them last year and as 2-year-olds and they are training good. So I think he's going to be a good stallion in the future. So we just took a gamble buying one of them."

**Life Is Good** is already the sire of Susumu Fujita's Lizhitsumodoraichi, a **debut winner** over 1800 meters at Niigata Racecourse on Aug. 2.--CBoss

### Stewart Extends to \$1 Million for **Nyquist** Colt

John Stewart's Resolute Bloodstock also entered the fray at Fasig-Tipton on Monday, purchasing a pair of colts. Leading the duo was hip 75, a colt by **Nyquist** out of Me and Mine (Bernardini) who brought \$1 million. From the extended family of European champion Hold That Tiger in addition to GI Belmont winner Editor's Note, the bay was consigned by Eaton Sales.

"When they walked him out, he just had a lot of class about him," explained Chelsea Stewart. "He was great on the shank, and checked all our boxes. He walked fantastic. We really loved him."

Asked about the seven-figure price, she added, "He was one at the top of our list, and I think we were happy with the value that we got on him. We were expecting them to kind of be in that range, but you never know what the sales. Sometimes they go through the roof, but we were thrilled with the outcome."

According to Stewart, the cross was also important in pushing the purchase across the finish line.

"As soon as we saw that he was a **Nyquist** colt out of a Bernardini mare, we were like, 'Oh, we've got to go look at him,'" she said. "It's the same cross as [Grade I winner] Nysos, so the sky's the limit. I mean, it's got a huge hip on him, so you know he's going to be speedy. So we're excited."

Earlier in the session, the Stewarts also secured hip 15, by **Life Is Good**. Out of Mae Never No (Ire) (**No Nay Never**), the Apr. 17 foal was a member of the Gainesway consignment.

Stewart confirmed that Resolute will partner with MyRacehorse on the Florida-bred colt.

When asked what the Resolute team is currently looking for, Stewart confirmed that quality colts were the primary target.

And while the Stewarts have become well-known buyers over the past few years, she confirmed that the team have expanded into a new direction in 2026.

"This is our first year we're taking yearlings to the market and we'll be selling [at Keeneland September]," confirmed Stewart. "And we've retained nine fillies. So we're just adding them up, but we're selling about 16 or 17 at Keeneland."

Resolute sold a pair of yearlings at Fasig-Tipton in July and will earmark an additional two or three for Fasig October.

"We sold our first two at Fasig in July and those both went off successfully, so we were excited with that," she said. "And then we also have a son of [MGISW] Caravel (Mizzen Mast) and [yearling by **Frankel {GB}**] at Tattersalls. So we'll be selling in Europe as well. It's the first year for everything."--CBoss



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### Life is More Than Good for Taylor

Taylor Made Sales Agency sent a pair of colts by **Life is Good** through the sales ring Monday in Saratoga on behalf of two different pinhooking partnerships and both yearlings provided handsome profits to their investors.

Early in the session, Flying Dutchmen purchased a colt by **Life is Good** (hip 30) for \$675,000. Mike Rose and Keiber Rengifo purchased the dark bay out of Most Empressive (Empire Maker) for \$185,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale.

"I went down to Florida in February and saw that colt," Taylor Made's Marshall Taylor said. "And from from the time I saw him, he had a beautiful shape. Every time we brought that colt out, he never turned a hair. He just kept going every time he walked. He just gave the same effort every time, and he's such a beautiful horse. He looks like a horse that could be running over the Saratoga track this time next year."

That early result was eclipsed later in the session when Taylor Made sold another colt by the WinStar stallion (**hip 70**) for \$1 million to Mitsu Nakauchida. Out of Seabrook (Speightstown), the yearling was purchased by Charlie Allen on behalf of Terry Stephens Racing for \$260,000 at Keeneland last November.

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"The first one we sold, he looked like a horse who would be running across the street, or might be running Keeneland next April. He looked like a real early, precocious horse. He had a really fast body, had a big walk, and he just looked like one of those horses that they'll be running early. The second one we just sold, he was a leggier two-turn-looking horse."

Of the two sets of partners, Taylor said, "We've sold for both of them for several years. Both of them came from Ocala. So I was down in Ocala, and I'd keep going from one stop to the next, so I'd get to see them both. But once **Life Is Good** started rolling with winners, I knew Saratoga was a great choice."

"Consistent with HIWU's test distribution plan, all horses that won the races referenced were immediately selected for Post-Race testing. Additional targeted Out-of-Competition Testing has been and will continue to be administered by HIWU. HISA has placed Threedots Andadash, who was entered to compete [Monday] at Presque Isle Downs by connections of the horses in question, on the HISA Veterinarians' List as deemed unfit to race. Threedots Andadash will remain on the Veterinarians' List pending further developments in the investigation. As HISA is not currently operating in West Virginia, it has informed the West Virginia Racing Commission about the other horse entered to race today with similar connections at Mountaineer.

"HISA and HIWU will continue to carefully review the available information and testing results and will take any appropriate action if the investigation determines that HISA rules have been violated. At this stage, HISA will not speculate on the outcome of the investigation or testing process."

Threedots Andadash hasn't run since May and has three slow workouts at Fair Hill.

A New Jersey racing official, who asked not to be quoted, also confirmed that the New Jersey Racing Commission is looking into the matter.

Trainer Angel Quiroz, who has stalls at Fair Hill, ran two horses at Monmouth. He won the third race with The Great Amira (Rock Your World), who last ran on Feb. 8 and finished 10th, beaten 15 lengths, in a \$35,000 maiden claiming race at Gulfstream. She was 20-1 on the morning line and was sent off at 17-1 and won the race by nine lengths under jockey Carlos Lugo. It was only Quiroz's third winner on the year.

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## Fair Hill Controversy cont.

In the next race, the Quiroz-trained Tepeyac (Heart to Heart) won by a half-length, also under Lugo. It was the colt's first start since finishing sixth in an optional claimer/starter allowance on April 5 at Gulfstream.

Quiroz's winners paid \$37.20 and \$9.60, but the \$1 daily double combining the two paid just \$12.80.

Quiroz also started a horse in the third race Sunday at Saratoga named Scootaloo (Mitole). After getting off to a slow start and tossing her head at the break, that horse finished fourth.

"It's very simple," Quiroz said. "I took my horses and ran them at Monmouth Park and won the races and I took one horse to Saratoga and she ran fourth. Everybody is shocked. I don't see what the big deal is or what the problem is. I'm supposed to run all the time and not try to win the race? There are too many people behind social media who don't show their faces and post too much stuff that is not true. The problem with social media is that this became very popular and people started to say stuff that isn't true and tried to make me out to be a bad guy."

Quiroz said that handicappers should not have been surprised that both horses won. He said that The Great Amira had overcome some problems and he always believed she would improve on the grass. As for Tepeyac, he said the horse had been facing better company in races at Colonial Downs and Gulfstream and fit in the \$16,000 claimer.

"It's not your fault that other people didn't like the horses or bet on the horses," he said.

At Saratoga, trainer Ernesto Ochoa won two races with horses coming off layoffs and showing works at Fair Hill. Quiroz confirmed to the TDN that he had trained both horses before they were sold to Ochoa by their owner. Ochoa does not have stalls at Fair Hill.

Ochoa's first winner was Classic Rock (Daredevil). Making his first start since a restricted maiden special weight race at on Nov. 7 at Churchill Downs, he was 10-1 in the morning line, went off at 8-1 and won by 8 3/4 lengths. It was just Ochoa's third winner on the year. Ochoa came back in the seventh race and won with M Bs Melanie Cares (Redesdale). Unraced since finishing fifth in a Jan. 4 maiden optional claimer at Gulfstream, M Bs Melanie Cares won by 3 1/2 lengths at 12-1.

Both of Ochoa's winners, as well as Scootaloo, were ridden by Ricardo Santana Jr.

"I've known Ochoa for a long time," Quiroz said. "My owner made a deal with him. The horses were ready to run and in good condition."

Phipps said that he has told Quiroz that he must meet with him and the Fair Hill Board of Directors Tuesday morning.

"We're taking a hard look at what the facts are and we will talk about it at our board meeting tomorrow and will take appropriate action," Phipps said. "We have spoken with everybody involved. In short, the trainers said they did nothing wrong. We will be investigating. This is very unusual. As you can imagine, this is nothing we've ever had to deal with before. We have a good group of people over here. Angel is a new trainer who came in for a three-month stint here. We will be looking into who we let into here and why. That's for sure."

"I am going to put him in front of our executive committee. We're going to get the whole story from him verbatim. As of now, it's kind of piecemeal. We've never had anything like this happen so we are trying to sort through it the best we can."

All of the horses' last workouts had been recorded at Fair Hill.

Multiple Grade I winner **White Abarrio** (Race Day) has been retired from racing and will join his grandsire **Tapit** in Lexington at Gainesway Farm, co-owner C2 Racing revealed in a post on X.

An 11-time winner, with four at the elite level--the GI Pegasus World Cup, GI Breeders' Cup Classic, GI Whitney Stakes, and the GI Florida Derby--White Abarrio had earned just shy of \$8.6-million during a six-year career. Trainer Saffie Joseph Jr. had said Sunday that the son of Race Day **would be evaluated** after fading to seventh in last Saturday's GI Whitney Stakes, and that a decision on his future would be made pending those results.

## SANTA ANITA'S 'SHIP & WIN' PROGRAM RETURNS FOR 2026 AUTUMN MEETING

The 'Ship & Win' program at Santa Anita will return for the Autumn meet starting Friday, Sept. 25 and run through Sunday, Nov.1, the track announced Monday.

The six-week stand features increased overnight purses in addition to a stakes schedule topped by seven 'Win and You're In' events for the Breeders' Cup at Keeneland. For this year's meeting, horses from out of state who made just one start at the Del Mar summer meet will remain eligible for the 'Ship & Win' purse bonus provided they did not make an additional start elsewhere.

In dirt races, eligible horses who finish first through fifth will receive a 50% purse bonus. In turf races, eligible horses who finish in the top five will receive a 40% purse bonus. These bonuses are applicable for one start only and do not include stakes races.

Horses participating in the program for the first time that make their initial California start during the Autumn meet will also receive a guaranteed \$4,000 in addition to the purse bonuses.

"The Ship & Win program has continued to attract significant numbers of horses to the Southern California circuit," said Jason Egan, Santa Anita director of racing and racing secretary. "With the best weather and great facility at which to race and train, we feel we've got the best turf racing in the nation. The Ship & Win program provides tremendous incentives for those considering stabling here in California year-round."

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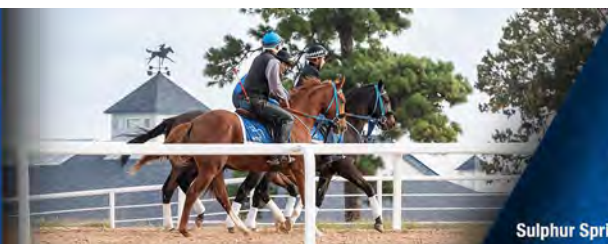

Sum of Success parlayed a sterling debut into career-first black-type with another powerful performance in the In Summation Stakes at Gulfstream.

Debuted at this venue July 20 against fellow Florida-breds, he overcame a bumpy start to cruise through the condition by 7 1/2 lengths. The betting public saw no reason to fix what wasn't broken for this start, and sent Sum of Success away as the heavy 1-5 favorite.

Breaking well this time, he quickly established control over the pace with an opening quarter in :22.06 and posted four panels in :44.64 while It's Smoking ranged up to issue a challenge on the bend. Called on for more as they swung for home, he opened up on is competition to win by a widening 11 1/2-length margin. Boyhood Dream overtook It's Smoking for second and the latter closed the trifecta by a neck over a late challenger.

"What can I say? You dream about having a nice horse, and I know what makes a great horse--a smart mind, and they're fast," said trainer Bobby Dibona. "I knew from the beginning this horse possessed those talents. He's quite amazing."

"We really haven't let him run. He hasn't had to do anything. It's pretty exciting to see what we're going to do."

"I have the Florida-bred races lined up where he's going to just be dominant and probably makes the most sense and save the challenges for his 3-year-old season," Dibona added. "That's kind of what I'm thinking now, go seven [furlongs] and then a mile, which is within his scope. But they're talking about Breeders' Cup with the horse, so it's a little tricky."

Sum of Success is the most recent to the races for All Summed Up, and is the 12th stakes horse for his Florida-based sire. 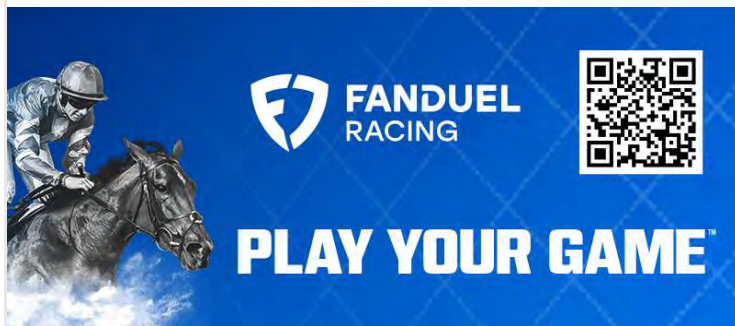

That sale represents the scene of Fanning's greatest day as a consignor with a Havana Grey filly, who later became the stakes-placed Aegina, selling for £240,000 [to Mark McStay on behalf of Skara Glen Stables].

Fanning is readying a nine-strong draft for this year's Premier Yearling Sale and describes herself as happy with how her burgeoning outfit has taken shape in recent years.

She explained, "We're very pleased with how things are going. We are selling nine horses in Donny and, for the first time ever, we have five for Book 2 at Tattersalls so that's exciting. I'm really chuffed about that because it can be hard selling the horses at the bottom end of the market at times. It seems as though we have some nice ones to look forward to this year, which is exciting. You learn so much from selling the lower grade horses and, in many ways, it's how you cut your teeth. However, in recent years, it has become hard sending an owner a bill when they've not managed to sell their horse. The bottom end of the market has become incredibly tricky so it's nice to have some better stock to look forward to this year."

She added, "We obviously did very well with the Knox family's Aegina (Havana Grey), which she is known as now, at the Premier Yearling Sale a couple of years ago. She was the highest-priced filly at the sale in 2024 and she has gone on to be

a very good filly for Donnacha O'Brien. That was an amazing experience and to do it for smaller breeders, who had been in the game for years without experiencing anything like that, it was extra special. It was all quite emotional, really. So we've plenty of good memories at Donny and it has been a lucky place for us."

Joe's retirement at the age of 55 was met with an outpouring of goodwill across the industry. One of the most successful jockeys of the modern era had not ridden in a race since last November due to a prostate cancer diagnosis and made the decision to officially bow out following a successful surgery.

Just six jockeys in Britain have ridden more winners than Joe managed throughout his career and, upon his retirement, he was labelled "a master of judging pace" by his old ally Johnston.

"It's mad really because we're both so busy and you just kind of go through your day-to-day life, don't you?" Sarah reflected. "You don't really think too much about these things. Even when Joe was poorly, he just wanted to get his treatment done and just get it over and done with and move on. But yeah, I guess the last few weeks it's been a bit quieter in the yard, so I've taken stock and every time I read the words that have been spoken about Joe, it moves me to tears to be honest. It's a bit surreal. It's incredible how highly he was viewed within the industry. It's all very humbling." **Cont. p4**

She added, "Joe is just so level. He never gets high and he never gets down. He's just a very, very level person, whereas I would be more emotional. I'll never forget when I first got to know him, I was working at Darley and obviously we used to go into Mark Johnston's quite a lot to see some of the horses. Joe would often win on a lot of those horses earlier on in their career before being jocked off for some of the bigger races. That really riled me, but Joe never let it upset him and saw the bigger picture. In reality, the way Joe is, it's probably how you need to be in this game; level."

It may not be the greatest surprise to learn that a man who mastered the art of front-running riding throughout his glittering career is often in a rush to get things done around the yard. This, according to Fanning, has led to the odd exchange between the pair since Joe's retirement. Nevertheless, Fanning, whose style would have been more Paul Carberry than Joe Fanning had she been a jockey, is looking forward to having her husband on deck going forward.

Fanning said, "He came to the store sales in May--he was supposed to be there to help us, but we didn't see him all day because he was too busy chatting to people! He can be front of house and bring the customers to the door going forward!"

Fanning, who is rarely seen without a smile on her face at the sales, has built up a smart CV in her own right. As well as working at York Racecourse, she graduated from the Godolphin Flying Start programme and enjoyed spells working with Darley and also as a barn manager with Johnston. But it is through her role as a pre-trainer and consignor where she has begun to flourish.

She said, "I have been lucky to have done a lot of different things and have seen the industry from various different angles. I loved my time working at York Racecourse after uni and that was a fantastic experience, seeing the racing administration side of it and dealing with sponsors and owners and all that kind of stuff. And then I was on the Flying Start, which was a great experience, before I joined Darley and worked for John Ferguson in the office. That was really good. I've seen it from a lot of different angles and it was a great experience as yard manager for Mark Johnson as well. I think I went there with the intention of becoming a trainer but realised pretty quickly that I

didn't want to go down that road, purely because it is just such a difficult profession."

Have she ever revisited that thought?

"We've had a few point-to-pointers over the years, but it's just so hard," she replied. "We pre-train quite a few horses during the winter and we enjoy the breaking and pre-training side of things. I like to use my eventing background and give the horses a really good start. I think it's important for them to leave here with good temperaments and be nice to be around and nice to ride. It sets them up well for their careers in training."

She added, "And then with regards to the horses we consign, I like them to have really good top lines, but I don't like fat horses. I like people to be able to look at them and imagine how they're going to look as a racehorse when they're fit. I like them to be carrying plenty of condition and top line, but equally athletic enough to show themselves off. I did a lot of part-time and full-time working for Mark Dwyer and I think he's very good

at feeding and his horses always look fantastic. That experience really stuck with me."

That breadth of experience has shaped a hands-on business built around quality rather than quantity. Fanning remains closely involved with every horse, from preparation to sale, and her ambition is clear; to build a boutique operation known for well-prepared horses and personal service.

She concluded, "I'd like to be known for a boutique consignment of very nice horses.

I admire the bigger consignors, but my ethos has been to offer a one-to-one service to our clients. I know how much effort goes into getting a yearling to the sale and I like to be on the job and know exactly what's going on with every horse at the sales. So, it's not really my plan to be consigning huge numbers."
